GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Nishikaigan Pier at Moji Port (walkable) or Hibiki Terminal (shuttle required)

Best For: History, retro architecture, local food, day-trip to Shimonoseki

Walk to center: 10-15 min from Moji Pier to Mojiko Retro; 15 min from Kokura Port to Kokura Station

Don't Miss: Yaki Curry in Mojiko, Kokura Castle, and the Kanmon Pedestrian Tunnel

Getting around: **Taxi** ¥4,000–¥6,000 · **Rideshare** Uber, GO · **Hop-on hop-off** Hop-on hop-off

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Mojiko Retro Waterfront Walk** — Stroll the preserved early-20th-century port district — ornate customs buildings, the Old Moji Mitsui Club where...
- Kokura Castle & Tanga Market** — Kokura Castle's rare design (5th floor wider than 4th) and the adjacent Edo-period garden make for a great morning.
- Kanmon Pedestrian Tunnel** — Walk 780 meters under the sea from Kyushu to Honshu — the only place in Japan you can cross islands on foot.
- Karato Market Fugu & Shimonoseki Day** — Hop the 5-minute Kanmon Kisen ferry to Shimonoseki and visit Karato Market — the world capital of fugu (pufferfish).
- Mount Sarakura Night Views** — Take the Sarakura cable car and slope car to a summit officially ranked among Japan's New Three Major Night Views.

BEST WALKS

- Mojiko Retro Heritage Walk** 1.5 km · 45–60 min · Easy · From the pier — From the cruise pier, walk north along the waterfront past the Blue Wing Moji drawbridge, take in the Former Moji Customs House and...
- Kanmon Tunnel Crossing** 2 km round trip · 1 hr · Easy · Free — Walk south from Mojiko along the waterfront to the tunnel entrance, descend the elevator, cross the 780-meter tunnel beneath the...

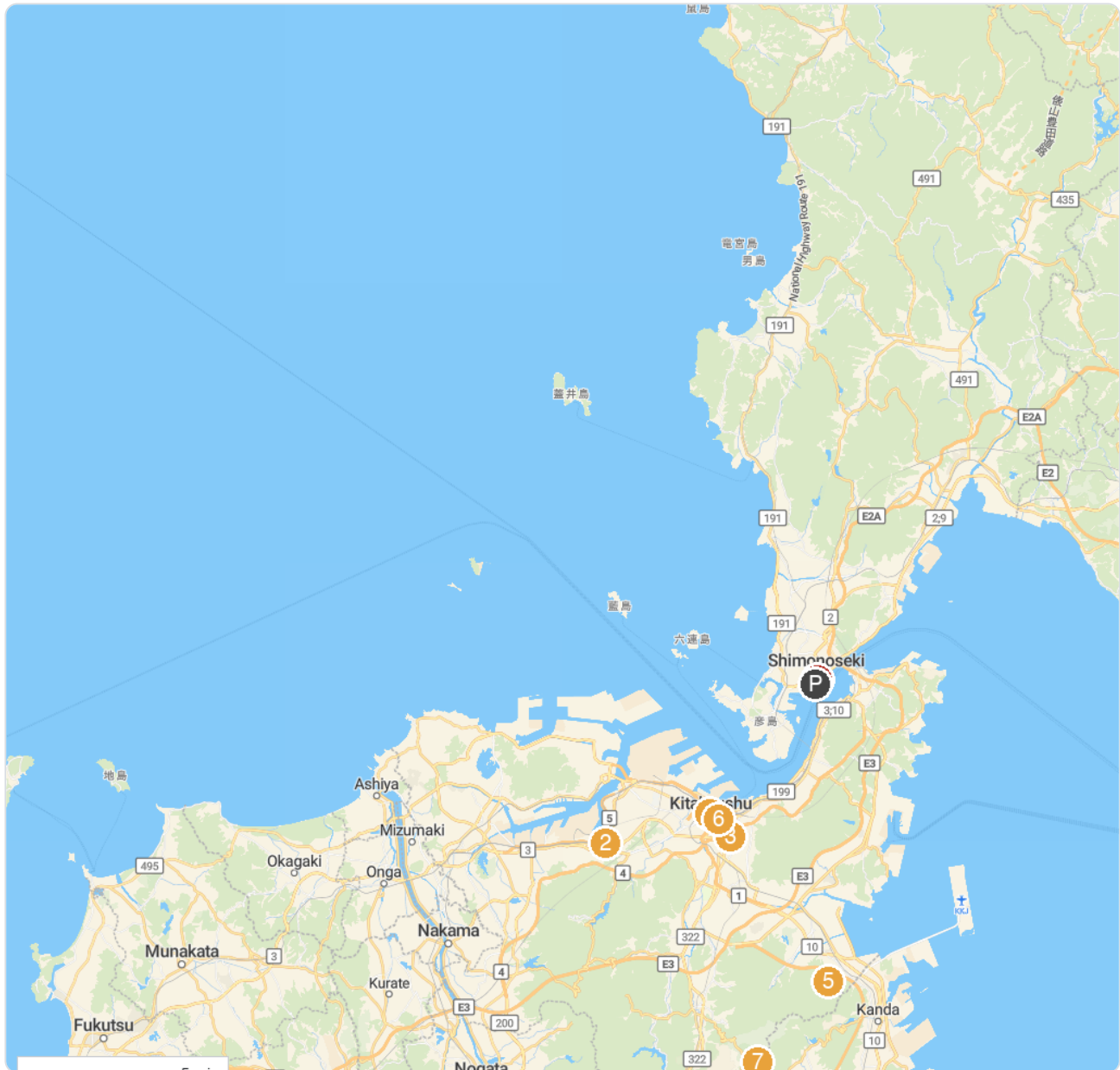
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
