GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier — Jeddah Islamic Port passenger terminal, no tender

Best For: UNESCO coral architecture, Red Sea history, vibrant souqs, iconic fountain

Walk to Center: Not walkable — port is industrial; 15-20 min by taxi/shuttle to Al-Balad

Don't Miss: Al-Balad historic district and a stop at Al Baik for legendary Saudi fried chicken

 Getting around:  **Taxi**  SAR 20–50 (~\$5–14) negotiated ·  **Rideshare**  Uber, Careem

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Al-Balad UNESCO Walking Tour** — Explore Jeddah's 1,400-year-old walled city, renowned for its rawashin — intricately carved wooden bay windows atop...
- Red Sea Corniche & King Fahd Fountain** — Stroll Jeddah's 30-km waterfront promenade past Henry Moore and Joan Miró sculptures, then watch King Fahd Fountain...
- Al-Tayebat City Museum** — A multi-level palace replica showcasing thousands of artifacts spanning Islamic and Saudi history.
- Obhur Beach Club Day Pass** — Private beach clubs north of Jeddah (Silver Sands, Oia Beach) offer pool, beach, and Red Sea access where Western...
- Al-Rahmah Floating Mosque & Corniche Walk** — Visit the iconic mosque built on stilts over the Red Sea — stunning at high tide when the structure appears to float.

BEST WALKS

- Al-Balad Historic Core Loop** 2–3 km | 2–3 hrs | Moderate (uneven surfaces) — Start at Bab Makkah gate, then weave through Souq Al Alawi to Nassif House Museum, Al-Shafei Mosque, and Madrasa Al Falah.
- Corniche Waterfront Stroll** 2–4 km | 1–2 hrs | Easy — Walk the paved Red Sea promenade from Al-Rahmah Floating Mosque south toward King Fahd Fountain.

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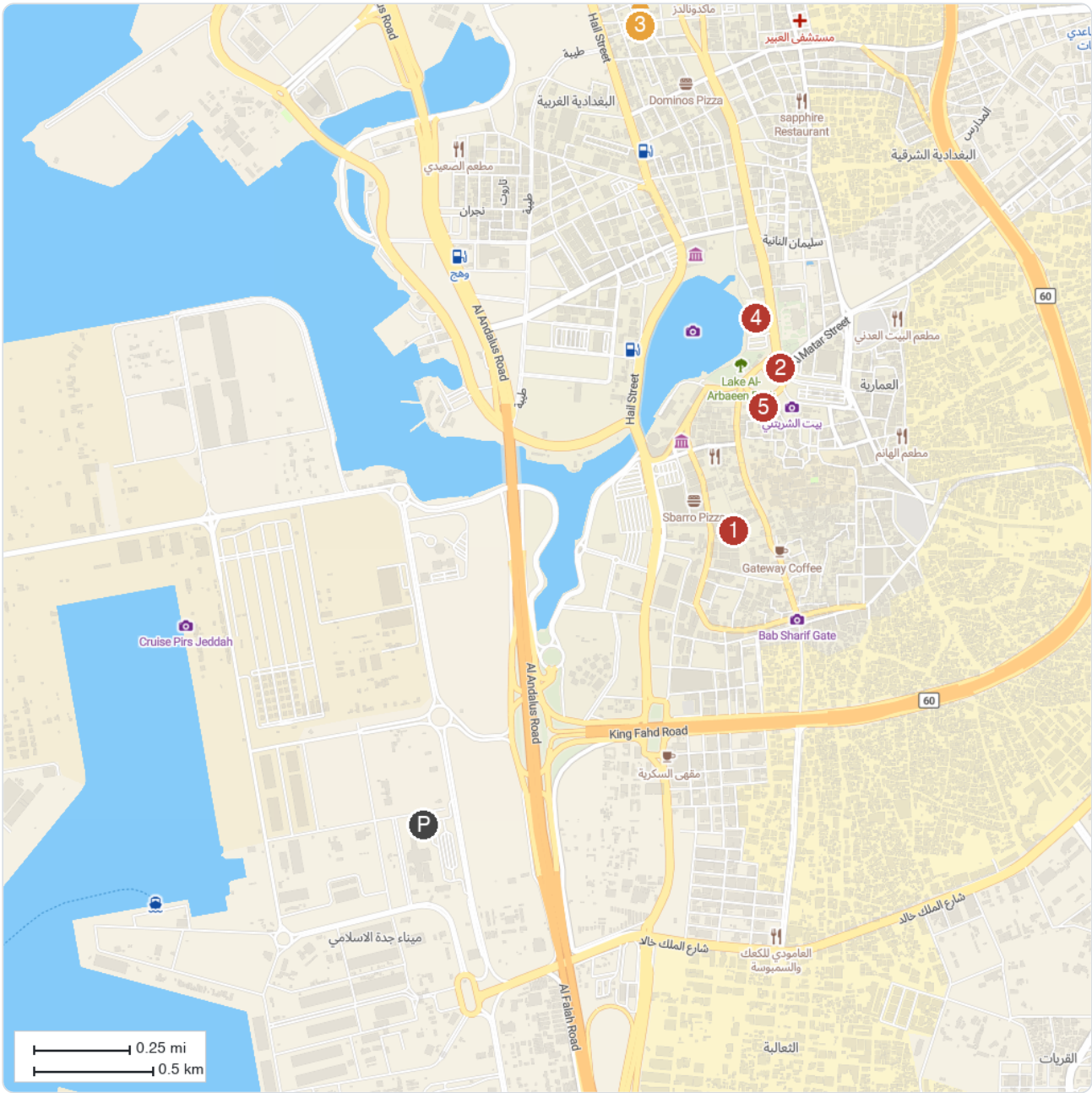
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
