Don't Miss: Alutiiq Museum, Holy Resurrection Cathedral, Fort Abercrombie WWII ruins

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Kodiak Bear Flightseeing** — The island's famous brown bears — largest in the world — live deep in the Kodiak National Wildlife Refuge.
 - Fort Abercrombie State Historical Park** — About 4 miles northeast of downtown (a ~10-minute taxi ride), this WWII coastal defense site hides concrete bunkers...
- Alutiiq Museum & Baranov Museum** — Two of Alaska's finest small museums sit within a short walk of each other downtown.
 - Halibut & Salmon Fishing Charter** — Kodiak is world-renowned for sport fishing.
 - Near Island Bridge & Harbor Walk** — A free, self-guided walk from downtown across the Near Island Bridge (the Fred Zharof Memorial Bridge — open to cars...

BEST WALKS

- Downtown Harbor Loop** 1.5 miles · Easy · ~45 min — From Pier II, stroll along the harbor past St.
- Near Island Bridge Walk** 1 mile · Easy · ~30 min — Head northeast from downtown across the Near Island Bridge (the Fred Zharof Memorial Bridge) connecting to Near Island.

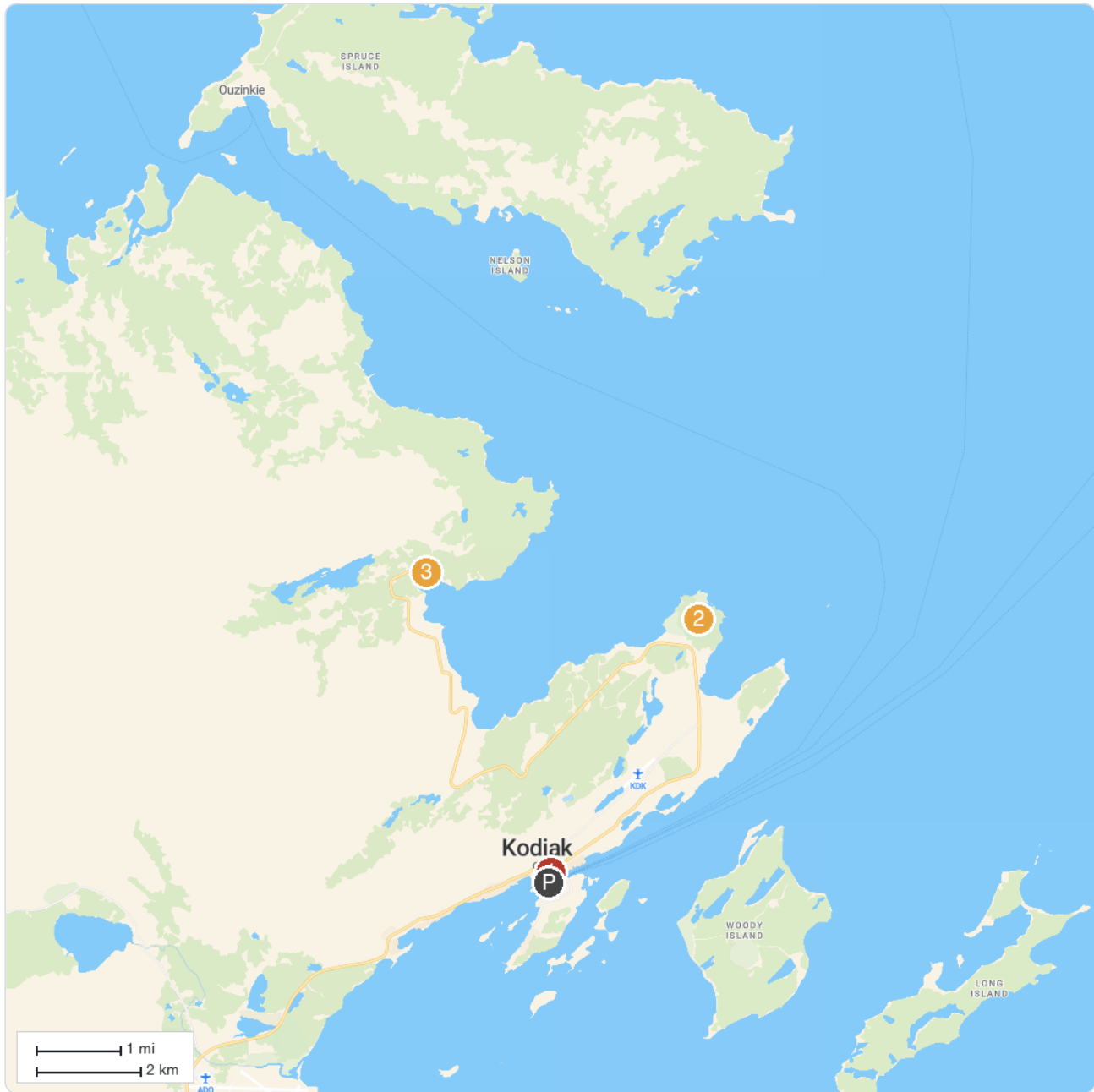
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Pack rain gear: Kodiak earns its 'Emerald Isle' nickname — it can rain any month. A waterproof jacket and waterproof footwear are essential, not optional.
- Bears are remote: You won't stumble onto a Kodiak bear near town. They live deep in the wildlife refuge interior — a floatplane excursion is the only realistic way to see one up close.
