- Tobermory Distillery Tour & Tasting** — One of Scotland's oldest distilleries (est.
- Duart Castle** — The 13th-century clifftop seat of Clan Maclean commands dramatic views over the Sound of Mull.
- Isle of Iona & Iona Abbey** — The 'Cradle of Christianity' in Scotland.
- Staffa & Fingal's Cave** — Sail to this uninhabited island of hexagonal basalt columns.
- White-tailed Sea Eagle Watching** — Mull has Europe's highest density of White-tailed Sea Eagles — wingspan up to 8 ft.

BEST WALKS

- Tobermory Harbour Front Stroll** 30 min · Flat · No transport needed — Walk the length of the iconic painted harbor buildings, browse the independent shops and galleries, and soak up the bay views.
- Rubha nan Gall Lighthouse Walk** 3 miles / 1.5 hrs round trip · Easy coastal path — Head north out of Tobermory along a flat, well-marked coastal path through woodland and along the shore to a working 19th-century...
- Aros Park Rainforest Trail** 1–2 hrs · Easy · 15-min walk from pier — A temperate Atlantic rainforest walk with waterfalls, wooden footbridges, giant ferns, and viewpoints looking back across the bay to...

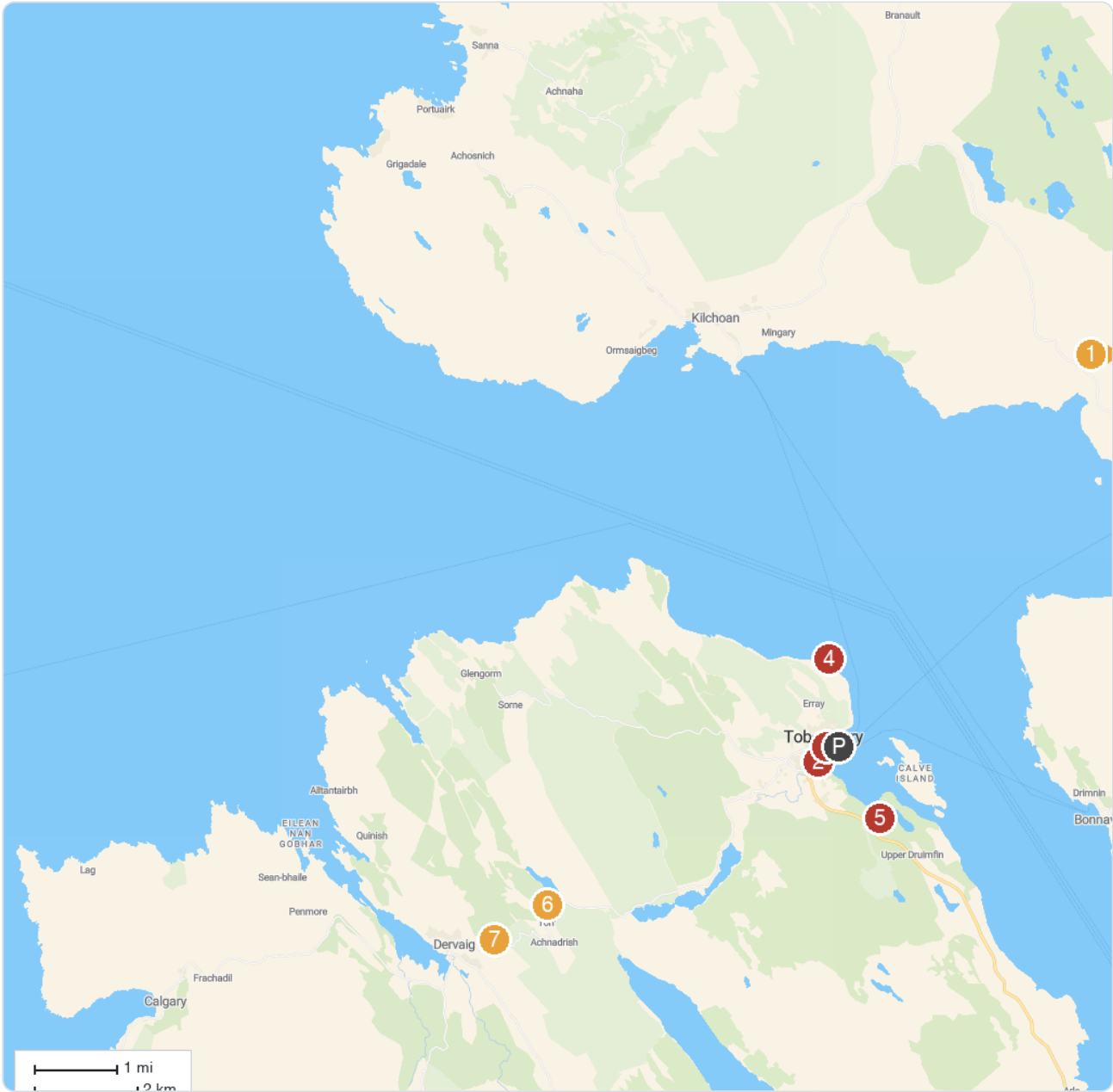
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
