## GETTING ASHORE

**Docking:** Ocean ships berth at Kidderpore Docks; river cruises dock at Millennium Park or Man-of-War Jetty

**Best For:** Colonial history, temple hopping, street food, and sensory immersion

**Walk to center:** Kidderpore: not walkable — take Uber/Ola or tour bus. River jetty: steps from BBD Bagh

**Don't Miss:** Victoria Memorial, Mullick Ghat Flower Market at dawn, Kumartuli potters' quarter

## TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Victoria Memorial & Gardens** — The crown jewel of Raj-era architecture — a vast white marble palace-museum built to honor Queen Victoria, set in lush...
- **Kumartuli Potters' Quarter** — A 300-year-old riverside neighbourhood where artisans hand-sculpt enormous clay idols of Hindu deities — especially the...
- **Colonial Dalhousie Square (BBD Bagh)** — The heart of British Calcutta, ringed by monumental Victorian and Edwardian public buildings — the Writers' Building...
- **Mother House & Mother Teresa's Tomb** — The global headquarters of the Missionaries of Charity is a quiet, contemplative space open to all visitors.
- **Mullick Ghat Flower Market at Dawn** — Asia's largest wholesale flower market operates under the Howrah Bridge from around 4 AM.

## BEST WALKS

- **River Jetty to BBD Bagh Colonial Circuit** 1.5 km | 20 min | Easy | River cruise passengers only — From Millennium Park Jetty, stroll north along the Strand riverfront, passing the Man-of-War Jetty, to Dalhousie Square (BBD Bagh).
- **Victoria Memorial to Park Street** 1.5 km | 20 min walk | Easy | All passengers (after transport to area) — From the Victoria Memorial gardens, walk north along Jawaharlal Nehru Road (Chowringhee) to Park Street — Kolkata's famous...

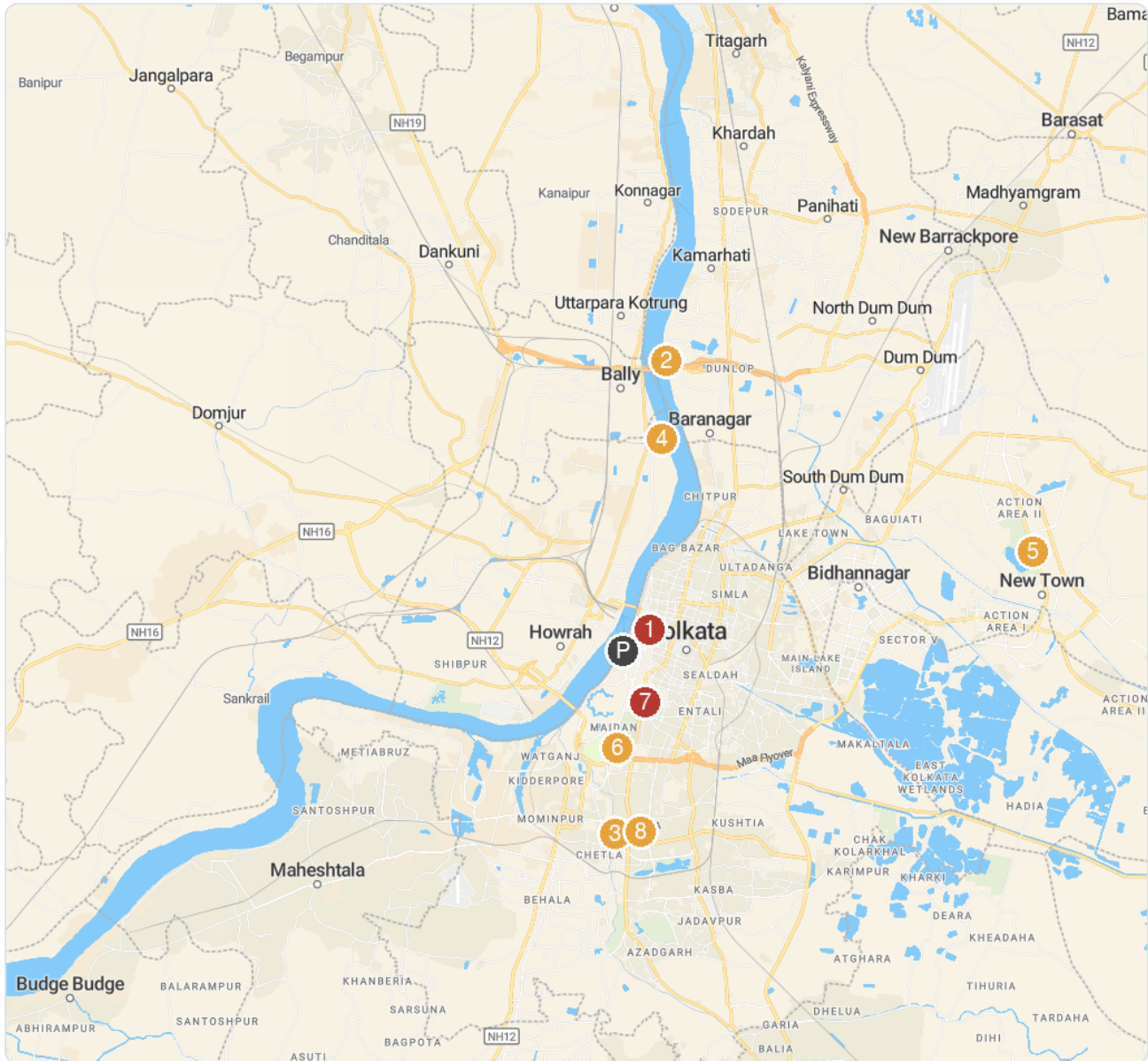
