GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Direct alongside berth at Kahului Harbor — no tender required

Best For: Haleakalā volcano, Road to Hana, Molokini snorkel, Iao Valley

Walk to center: Queen Ka'ahumanu Center ~1.5 mi (20-30 min); not scenic — take a shuttle or rideshare

Don't Miss: Molokini Crater snorkel or a sunrise/day summit at Haleakalā National Park

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Road to Hana** — Maui's legendary 64-mile coastal highway winds through rainforest, past waterfalls, and black-sand beaches.
- **Haleakalā National Park Summit** — Drive to the 10,023-ft summit of a dormant shield volcano for sweeping crater views above the clouds.
- **Molokini Crater Snorkel** — This partially submerged volcanic crater off Maui's south coast is ranked among the world's best snorkel sites...
- **Iao Valley State Monument** — A lush valley with the iconic Iao Needle — a 1,200-ft green basalt spire rising from the valley floor.
- **Whale Watch Cruise (Dec–Apr)** — Kahului Harbor is right in the middle of North Pacific humpback whale winter grounds.

BEST WALKS

- **Iao Valley Loop** 1.2 miles | Easy | Paved paths — Short paved loop through lush Iao Valley with views of the Iao Needle spire.
- **Paia Town Stroll** 0.5 miles | Easy | Flat — Walk the main strip of Paia town from the iconic Paia Fish Market along Baldwin Avenue's galleries, boutiques, and juice bars toward...

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Rent a car for flexibility. Maui's best sights are spread out. Book your rental at Kahului Airport (OGG) well in advance — availability is tight on ship days.
- Reef-safe sunscreen only. Hawaii bans sunscreens containing oxybenzone and octinoxate. Buy reef-safe SPF 50+ before you arrive or at a local store.
