TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Taipei City Highlights** — Taipei 101's observatory, Chiang Kai-shek Memorial Hall, and the National Palace Museum's imperial art collection — the...
- **Jiufen Old Street** — Narrow, lantern-lit lanes, atmospheric teahouses perched above the sea, and hillside alley shops — this former...
- **Yehliu Geopark** — Bizarre sea-eroded rock formations along the north coast, including the famous 'Queen's Head' mushroom rock.
- **Shifen Sky Lanterns & Waterfall** — Write a wish on a paper sky lantern and release it over Shifen Old Street's railway tracks, then walk to the Shifen...
- **Keelung Miaokou Night Market** — One of Taiwan's most famous food markets, operating day and night beside the Dianji Temple.

BEST WALKS

- **Pier to Miaokou Night Market** 0.5 km · 5 min · flat · all abilities — Exit the terminal onto Gangxi Road and walk inland to the Dianji Temple precinct — you'll smell the food stalls before you see them.
- **Harbour Waterfront & Keelung Tower** 1.5 km · 20 min · flat · scenic — Stroll the harbour promenade past fishing boats and seafood restaurants to the Keelung Tower at Maritime Plaza — ride the free...
- **Zhongzheng Park & Guanyin Statue** 2 km round-trip · 45 min · uphill · good views — From the terminal walk to the base of Zhongzheng Park and climb the zigzag steps (or take a short taxi to the gate).

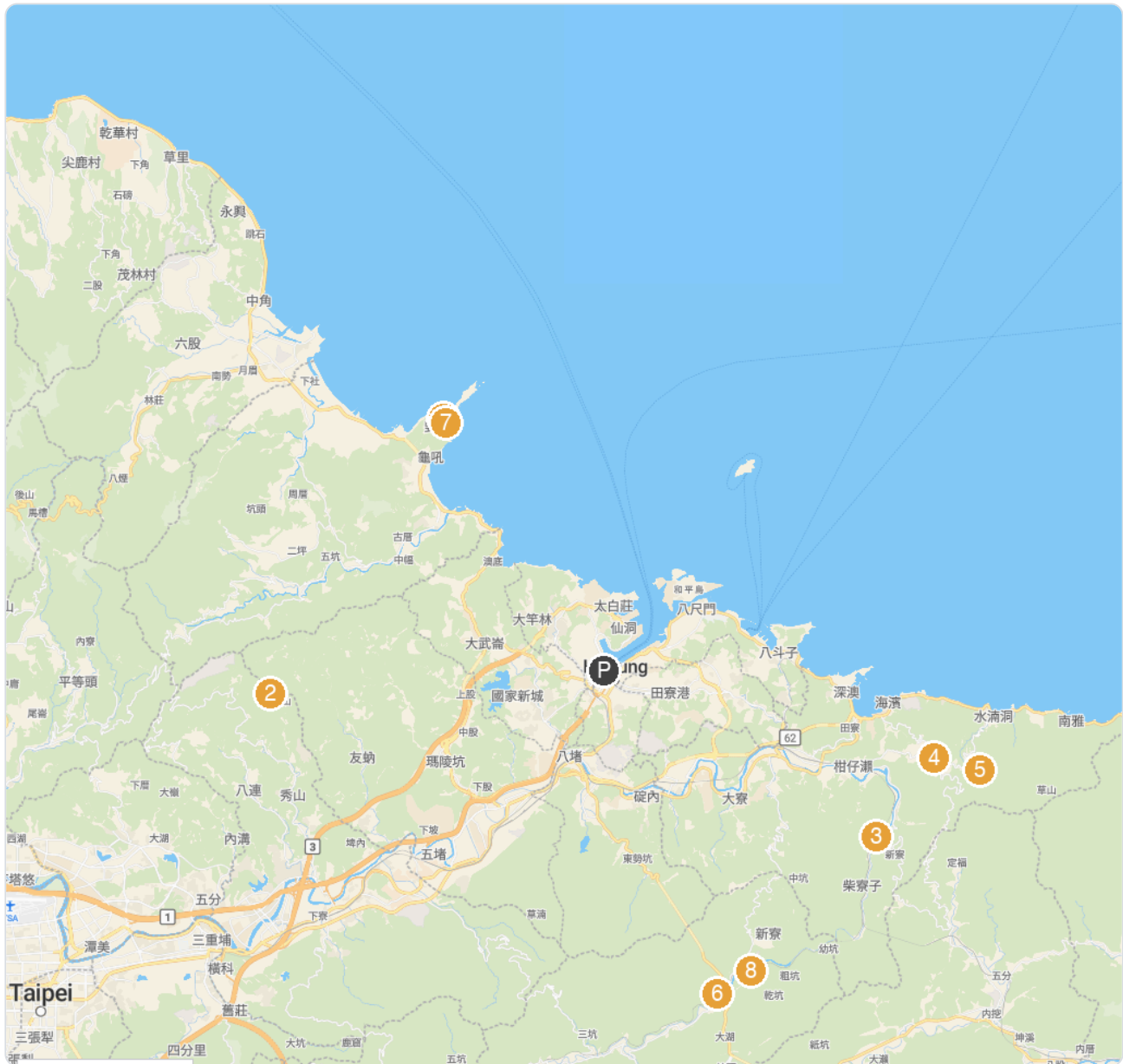
