GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender to Jondal Guest Harbour (village centre)

Best For: Quiet fjord scenery, summer glacier skiing, Hardanger embroidery

Walk to centre: 1–2 min from tender dock

Don't Miss: Jondal Church — the 'Hardanger Cathedral' — and a drive to Folgefonna Glacier

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Summer Skiing on Folgefonna Glacier** — Drive 45 minutes up a winding mountain road to Fonna Glacier Ski Resort, where you can ski or snowboard at 1,200 m...
 - Hardangerfjord Kayaking** — Paddle the glassy fjord at water level, surrounded by towering peaks and waterfalls.
 - Baroniet Rosendal Day Trip** — Norway's only barony — a 1665 manor castle with a Renaissance rose garden and a dramatic waterfall backdrop, about an...
- Jondal Church & Village Walk** — The 'Hardanger Cathedral' seats about 500 in a village of around 400 — its scale is remarkable.
 - Hardanger Cider Tasting** — The Hardanger region is Norway's apple heartland.

- Village Heritage Walk** 1–2 km · 30–45 min · Easy · Free — From the guest harbour, walk to Jondal Church, admire the 19th-century wooden houses, and end at the local café for a pastry with...

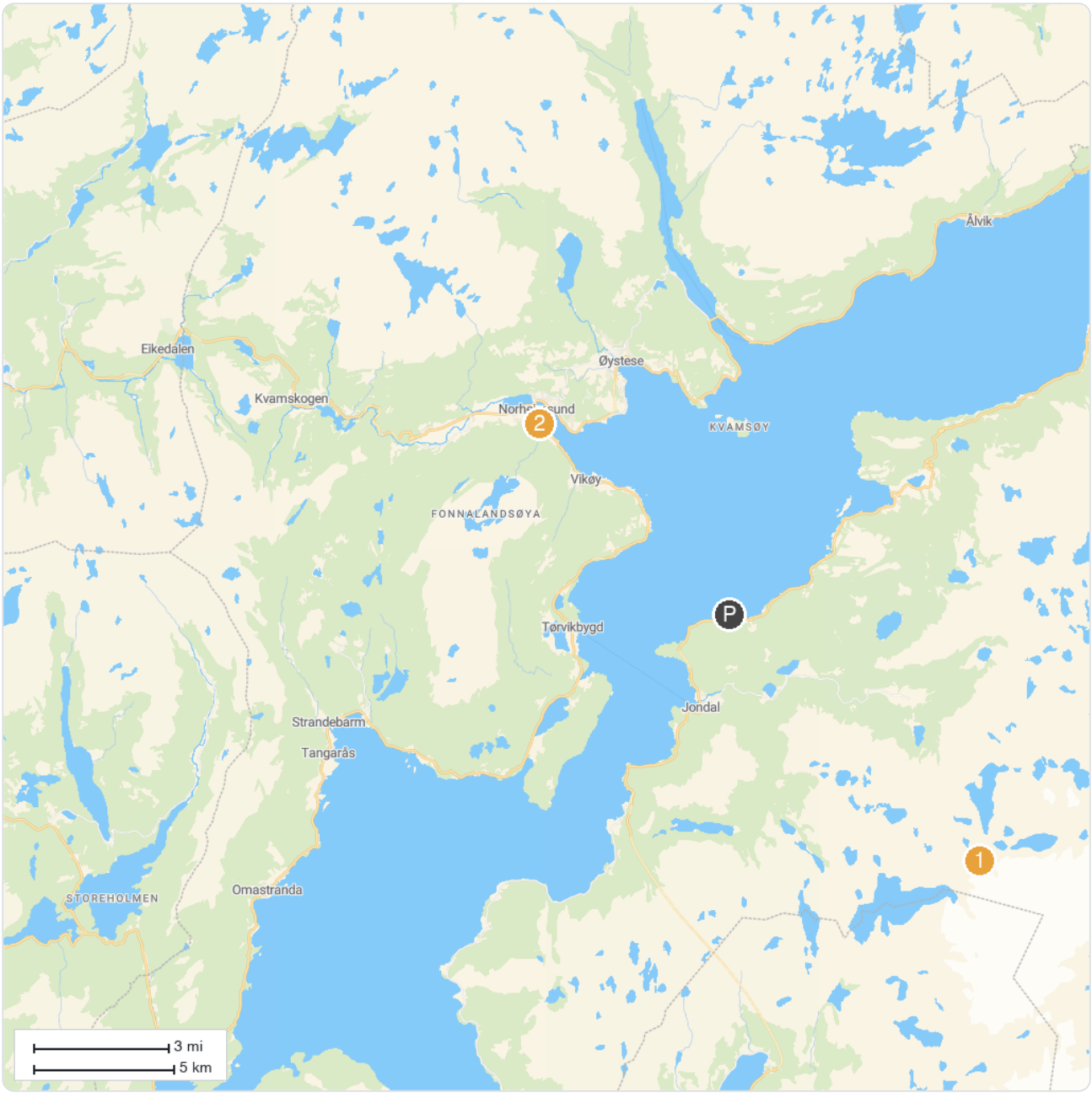
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Dress in layers for the glacier. Even in July, temperatures at Folgefonna can drop near freezing — bring a windproof jacket if heading uphill.
- Leave the cash at home. Norway is practically cashless — cards are accepted for coffee, postcards, and everything in between.
- Pre-book glacier transport. Taxis in Jondal are scarce. Book excursion buses or private transfers in advance — don't count on finding one on the dock.
