GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Kobe: Shinko Pier No. 4 or Naka Pier (city-center, walk/Port Liner). Osaka: Tempozan Cruise Terminal (Bay Area, 8 km from Namba).

Best For: Kyoto day trips, Kobe beef, sake breweries, Osaka street food, Himeji Castle, Nara deer park

Walk to Center: Kobe Naka Pier → Meriken Park: 2 min; Sannomiya: 20 min walk or short bus ride. Shinko Pier → Sannomiya: 5-min Port Liner. Osaka terminal → Osakako Metro: 5-min walk.

Don't Miss: A sit-down Kobe beef lunch in the Kita-no district or a bowl of takoyaki in Dotonbori

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Kyoto Temples & Fushimi Inari** — Japan's cultural capital is ~25–30 minutes by train from Osaka and ~50 minutes from Kobe.
- **Himeji Castle** — 45 minutes from Kobe, Himeji is Japan's finest surviving feudal castle — a UNESCO World Heritage Site nicknamed the...
- **Nara Deer Park & Todai-ji Temple** — Nara Park is home to 1,200 free-roaming sacred deer that bow for rice crackers sold at the gate.
- **Kobe Beef Lunch in Kitano** — Kobe is the birthplace of the world's most marbled beef.
- **Osaka Castle & Dotonbori** — Osaka Castle anchors a hilltop park with a modern museum inside.

BEST WALKS

- **Kobe Waterfront Loop** 2.5 km · 45 min · Easy — From Naka Pier, stroll through Meriken Park past the Kobe Earthquake Memorial site and the striking latticed Kobe Port Tower (with...
- **Kitano Ijinkan (Foreign Settlement)** 1.5 km uphill · 30 min · Moderate — From Sannomiya, walk up through Kitano-cho to the well-preserved Meiji-era Western residences (ijinkan) once occupied by foreign...
- **Osaka: Tempozan Waterfront** 1 km · 20 min · Easy — If docked at Tempozan, the Osaka Aquarium Kaiyukan (one of Asia's largest, featuring a whale shark) is a 5-minute walk from the...

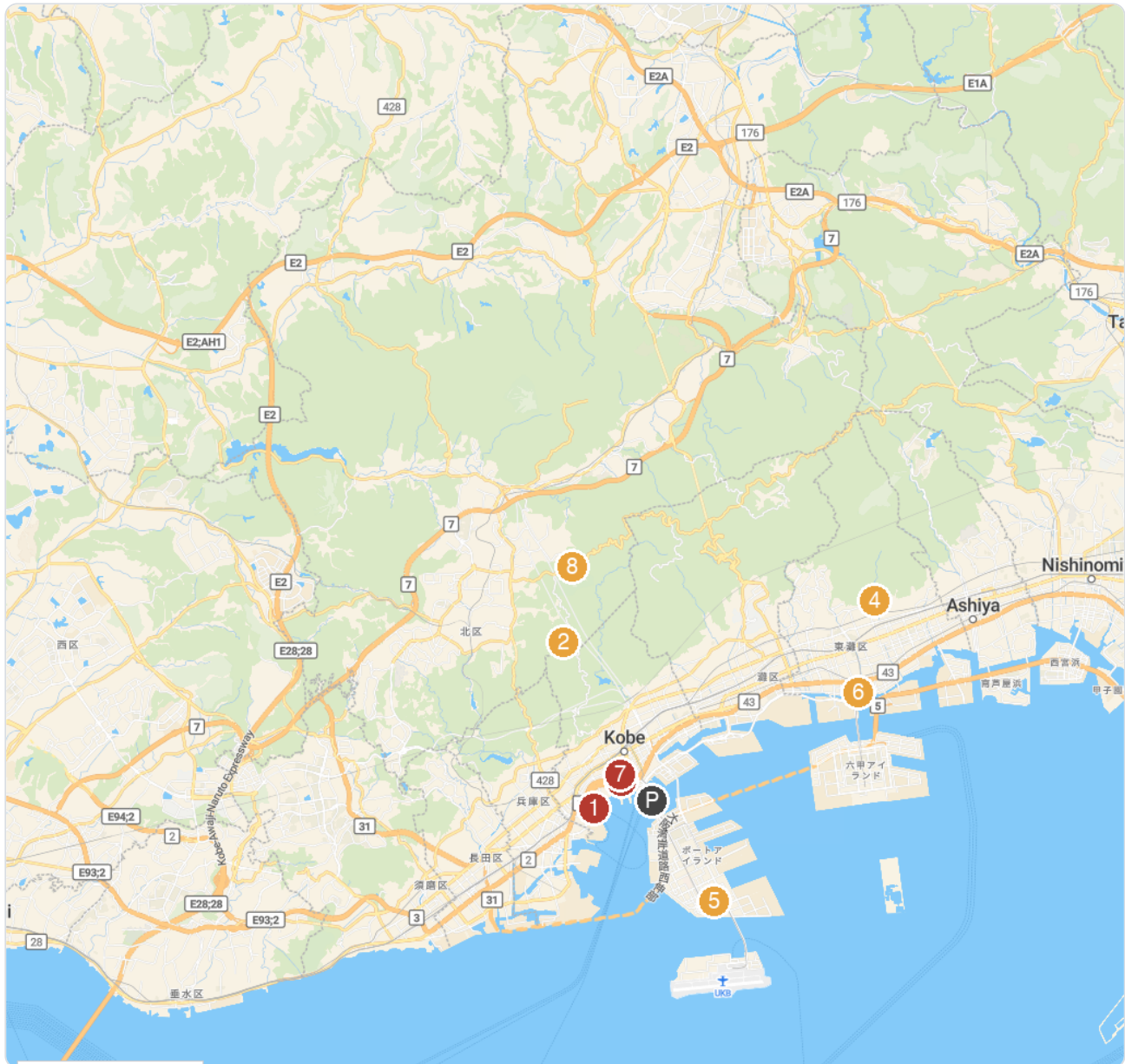
