- **Sunda Kelapa Harbor** — Walk the 500-year-old harbor where traditional wooden pinisi schooners still load cargo by hand, just as they have for...
- **Istiqlal Mosque & Cathedral** — Southeast Asia's largest mosque stands directly across the street from a neo-Gothic Dutch colonial cathedral — a living...
- **National Monument (Monas)** — Ride the elevator to the top of Jakarta's 132-meter golden-flame obelisk for panoramic city views, then explore the...
- **National Museum of Indonesia** — The 'Elephant Building' houses stunning Hindu-Buddhist gold treasures, ancient artifacts, and ethnographic collections...

- **Kota Tua to Sunda Kelapa** ~1.5 km | Easy | 45-60 min | Historical — From Fatahillah Square, wander through the old Dutch colonial quarter, past the Jakarta History Museum and Wayang Museum, then...

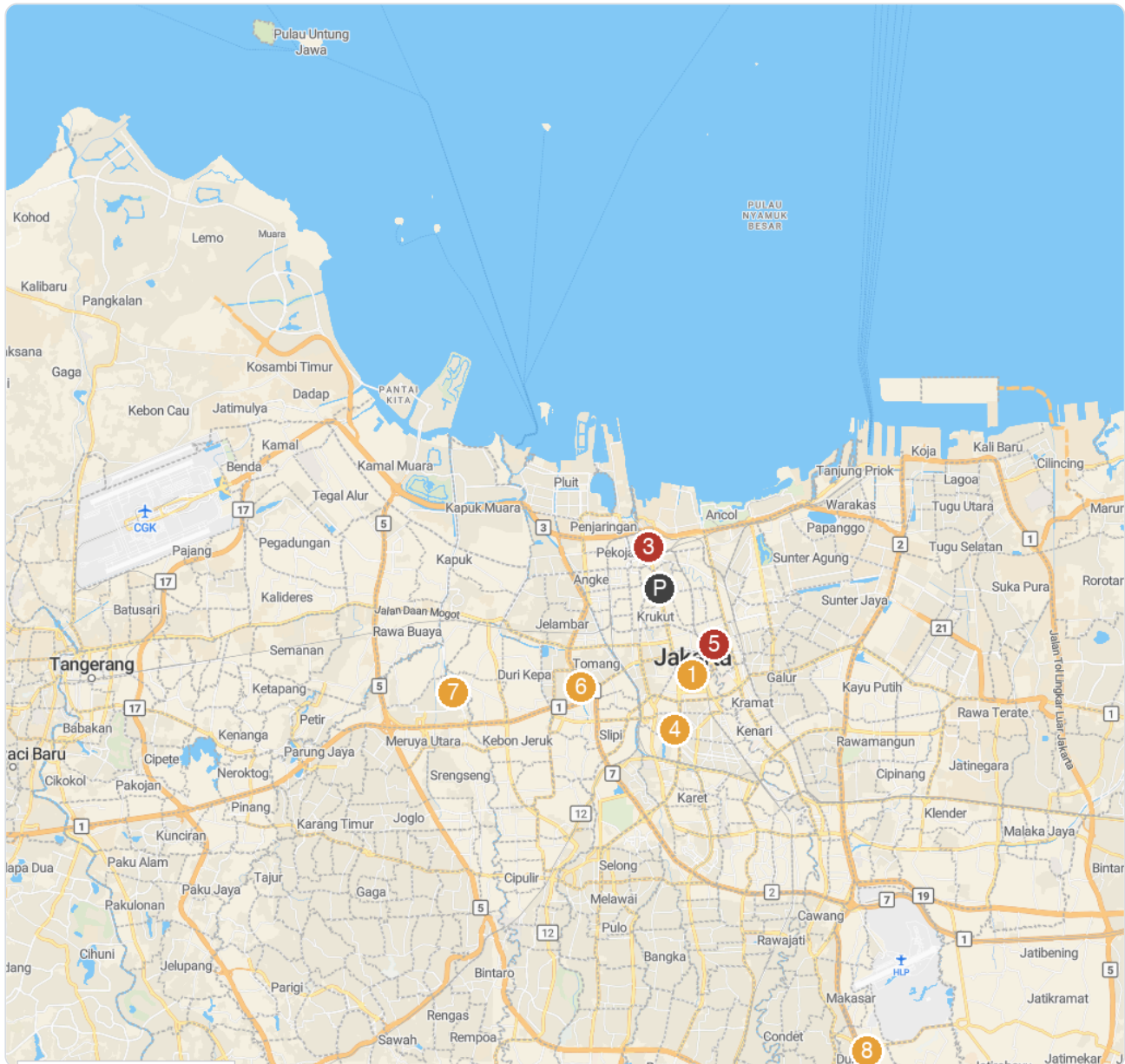
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Budget double travel time. Jakarta's traffic is legendary. A 30-min trip at 7 AM can be 2 hours at 2 PM. Head back to Tanjung Priok well before all-aboard — aim for 2.5 hours...
- Blue Bird taxis only. Use Blue Bird (blue cars) or Grab app. Avoid unofficial taxis outside the port. Always verify the meter is running.
