GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender to Albert Pier Pontoon (ships >185m); small ships may berth at Albert Pier, St Helier

Walk to centre: ~10 min from Albert Pier to Liberation Square, St Helier

Best For: WWII history, castle-hopping, wildlife conservation, beaches

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Jersey War Tunnels (Hohlgangsanlage 8)** — An extensive underground hospital complex carved by forced labour under German occupation, now a powerful WWII museum.
- **Mont Orgueil Castle** — A 13th-century fortress perched dramatically above Gorey harbour on Jersey's east coast.
- **Elizabeth Castle & Liberation Square** — A magnificent 16th-century sea fortress on a tidal islet in St Aubin's Bay — reach it by amphibious vehicle or on foot...
- **Durrell Wildlife Park (Jersey Zoo)** — Founded by naturalist Gerald Durrell, this world-renowned conservation park is home to some of the planet's most...
- **St Brelade's Bay** — Jersey's most popular beach — a sweeping crescent of golden sand on the sheltered south-west coast.

BEST WALKS

- **Liberation Square & St Helier Town Centre** 1–2 hrs · Flat · Free — From the Albert Pier Pontoon, walk west along the waterfront to Liberation Square — home to the bronze Liberation Statue marking the...
- **Gorey Harbour & Mont Orgueil Village** 1 hr on foot (after bus) · Moderate · Paid castle entry — Take LibertyBus to Gorey, then walk the quayside past brightly coloured boats to the foot of Mont Orgueil Castle.

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Tides are extreme. Jersey has some of Europe's largest tidal ranges (up to 12m). Always check tide times before walking to Elizabeth Castle or exploring coastal rocks — the sea...
- LibertyBus is your friend. The island bus network is reliable, clean, and cheap — pay by contactless card on board. A day rover ticket gives unlimited travel and covers all major...
- Jersey Pounds equal GBP but are not accepted on the UK mainland. Spend them on the island. UK bank cards work everywhere; most places take contactless.
