GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Anchor & tender — ships anchor off Inverarish; tender to the community pontoon or beach

Best For: Whisky lovers, hikers, wildlife watchers, anyone wanting to escape Skye's crowds

Walk to Centre: 5 min walk from tender landing to Inverarish village and distillery

Don't Miss: Isle of Raasay Distillery tour & tasting, and the view from Dun Caan summit

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Isle of Raasay Distillery Tour & Tasting** — A five-minute walk from the tender landing, this award-winning distillery produces a distinctive lightly-peated single...
 - Dun Caan Summit Hike** — Raasay's flat-topped volcanic peak (443 m) offers a 360° panorama over Skye, the Torridon hills, and the Outer Hebrides.
 - Hallaig Clearance Village & Sorley Maclean Trail** — Walk to the ruins of Hallaig, one of the villages cleared in the 19th
- century and immortalised in Sorley Maclean's...

 - Raasay House Kayaking & RIB Trips** — The Raasay House Outdoor Centre (1.5 km north of the tender landing) offers guided sea kayaking, wildlife RIB boat...
 - Brochel Castle & Calum's Road** — On the island's north-east coast, the crumbling 16th-century Brochel Castle perches on a volcanic plug above the sea.

BEST WALKS

- Distillery & Inverarish Village Loop** 1 hr | Easy | Free — From the tender landing, walk south through Inverarish to the distillery visitor centre (exterior always visible), then loop back via...
- Temptation Hill Viewpoint** 1.5–2 hrs | Easy–moderate | Free — A short climb from Inverarish to the Temptation Hill viewpoint rewards with sweeping views across the Sound of Raasay to Skye.
- Raasay House & Walled Garden** 45 min walk each way | Easy | Free to view — Head north along the track from Inverarish to reach Raasay House, a Georgian mansion that is now a hotel and activity centre.

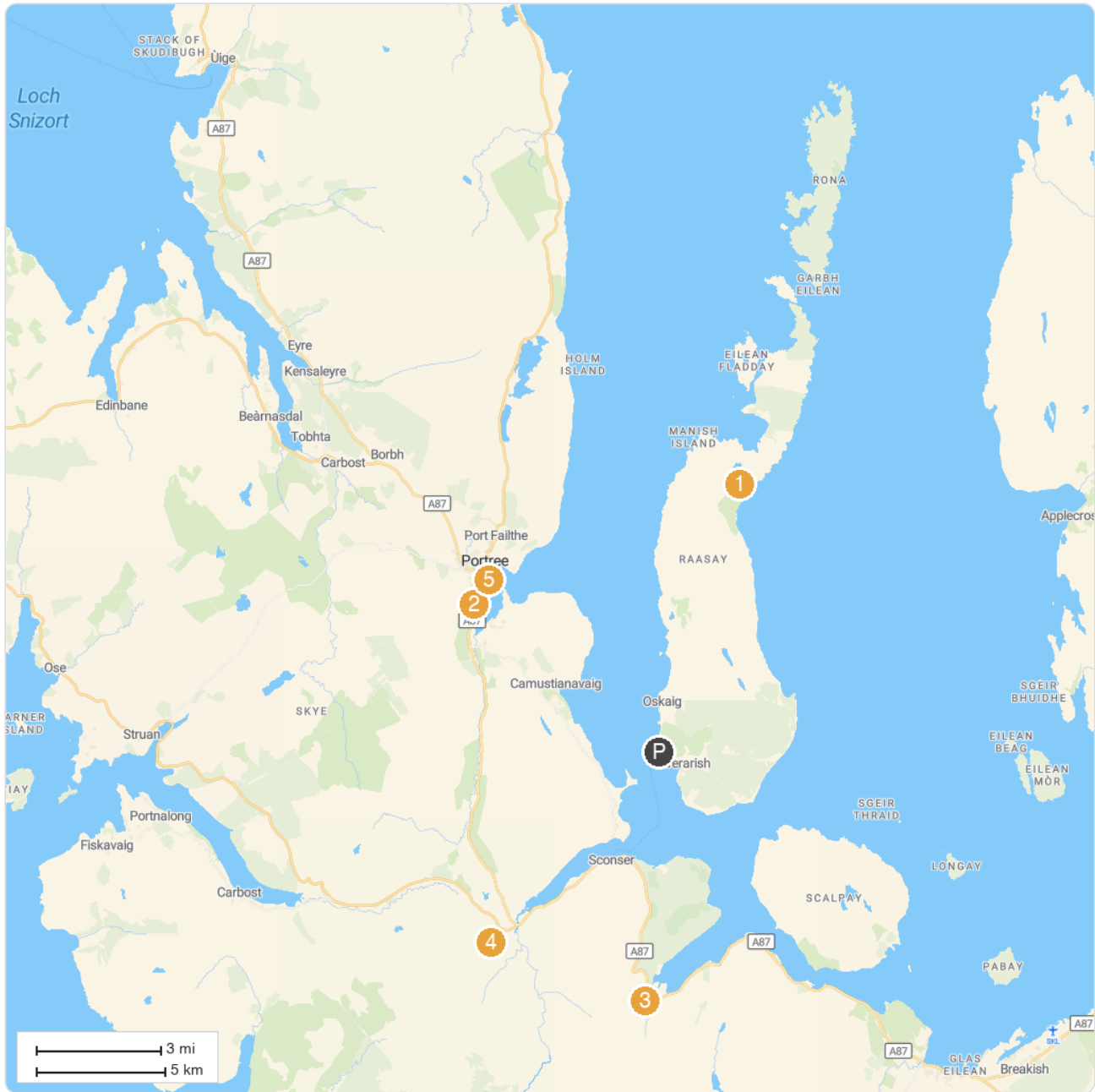
