TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Wat Nokor Bachey** — A 12th-century Angkorian temple built in sandstone and laterite — with a vibrant modern Buddhist pagoda (built in the...
- **Koh Pen Island Bicycle Loop** — Cross to this large Mekong island — by the concrete bridge (dry season bamboo bridge version sometimes rebuilt for...
- **Phnom Pros & Phnom Srei (Man & Woman Hills)** — Two facing hills wrapped in Khmer legend about a competition between men and women.
- **Chup Rubber Plantation** — One of Southeast Asia's largest rubber plantations, established by the French Compagnie du Cambodge in the 1920s.
- **Riverside Café & Market Walk** — Start at Phsar Thom (Central Market) for an unfiltered wet-market experience, then work your way to the riverfront for...

BEST WALKS

- **Riverside Promenade & Central Market** 1.5 km · 30-40 min · Flat · Free — A simple stroll from the ship landing along Preah Sihanouk Boulevard, past French colonial facades and riverside cafés, ending at the...
- **Koh Pen Island Walk** 2-4 km on island · 1-2 hrs · Flat · Free (bridge crossing) — Cross the bridge to Koh Pen Island and walk the dirt paths through the stilt-house village.

- Use crisp USD bills. US dollars are widely accepted but Cambodians will refuse ripped, torn, or heavily folded notes. Change is often given in Cambodian Riel (4,000 KHR ≈ \$1).
