TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Jura Distillery Tour & Tasting** — Founded in 1810 and revived in 1963, Jura Distillery produces a sweet, lightly peated single malt unlike its heavily...
 - **Paps of Jura Walk** — Three dramatic quartzite peaks — Beinn an Òir, Beinn Shiantaidh, and Beinn a' Chaolais — dominate the island skyline.
 - **Corryvreckan Whirlpool RIB Tour** — The Gulf of Corryvreckan between Jura and Scarba is home to one of the
- world's most powerful tidal whirlpools — audible...

 - **Corran Sands Beach Walk** — Just 4km north of Craighouse, Corran Sands is considered Jura's finest beach — a wide sweep of white shell sand backed...
 - **Craighouse Village & Keils Cemetery** — A self-guided loop from the pier to the Jura Distillery, along the shoreline, and back via the ancient Keils burial...

BEST WALKS

- **Craighouse Harbour & Keils Cemetery Loop** 3.2 mi / 5.2 km • 1.5 hrs • Easy — From the pier, walk through the village past the distillery, follow the shoreline south to the ancient Keils burial ground with its...
- **Craighouse to Corran Sands** 5 mi / 8 km round trip • 2.5–3 hrs • Easy–Moderate — Head north out of Craighouse along the A846 and the track to Corran Sands — Jura's most beautiful beach, a sweeping arc of white shell...
- **Paps of Jura — Beinn an Òir Summit** ~8 mi / 13 km • 5–7 hrs • Strenuous — Scotland's most iconic island hillwalk.
