Kastellorizo (Megisti) is Greece's most remote island — a car-free gem of pastel neoclassical mansions, piercing blue water, and a Blue Grotto so vivid it almost doesn't look real. Small ships only, and an experience unlike anywhere else in the Aegean.

GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender — ships anchor in Megisti Bay; tender to the harbour front

Best For: Blue Grotto, harbour photography, slow taverna lunches, history

Walk to Centre: 0 min — tender lands you directly on the waterfront promenade

Don't Miss: Boat to the Blue Grotto (€10–20 pp) and resident sea turtles at the quay

Getting around: **Taxi** €15 (village ↔ airport)

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Blue Grotto (Galazio Spilaio)** — One of the Mediterranean's most spectacular sea caves.
- Castle of the Knights (Castello Rosso)** — The 14th-century castle of the Knights of St.
- Lycian Rock Tomb** — The only Lycian-style monumental rock tomb in Greece, carved into the cliff face near the castle entrance.
- Mosque Museum** — A beautifully restored Ottoman mosque at the harbour entrance now serves as a small museum showcasing local costumes...
- St. George Islet Water Taxi** — A 5-minute water taxi (€5–10 return) takes you to this tiny islet just outside the harbour, complete with a whitewashed...

BEST WALKS

- Harbour Promenade & Town Loop** 1.5 km · 20–25 min · Flat — Walk the full crescent of the pastel neoclassical waterfront from the tender quay, past the Lycian rock tomb, up to the Mosque Museum...
- Castle & Mandraki Cove** 2 km · 45–60 min · Some steep steps — From the harbour, climb the steps to Castello Rosso for harbour views, then descend the other side towards Mandraki — the island's...

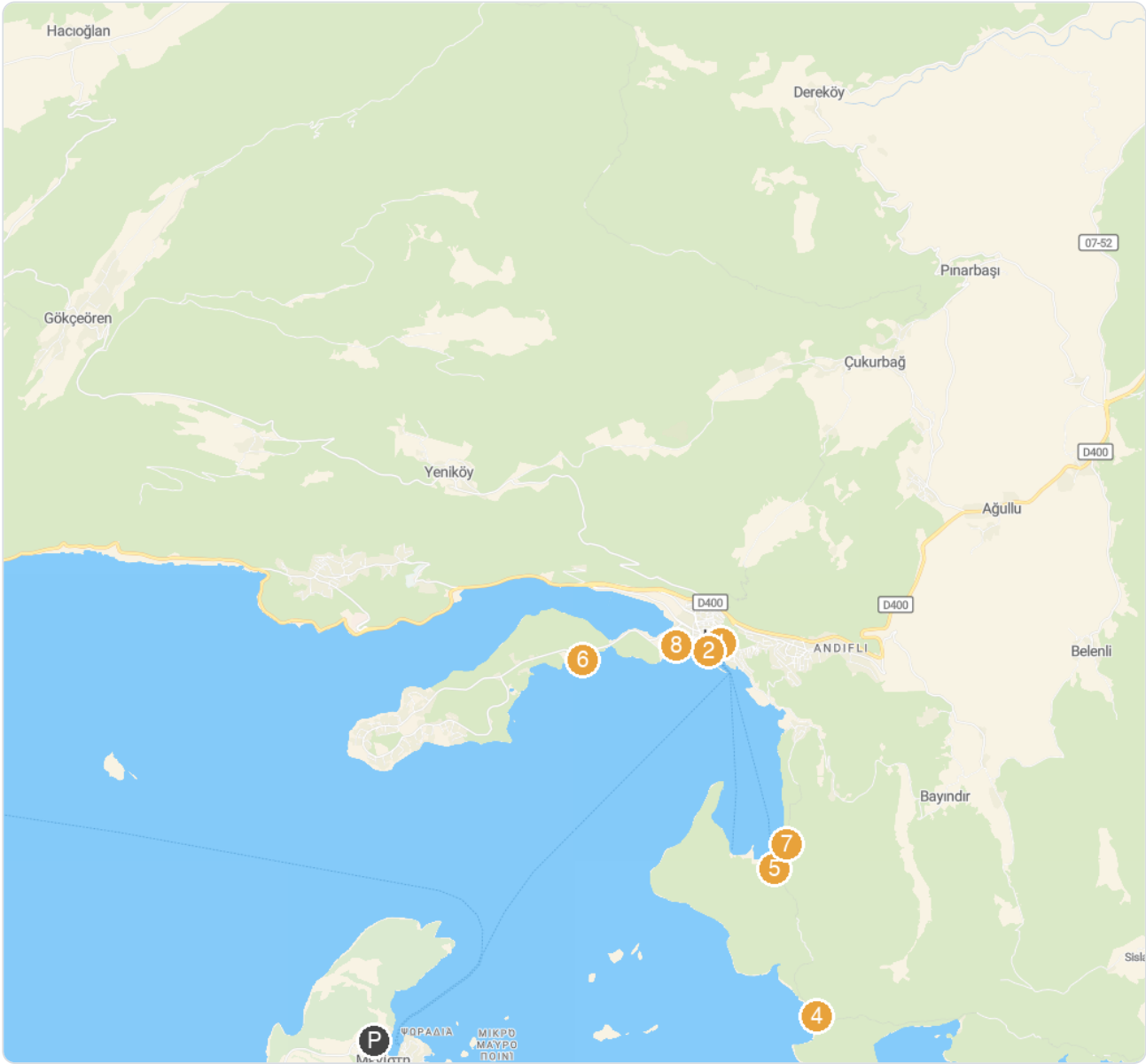
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Switch off data roaming: Turkey is 2 km away. Your phone almost certainly will latch onto a Turkish carrier (Turkcell/Vodafone TR) — and Turkey isn't in the EU, so data costs can...
- Bring small cash: There is only one ATM on the island, on the harbour front. Card payments work in most tavernas but local skiff operators for the Blue Grotto are cash only.
