GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender — anchor in Gott Bay; tenders land at Scarinish Ferry Pier

Best For: Beaches, birdwatching, cycling, walking, Hebridean tranquility

Walk to village: ~1.2 miles (20–25 min flat walk) from pier to Scarinish centre

Don't Miss: The Ringing Stone near Vaul — a glacial erratic that rings like a bell when tapped

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Machair Wildflower Walk** — In June–August, Tiree's coastal machair bursts into a carpet of yellow, purple, and white wildflowers — one of Europe's...
 - **The Ringing Stone (Clach a' Choire)** — A massive glacial erratic on the north coast that produces a clear metallic ring when tapped with a small pebble.
 - **Skerryvore Shore Station, Hynish** — Built by Robert Louis Stevenson's uncle Alan, this Victorian shore station
- supported construction of the Skerryvore...

 - **An Iodhlann Historical Centre** — Tiree's community archive in Scarinish holds historical documents, photographs, and stories covering Gaelic heritage...
 - **Balevullin Beach & Surf Watch** — Tiree's wildest beach on the northwest coast faces open Atlantic swells, making it Scotland's premier windsurfing and...

BEST WALKS

- **Gott Bay Beach Stroll** 1-2 miles • 30-45 min • Easy — From the tender landing at Scarinish Pier, walk north along the sweeping arc of Gott Bay — 2.5 miles of white shell-sand with clear...
- **Scarinish Village & Old Harbour** 1.2 miles • 20-25 min • Easy — Walk from the pier into Scarinish to find the Yellow Hare café, An Iodhlann archive, the Scarinish Hotel pub, and the picturesque old...
