GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Mallory Square Dock, Pier B (Truman Annex), or Navy Outer Mole — all docked, no tendering

Best For: Reef snorkeling, Old Town bars and history, walking Duval Street

Walk to center: Steps from Mallory/Pier B; 10-min shuttle from Navy Mole (complimentary)

Don't Miss: Mallory Square Sunset Celebration (if ship departs late afternoon or evening)

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Coral Reef Snorkeling** — The Florida Reef — the only living coral barrier reef in the continental U.S.
 - **Ernest Hemingway Home & Museum** — Tour the Spanish Colonial house where Hemingway lived and wrote classics like 'To Have and Have Not.' The roughly 60...
 - **Conch Tour Train or Old Town Trolley** — The fastest way to get an overview — narrated 90-minute loop through all of
- Key West's major sites.

 - **Kayak & Eco-Tour in the Backcountry** — Paddle through the mangrove islands of the Great White Heron National Wildlife Refuge north of Key West — a flat-water...
 - **Fort Zachary Taylor Beach** — The best beach accessible from the cruise port — clear water, good shade, and a historic Civil War fort.

BEST WALKS

- **Old Town Heritage Walk** 2 miles • 1-1.5 hrs • Easy/flat — The classic loop from the port through Key West's historic core — past Mallory Square, down Duval Street, to the Southernmost Point...
- **Historic Seaport & Waterfront Stroll** 1 mile • 30-45 min • Easy — Head east along the waterfront from the cruise piers through the Historic Seaport — charter boats, seafood shacks, and the lively...

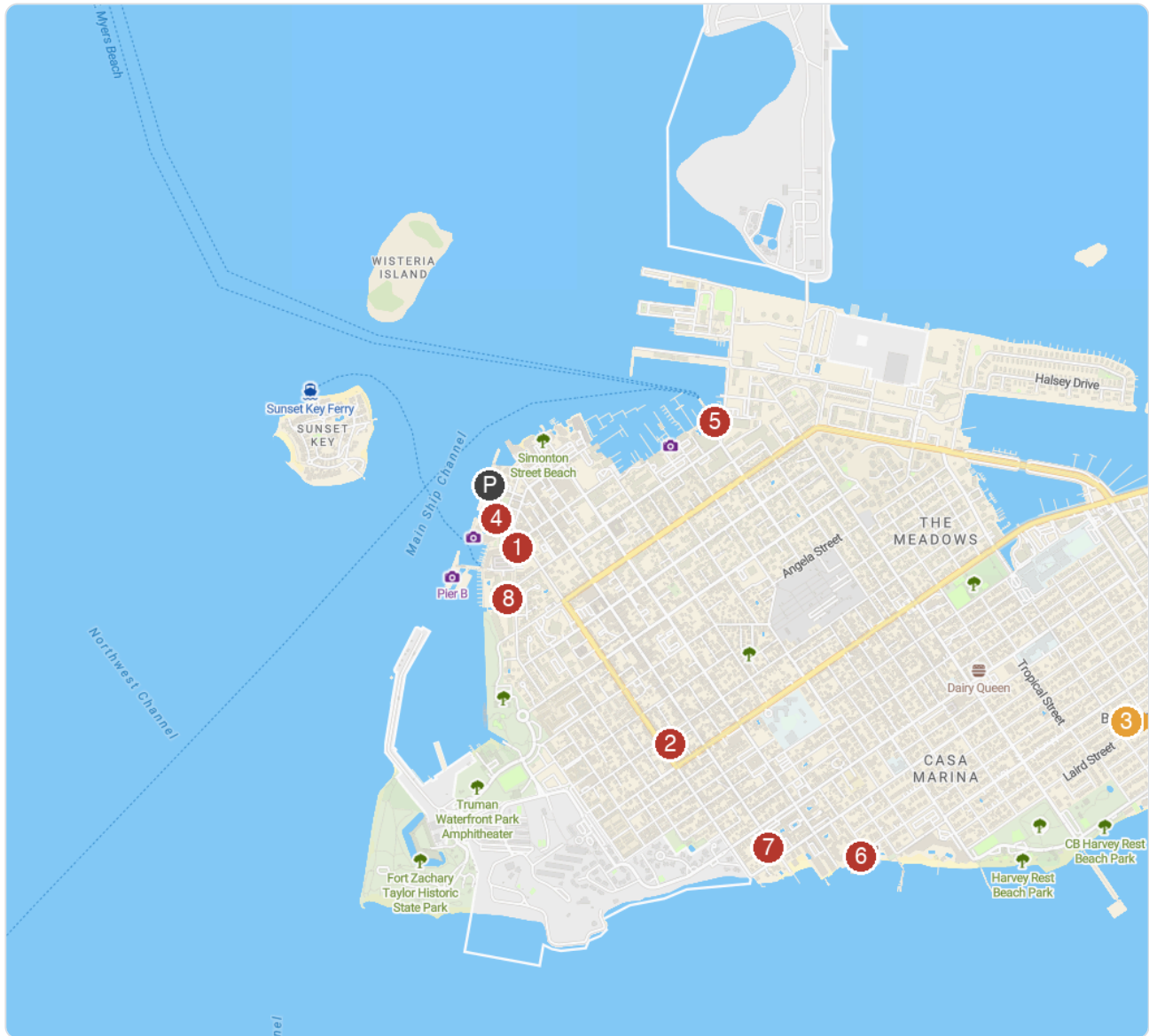
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Start early, beat the heat. Key West can be sweltering by midday in summer. Get out at 8-9 AM for the Hemingway House and beach; retreat to a bar around noon.
- Rent a bike or scooter. The whole island is flat and small — rentals are plentiful near all piers and let you cover more ground than
