GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier — ships tie up at Rondout waterfront, no tender needed

Best For: Colonial history, Hudson Valley food & wine, maritime museums

Walk to center: Rondout district: steps from ship; Stockade Uptown: 2.5 mi (shuttle recommended)

Don't Miss: The four-corners stone houses of the Stockade District & Rondout Lighthouse boat tour

Getting around: **Taxi** \$15–\$25 · **Rideshare** Uber, Lyft

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Stockade District Walking Tour** — America's densest concentration of pre-Revolutionary stone houses fills a four-block grid Uptown.
- Rondout Lighthouse Boat Tour** — Board the solar-powered vessel Solaris at the Hudson River Maritime Museum for a short cruise out to the 1915 Rondout...
- Hudson River Maritime Museum** — Steps from the dock, this museum covers the Hudson's commercial history — ice harvesting, canal trade, and boat building.
- Trolley Museum of New York** — Vintage subway cars and trolleys plus a scenic 1.5-mile trolley ride along the Hudson to Kingston Point Park.
- Hudson Valley Farm-to-Table Lunch** — Kingston is a genuine food destination.

BEST WALKS

- Rondout Waterfront Loop** 1–1.5 miles · Easy · 30–45 min — From the dock, head east along the Rondout Riverfront Walk past the Maritime Museum and Trolley Museum, continuing to Kingston Point...
- Stockade District Four Corners Walk** 0.5 miles · Easy · 45–60 min — Take the shuttle Uptown.

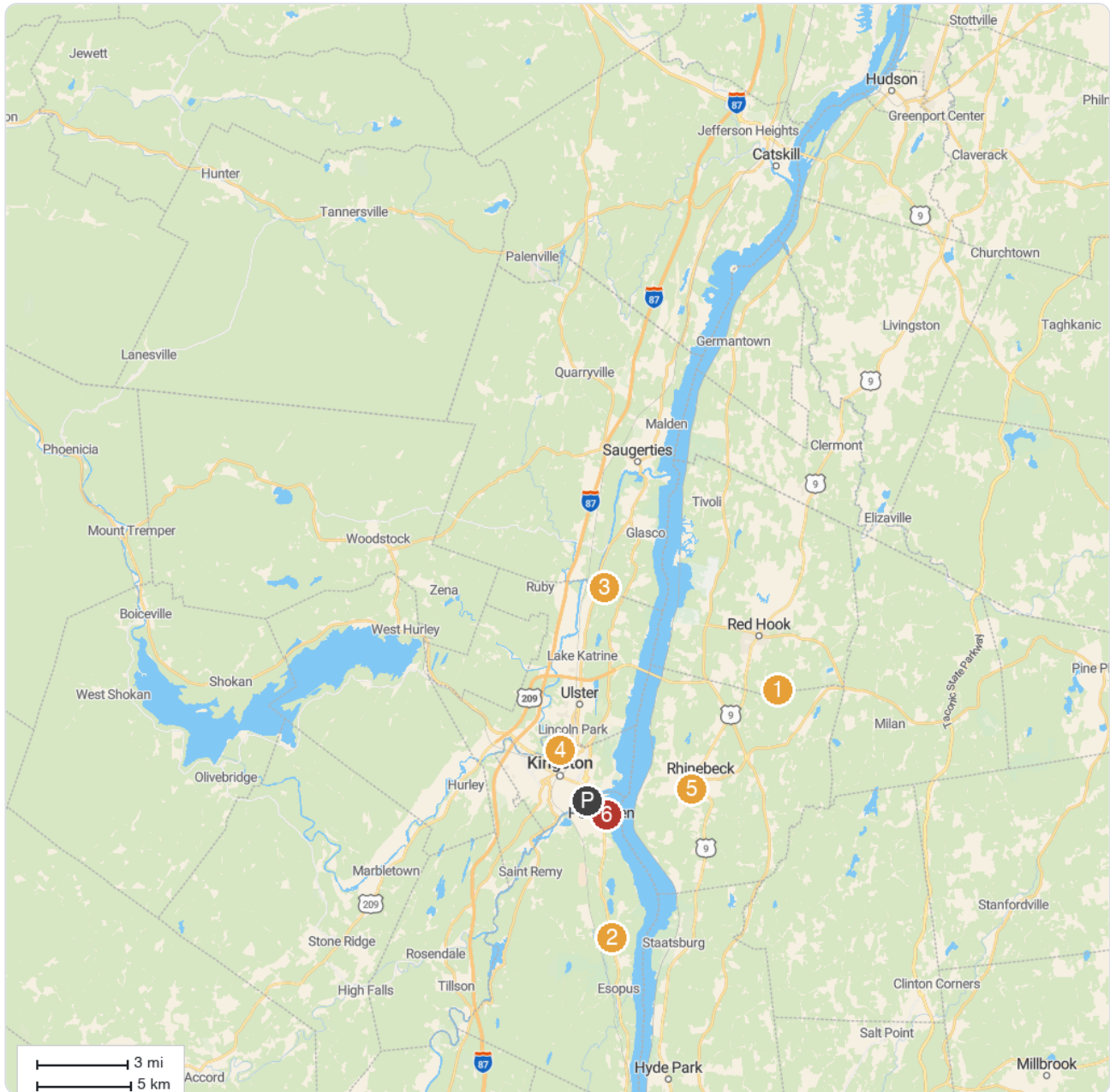
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Take the shuttle Uptown. The Stockade District is 2.5 miles uphill — not walkable in limited port time. Use the cruise line shuttle or grab a rideshare (allow 15–20 min wait time).
- Check shop & museum hours. Kingston has an independent-retail culture; many boutiques and some museums close Mon–Tue. Verify before you go.
