GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Kampot International Tourism Port (opened 2025) or Container Port, both ~6 km southeast of town

Best For: Pepper farm visits, French colonial architecture, cave temples, and day trips to Kep

Walk to center: Not walkable from port — \$3-5 tuk-tuk to the riverside (~15 min)

Don't Miss: La Plantation pepper farm, Phnom Chhngok Cave Temple, and green pepper crab in Kep

 Getting around:  **Rideshare**  **Grab**, PassApp

TOP THINGS TO DO

- La Plantation Pepper Farm** — Kampot pepper holds GI status (like Champagne) and La Plantation is the most visitor-friendly farm.
- Phnom Chhngok Cave Temple** — A pre-Angkorian Hindu brick temple dating to the 7th century, dedicated to Shiva, sits inside a limestone cave about...
- Kep Crab Market & Beach** — The fishing village of Kep, 30 minutes away, is famous for its open-air Crab Market.
- Bokor Mountain (Bokor National Park)** — A highland road climbs to the eerie abandoned Bokor Palace Hotel — a French colonial ruin wrapped in cloud forest...
- Kampot Colonial Town Walk** — Stroll the riverside French Quarter past faded yellow colonial buildings, the Old Market (Phsar Chas), and the iconic...

BEST WALKS

- Riverside French Quarter Loop** 1.5-2 km · 30-45 min · Easy — A relaxed circuit through Kampot's most atmospheric streets.
- Salt Fields Walk** Easy · Best Nov-Apr — Cross the Entanou Bridge to the island opposite downtown Kampot to see the gleaming salt pans.

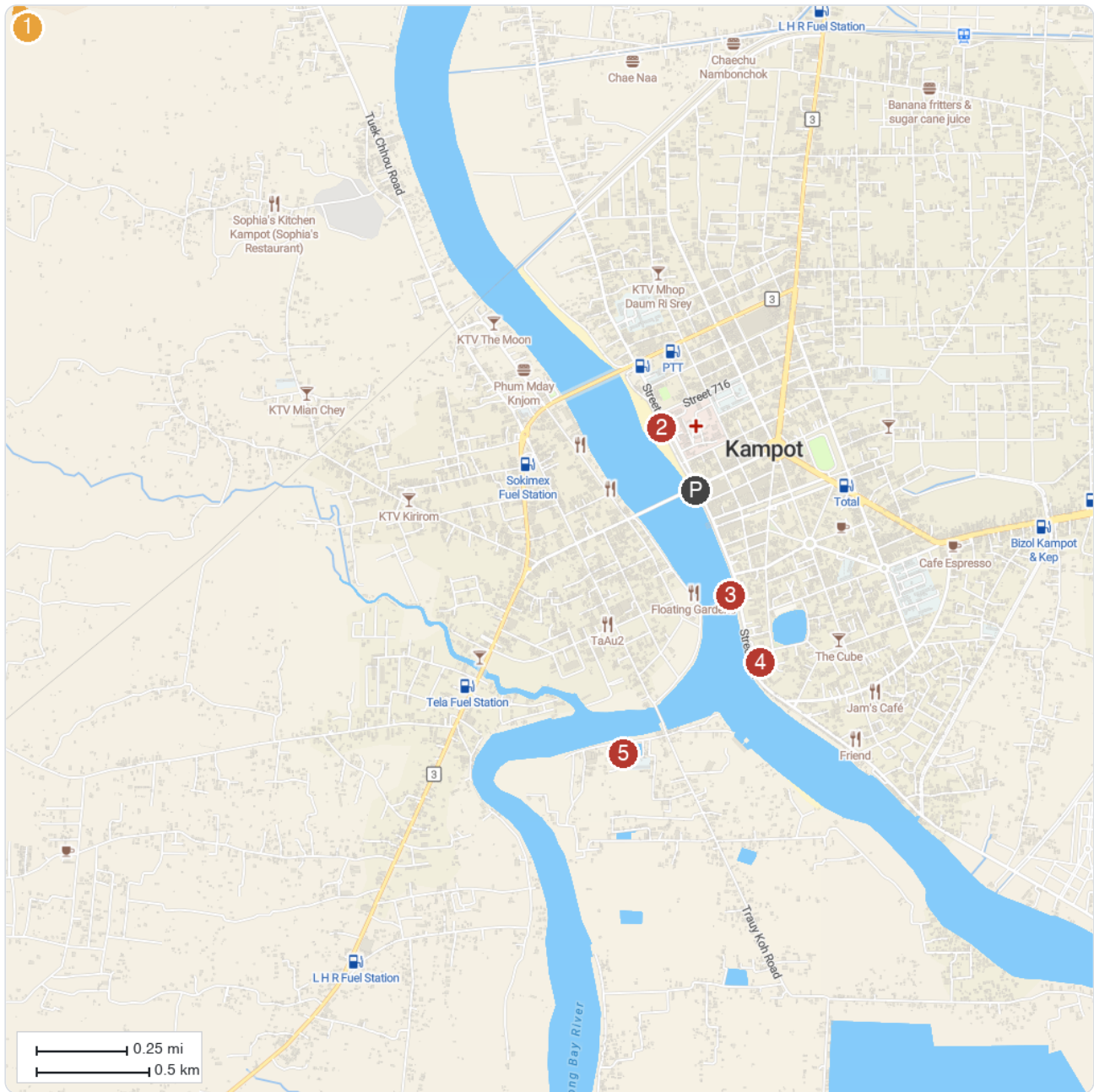
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- USD is king — but bring crisp bills. US dollars are accepted everywhere in Kampot, but merchants reject any note with a crease, tear, or ink mark. Change arrives in Cambodian Riel.
