

Itsukushima (Miyajima), Hiroshima Prefecture, Japan

Home to Japan's most photographed image — a vermilion torii gate rising from the sea — Miyajima pairs a UNESCO World Heritage shrine with deer that roam freely among the temples, street-grilled oysters, and sweeping views from sacred Mt. Misen.

GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Most ships dock at Hiroshima Port (Ujina) or Itsukaichi Wharf; small/expedition ships may tender directly to Miyajima Ferry Terminal

Walk to shrine: 10-12 min flat walk from Miyajima Ferry Terminal to Itsukushima Shrine

Best For: Shrines & temples, iconic photography, street food, scenic mountain views

Don't Miss: The floating torii gate at high tide, grilled oysters on Omotesando, Daisho-in Temple's 500 Rakan statues

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Itsukushima Shrine & the Floating Torii** — Walk the covered corridors of the 12th-century UNESCO shrine built on stilts over the tidal inlet, then step out to...
- Mount Misen & Ropeway** — Take the two-stage ropeway up to the Mt.
- Daisho-in Temple** — One of Japan's most important Shingon Buddhist temples, set at the foot of Mt.
- Hiroshima Peace Memorial & Museum** — Most ship excursions pair Miyajima with the Hiroshima Peace Memorial Park and Museum, one of the world's most moving...
- Omotesando Street Food Crawl** — Miyajima's main shopping street is a gauntlet of free samples and open-air grills.

BEST WALKS

- Ferry Terminal to Itsukushima Shrine** 1.0 km | 12 min | Flat | Paved coastal path — The classic Miyajima walk.
- Shrine to Daisho-in Temple** 1.2 km | 20-25 min | Gentle uphill | Mix of paved and stone paths — From the shrine, follow signs inland and uphill through quiet residential lanes to Daisho-in Temple.

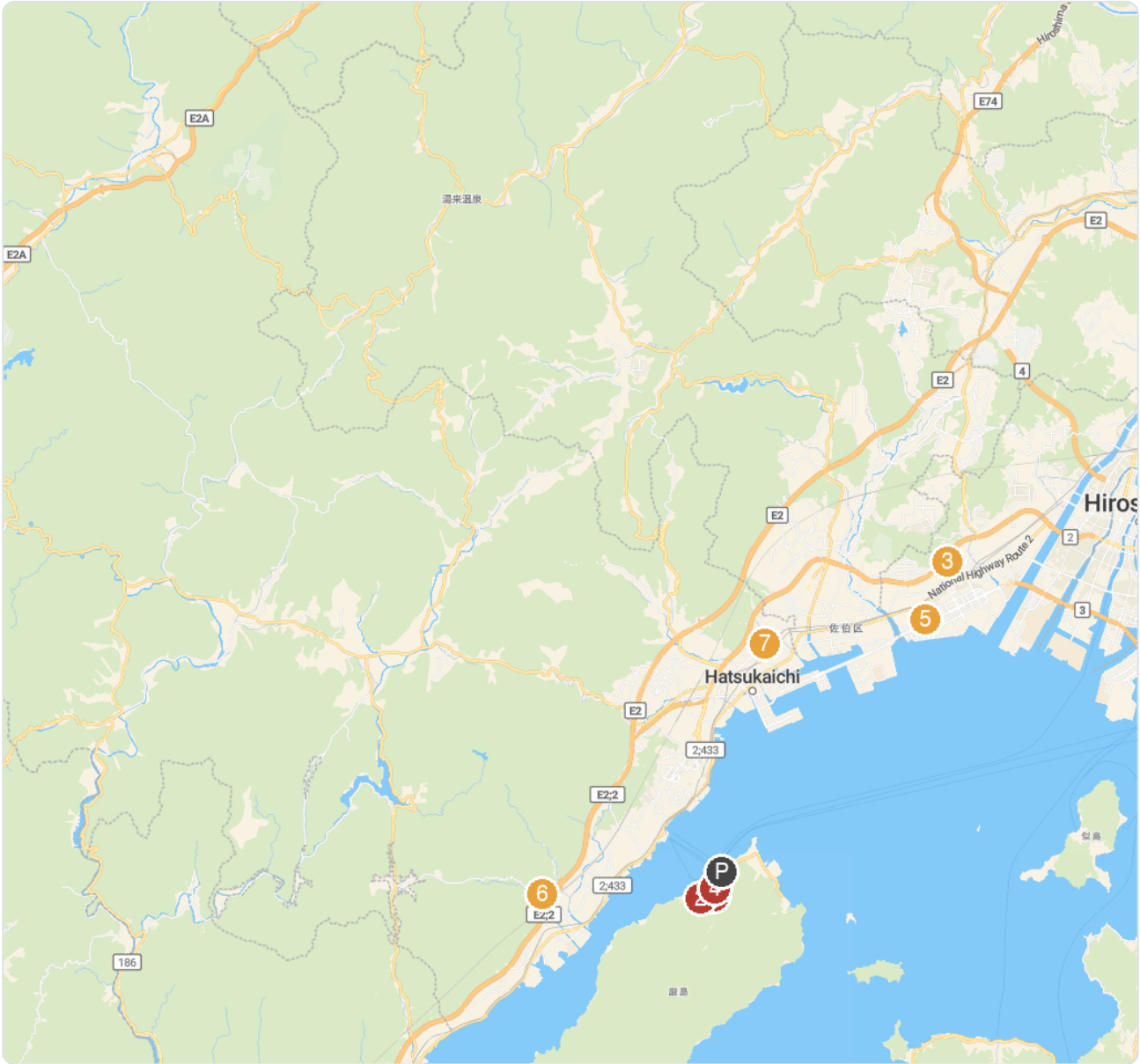
