- **St. Augustine Day Trip** — America's oldest city is just 35–60 min south.
 - **Jacksonville Zoo and Gardens** — A 73-acre zoo home to thousands of animals including big cats, gorillas, and exotic birds, woven through botanical...
 - **Jacksonville Beach & Atlantic Beach** — Twenty miles of Atlantic coastline, 30–40 min from port.
- **Catty Shack Ranch Wildlife Sanctuary** — A nonprofit rescue for endangered big cats — lions, Siberian tigers, leopards, and bobcats.
 - **Riverside/Avondale & Cummer Museum** — Jacksonville's most photogenic neighborhood — historic bungalows, oak-lined streets, independent shops, and the Cummer...

BEST WALKS

- **Jacksonville Riverwalk** 1.5 miles | Easy | Downtown — A flat, paved riverfront promenade along the Southbank of the St.
- **Riverside/Avondale Historic Neighborhood** 1–2 miles | Easy | Historic district — Stroll oak-canopied streets past Craftsman bungalows and Spanish Mediterranean mansions.

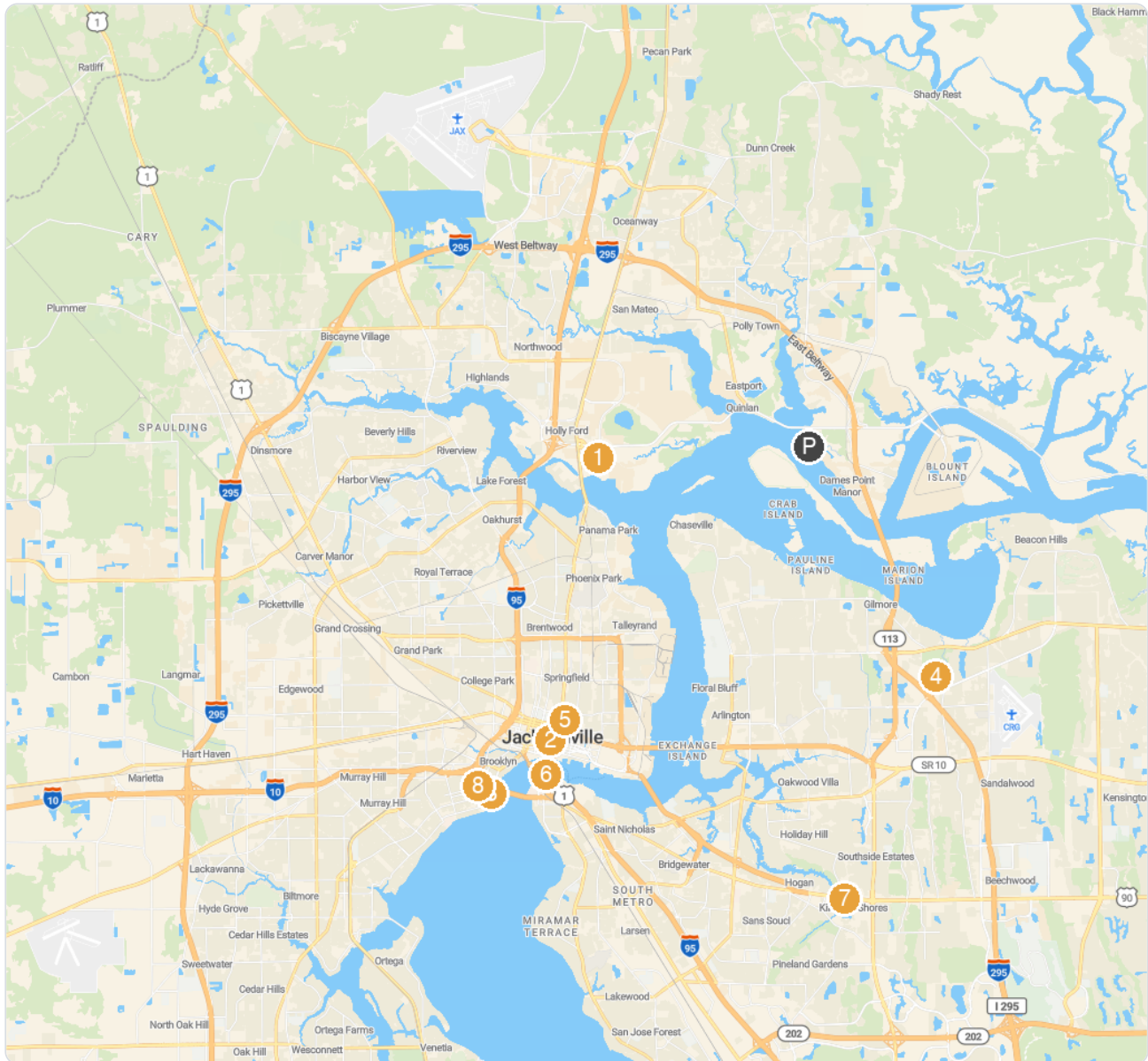
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
