GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier at Alsancak Port — no tender required

Walk to center: 15–20 min walk along the Kordon to Konak Square; taxis plentiful

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Ephesus & the Library of Celsus** — One of the best-preserved Roman cities on earth, 80 km south of Izmir.
- **Kemeralti Bazaar & Ancient Agora** — Lose yourself in Izmir's 17th-century market — a labyrinth of spice stalls, carpet shops, Ottoman caravanserais...
- **Kadifekale (Velvet Castle)** — Izmir's ancient hilltop citadel, built during Alexander the Great's era, offers sweeping panoramas over the Gulf of...
- **Turkish Breakfast & Local Food Walk** — Izmir has its own culinary identity.
- **Şirince Village & Wine Tasting** — Combine an Ephesus visit with a stop in Şirince, a whitewashed hilltop village famous for its fruit wines (pomegranate...)

BEST WALKS

- **Kordon Promenade to Konak Square** 2.5 km · 30–35 min · Flat, paved — Walk south along the Kordon waterfront promenade from Alsancak Port past outdoor cafes, palm trees, and ferry piers to Konak Square...
- **Kemeralti Bazaar & Ancient Agora Loop** 2 km · 2–3 hrs exploring · Cobblestones — From Konak Square, plunge into Kemeralti Bazaar along Anafartalar Caddesi.

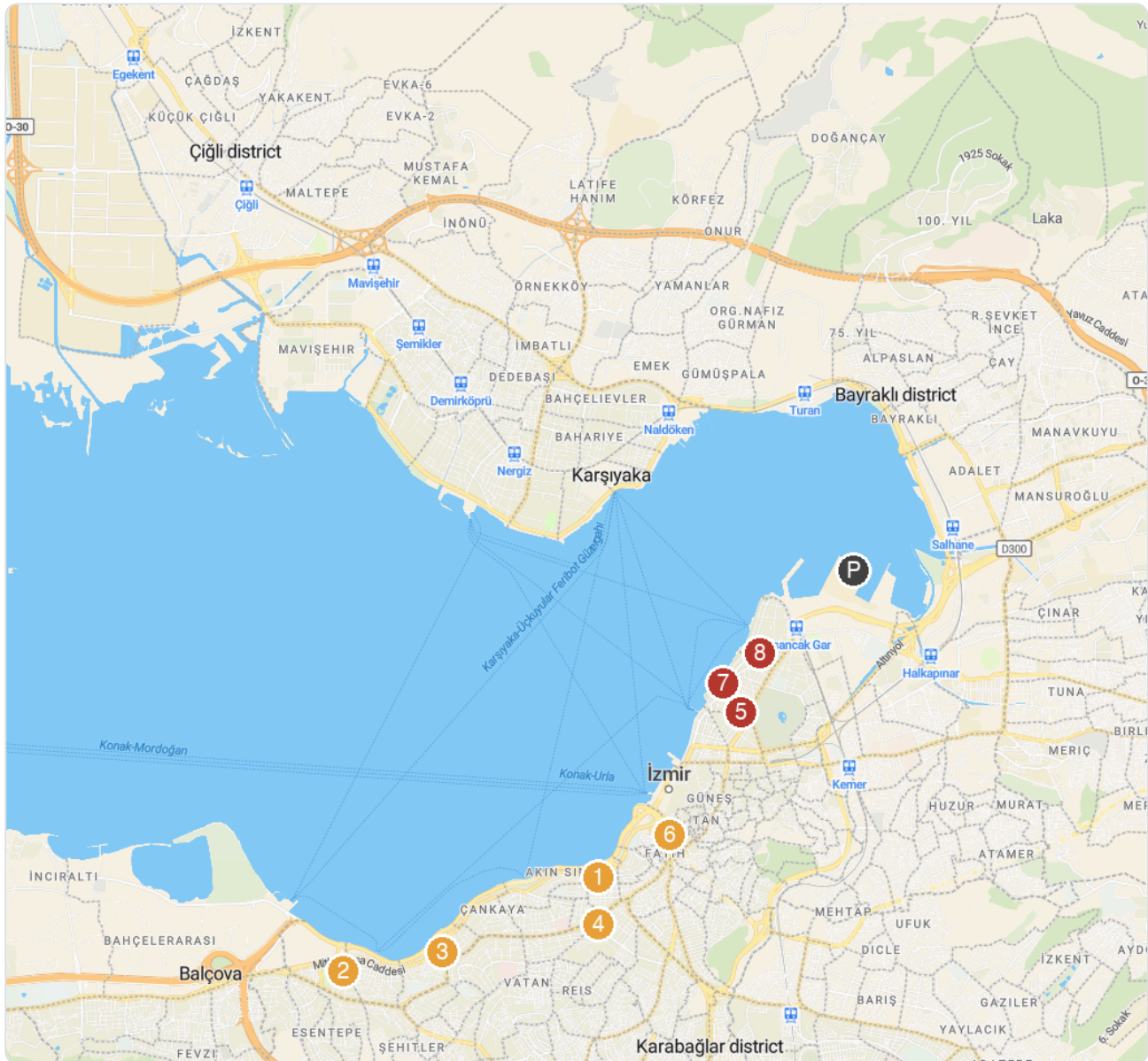
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Use city-centre ATMs for Lira. Exchange desks at the terminal offer poor rates. Turkish Lira is needed for trams, buses, and market stalls, though taxis and tourist shops accept...
- Entering mosques: Shoulders and knees must be covered. Women need a head covering. This applies to Hisar Mosque in the
