GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier-side on Rhine (Konrad-Adenauer-Ufer) or Moselle (Peter-Altmeier-Ufer) — always docked, never tendered

Best For: History, Rhine wine, fortress views, scenic cable-car crossing

Walk to centre: 2–10 min flat walk from either dock to Deutsches Eck and the Altstadt

Don't Miss: Ehrenbreitstein Fortress via cable car — best panorama of the river confluence

 Getting around:  Taxi  €8–12 ·  Rideshare  Uber

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Ehrenbreitstein Fortress & Cable Car** — Glide across the Rhine in a gondola (look for Cabin 17 with its glass floor) to Europe's second-largest preserved...
- **Deutsches Eck & Altstadt Walk** — Stand at the tip of the headland where the Moselle slides into the Rhine beneath Kaiser Wilhelm's towering equestrian...
- **Weindorf & Moselle Wine Tasting** — Head to the Koblenz Wine Village — a half-timbered courtyard built for the 1925 German Wine Exhibition — for glasses of...
- **Stolzenfels Castle** — A textbook example of Rhine Romanticism, this neo-Gothic hilltop castle sits about 5 km south of the city.
- **Moselle River Cruise to Cochem** — Many operators offer a half-day boat excursion up the winding Moselle to Cochem, past terraced vineyards and medieval...

BEST WALKS

- **Promenade to Deutsches Eck & Altstadt** 1.5 km · 25 min · flat — From the Rhine pier, follow the promenade north past the Electoral Palace gardens to the Deutsches Eck headland.
- **Cable Car & Fortress Loop** Easy walk + cable car · 2–3 hrs — Walk from the pier to the cable car station (3 min), cross the Rhine to Ehrenbreitstein Fortress, explore the ramparts and museum...

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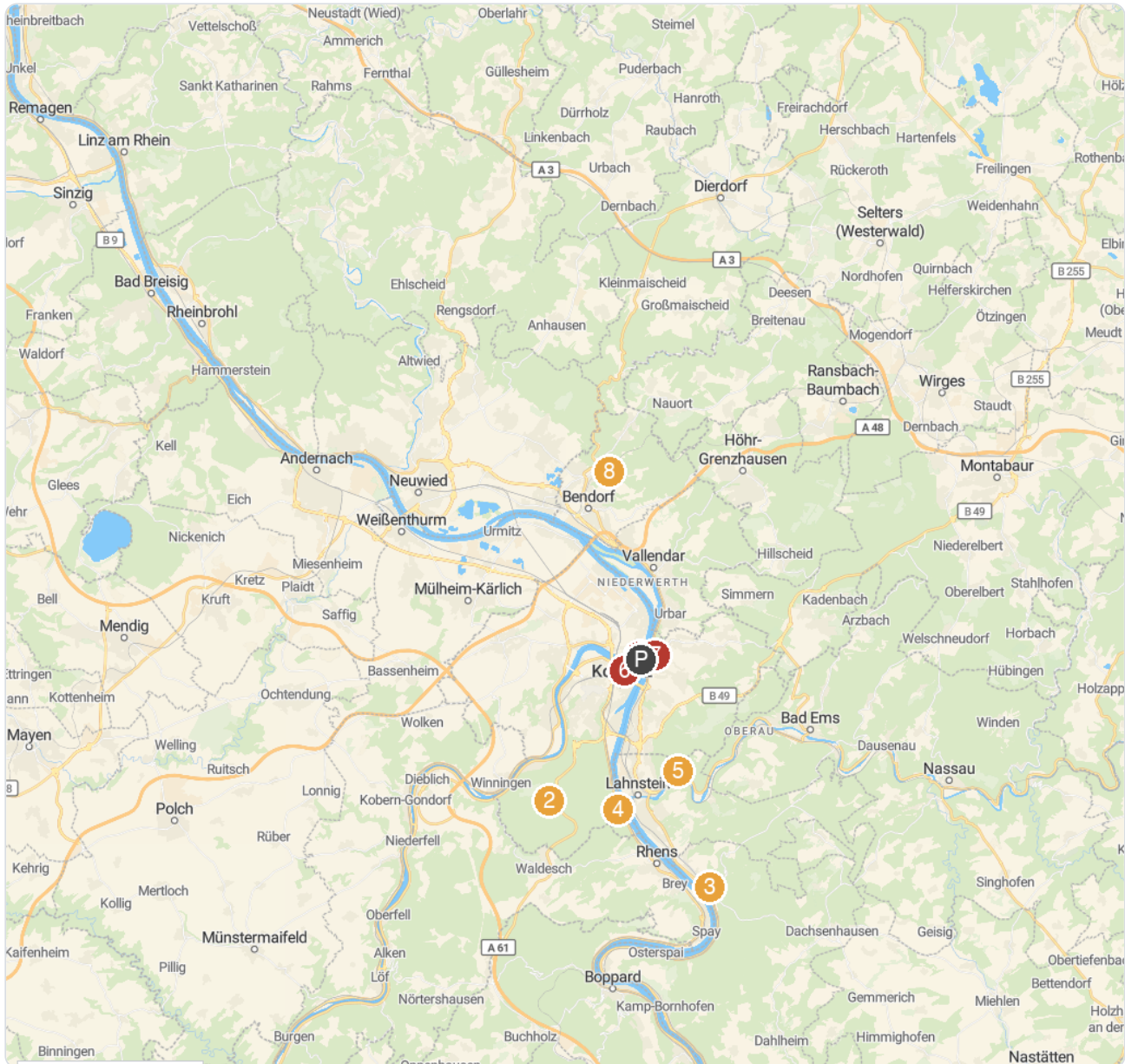
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
