Docking: Tender — no large cruise pier; tenders use marina docks

Best For: Hiking, wilderness scenery, Canadian history, nature photography

TOP THINGS TO DO

- The Crack Hike, Killarney Provincial Park** — The park's signature day hike climbs a dramatic quartzite fissure to jaw-dropping views over the La Cloche Mountains...
 - Kayak or Canoe on Georgian Bay** — Killarney Outfitters rents canoes and kayaks for exploring the sheltered inlets and islands along the bay's north shore.
- Village Walk & Killarney Museum** — Ontario's oldest north-shore settlement was founded in 1820 as a fur trading post.
 - Floatplane Scenic Flight** — Local floatplane operators offer scenic flights over the La Cloche Mountains, Georgian Bay islands, and the white...
 - Killarney Lighthouse Trail** — A 4.5 km return trail along the Georgian Bay shoreline to the historic Killarney East Lighthouse with panoramic bay...

BEST WALKS

- Village & Waterfront Stroll** 1 km · 20 min · Easy · Flat — From the marina tender dock, stroll past Herbert's Fisheries, the Killarney Museum, and along the Killarney Channel waterfront to...
- Killarney Lighthouse Trail** 4.5 km return · 1.5 hrs · Moderate · Rocky shoreline — Head east from the village along the Georgian Bay shore to the Killarney East Lighthouse.

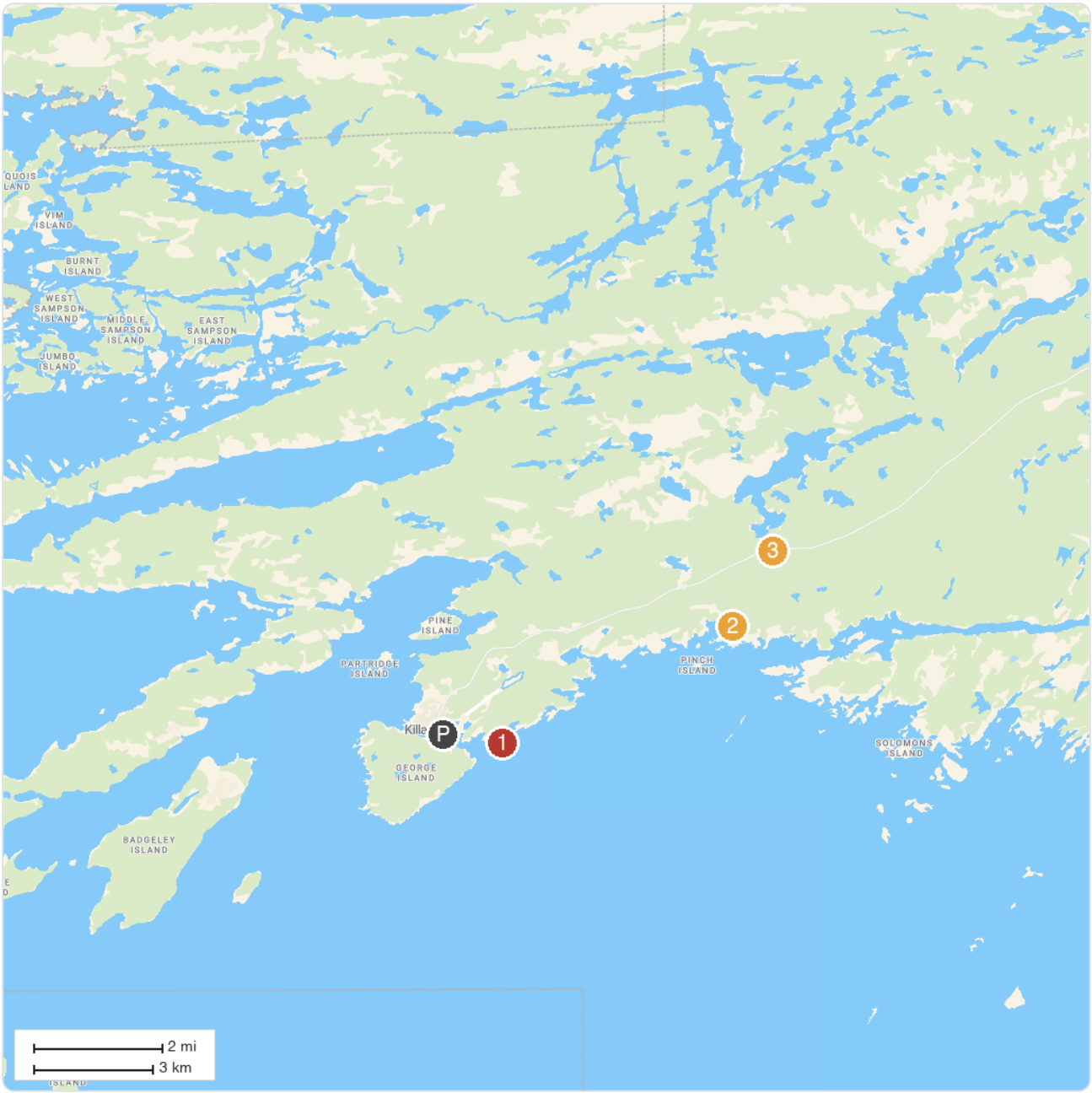
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Pack bug spray: Blackflies and mosquitoes are fierce June–August in northern Ontario. Bring DEET or Icaridin repellent — especially for any hiking.
- Wear hiking shoes: Even the village streets involve uneven granite rock and gravel paths. Sandals or heels are a bad idea.
