GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier — Crawford Wharf, 1 Brock St, directly downtown

Walk to centre: 0 min — City Hall is immediately adjacent to the dock

Don't Miss: Kingston Penitentiary tour (book ahead; ~3.5 km west of downtown) and Fort Henry National Historic Site

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Kingston Penitentiary Tour** — Canada's most notorious maximum-security prison closed in 2013 and opened to the public.
- **Fort Henry National Historic Site** — A UNESCO World Heritage Site crowning Henry Hill, this massive 19th-century British fort offers military drills...
- **1000 Islands Sightseeing Cruise** — Board a local sightseeing vessel from the wharf beside your ship and weave through granite islands dotted with castles...
- **Kingston Limestone Walking Tour** — Stroll a cityscape unlike any other in Ontario — 19th-century bylaws mandated local grey limestone for all major...
- **Canada's Penitentiary Museum** — Located in the former Warden's residence across from KP (about 3.5 km west of downtown), this small but absorbing...

BEST WALKS

- **Waterfront & Historic Core Loop** 2.5 km · ~45 min · Flat & easy — From the dock, cross into Confederation Park past Shoal Tower standing in the harbour.
- **Queen's University & Agnes Art Centre** 3 km · ~50 min · Flat — Head west from City Hall along King Street through the limestone downtown to Queen's University campus.

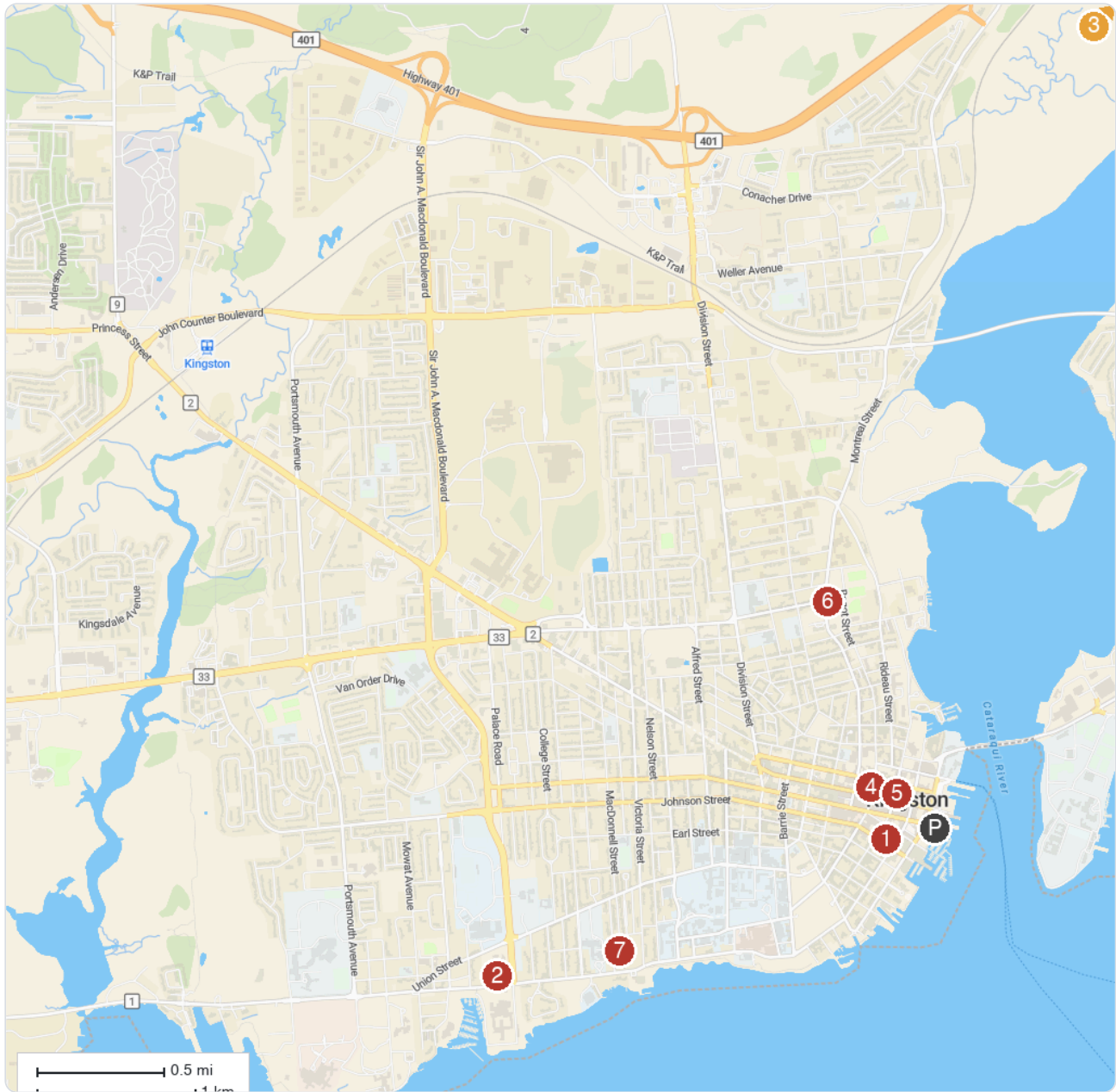
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- 1 St. George's Cathedral** Kingston's historic Anglican cathedral, a beautiful architectural landmark.
- 3 Rideau Canal, Locks 46 - 49 - Kingston Mills** See historic canal locks, a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- 5 Martello Alley** Discover local art in a charming, historic alleyway.
- 7 Bellevue House National Historic Site** Visit the home of Canada's first Prime Minister.

- 2 Canada's Penitentiary Museum (Correctional Service of Canada Museum)** Explore Canada's prison history in a former warden's house.
- 4 Sherlock's Escapes** Solve puzzles and escape themed rooms with your group.
- 6 Megaffin Park** Relax in this waterfront park with scenic views.
- P Cruise port / terminal**
