GETTING ASHORE

Docking: SeaWalk articulating floating pier at Port Royal — ship secures alongside the pier (walk off, no ship's tender)

Best For: Music history, pirate lore, authentic Jamaican food, beach day at Lime Cay

Walk to center: Port Royal village: 5 min on foot. Downtown Kingston: ~16 miles by taxi or ferry

Don't Miss: Gloria's Seafood for escovitch fish, Fort Charles & the Giddy House

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Fort Charles & the Giddy House** — Built in 1655, Fort Charles is Jamaica's oldest fort and the heart of pirate-era Port Royal.
- **Bob Marley Museum** — Marley's former home and recording studio at 56 Hope Road in Kingston.
- **Lime Cay Beach Day** — A short water taxi from Port Royal takes you to Lime Cay — a deserted white-sand cay with clear water and good...
- **Port Royal Walking Tour** — Explore the sleepy fishing village where 17th-century pirates once ruled.
- **Kingston Food & Culture Tour** — Devon House ice cream (one of the world's best), Chelsea Jerk Centre for authentic jerk chicken, and street-level...

BEST WALKS

- **Port Royal Heritage Walk** 1.5 km · 30-45 min · Easy — From the cruise pier, walk through the Port Royal Cruise Village into the old town.

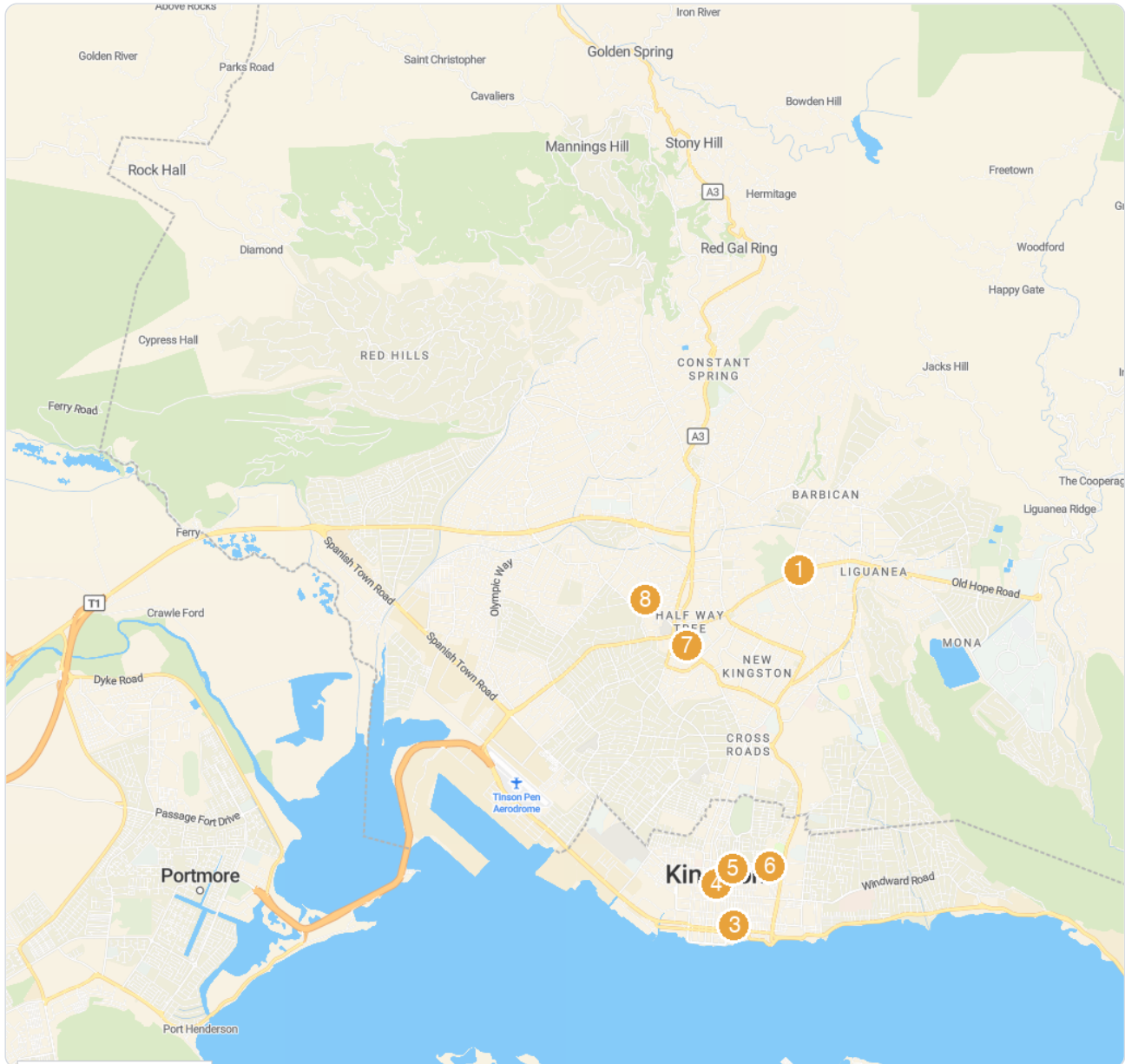
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Use JUTA taxis only. Registered JUTA taxis have red license plates. Avoid unlicensed drivers, especially in downtown Kingston. Your cruise director can arrange taxis or recommend...
- Leave Kingston early. Traffic on the Palisadoes road and in downtown Kingston can be severe. Build in at least 90 minutes of buffer before all-aboard — missing the ship here is an...
- USD works fine. US dollars are accepted nearly everywhere in Port Royal and Kingston tourist areas. Change may come back in...
