TOP THINGS TO DO

- Delphi Archaeological Site** — Walk the Sacred Way past the Temple of Apollo, the ancient theater, and the stadium perched high on Mount Parnassus...
- Delphi Archaeological Museum** — Air-conditioned home of the bronze Charioteer of Delphi, the Sphinx of Naxos, and stunning statuary.
- Olive Grove of Amfissa** — Over 1.2 million ancient olive trees — some more than 1,000 years old — blanket the valley between Itea and Delphi.
- Galaxidi Village** — A perfectly preserved neoclassical sea captain's town 15 km west of Itea.
- Itea Waterfront & Beach** — Stroll the Akti Poseidonos promenade, sip Greek coffee at a waterfront café, and dip into the calm, clear Corinthian...

BEST WALKS

- Waterfront Promenade Walk** 1 km · Flat · 20 min — Walk the Akti Poseidonos promenade from the pier westward past cafés, the Orthodox church, and the small marina.
- Itea Town Center** 0.5 km · Flat · 15 min — From the waterfront, head one block inland to find local bakeries, kafeneions, and the small market square.

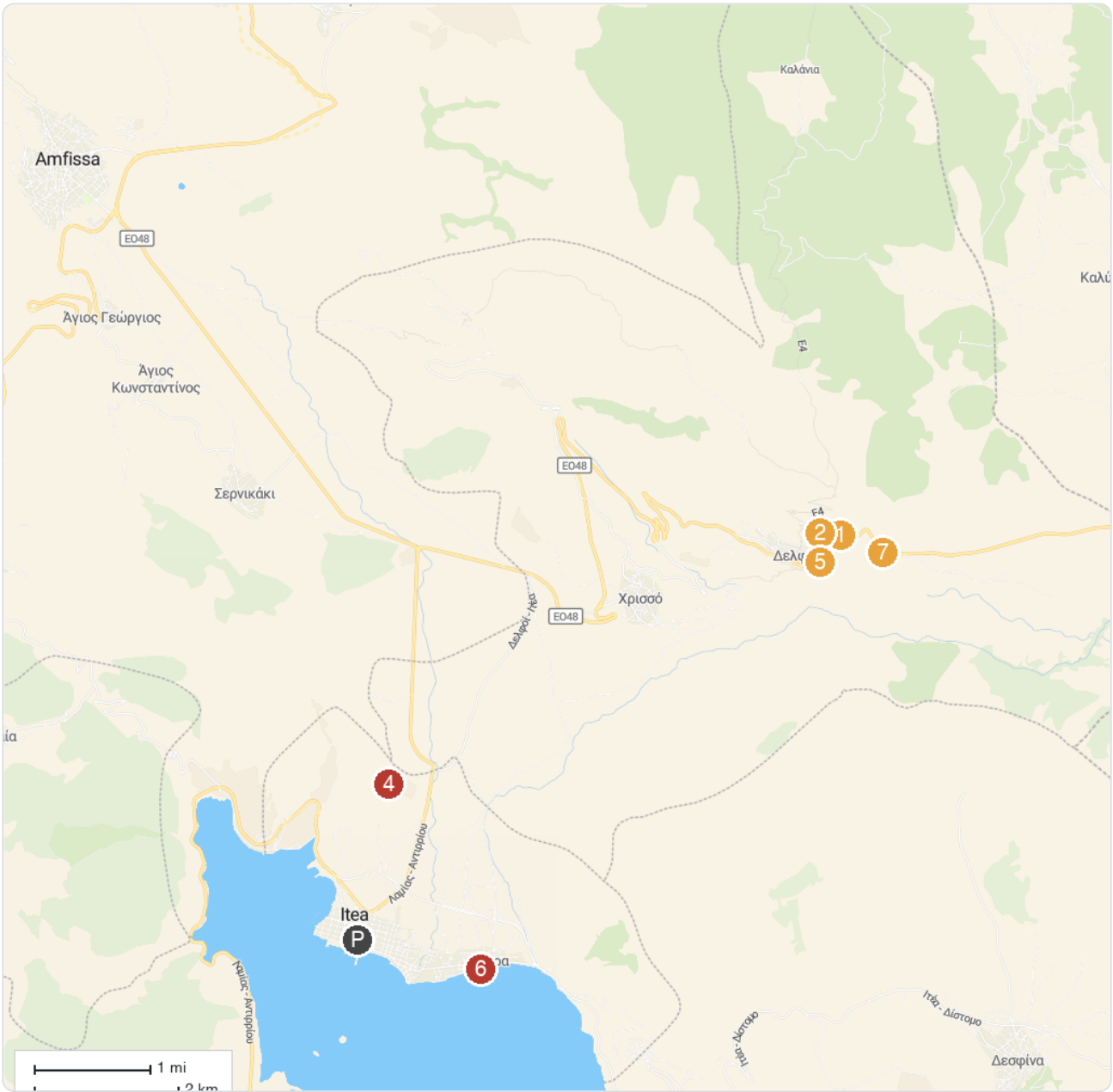
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
