TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Medieval Lübeck** — The UNESCO-listed Hanseatic old town on its island — the brick Holstentor gate, marzipan shops, and seven church spires.
- **Hamburg Day Trip** — Germany's great port city — the Speicherstadt warehouse district, the Elbphilharmonie, and the Reeperbahn, ~1.25 hours...
- **Kiel Canal & Holtenau Locks** — Watch ocean ships transit the locks where the world's busiest artificial waterway meets the Baltic — a maritime...
- **Laboe Naval Memorial & Beach** — Across the fjord, the towering Laboe Memorial and U-995 submarine, paired with a Baltic beach — reached by a scenic...

BEST WALKS

- **Kiellinie waterfront promenade** ~3 km · 1.5 hrs · easy — The pleasant fjord-side promenade from the city center, lined with sailing yachts, cafés, and views across the Kieler Förde.
- **Holstenstraße & old market** ~1.5 km · 1 hr · easy — Kiel's pedestrian shopping street up to the Alter Markt, the Nikolaikirche, and Barlach's 'Spirit Fighter' sculpture.
- **Schwentine fjord ferry ride** short ferry · 1–2 hrs · easy — Hop a fjord ferry from the city pier for a cheap mini-cruise across the harbour — a local's way to see Kiel from the water.

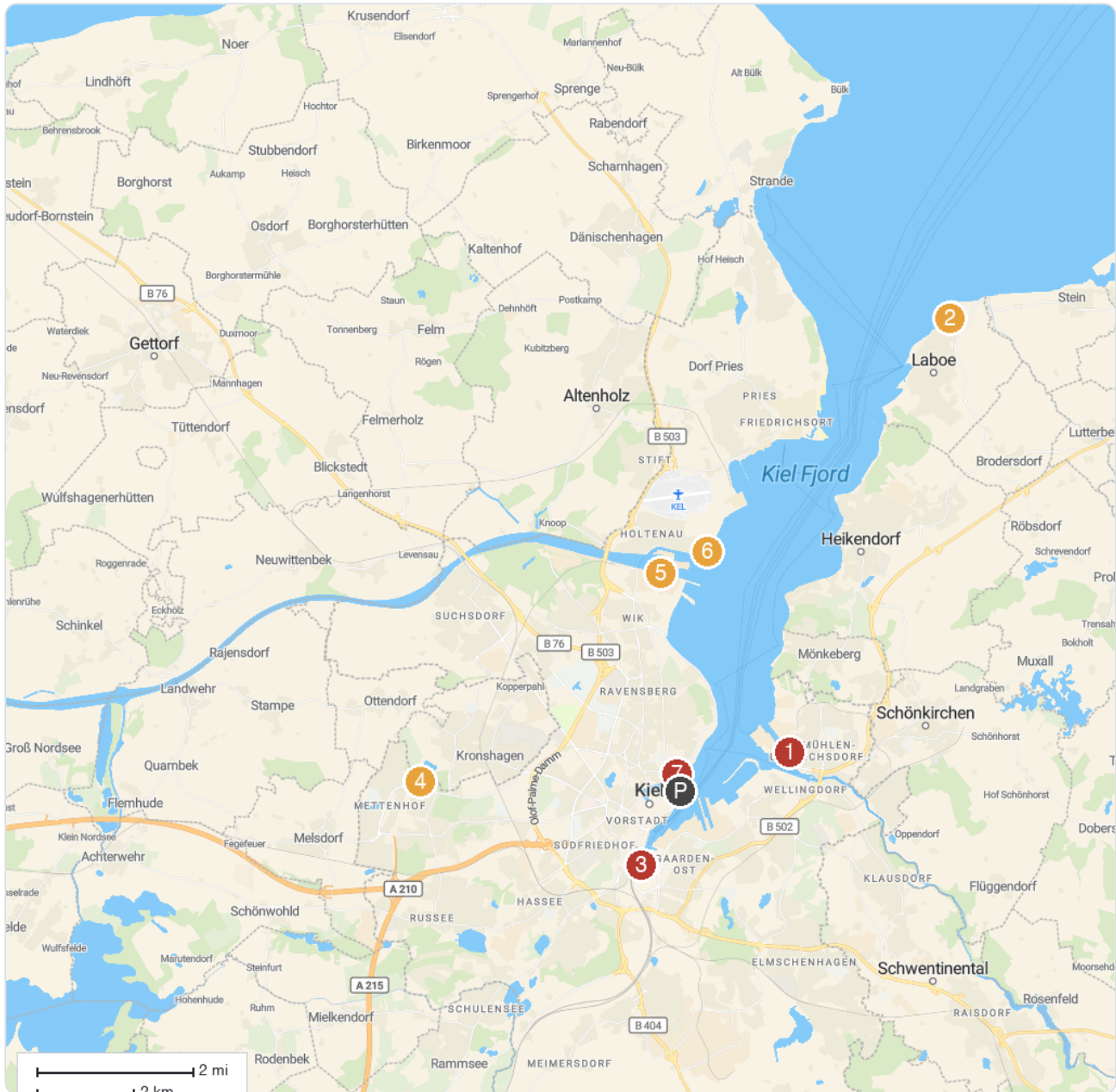
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Lübeck is the must-do. Just an hour by train, its UNESCO old town and marzipan are far more memorable than central Kiel — go independently or with a tour.
- Watch the Kiel Canal. If you love ships, the Holtenau locks where ocean vessels enter the canal are a genuinely unique spectacle.
- Bring euros. Germany still favors cash for small purchases — bakeries, markets, and snack stands may not take cards.
