GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Dedicated cruise terminal; ships dock directly — no tender needed

Walk to center: 5-10 min on foot to Tito Square and Old Town

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Postojna Cave & Predjama Castle** — Ride a miniature electric train through 24 km of stalactite-draped galleries at Postojna, then visit Predjama Castle...
- **Lake Bled & Ljubljana** — Full-day inland sweep: glacier-blue Lake Bled with its island church and clifftop castle, then Ljubljana's baroque Old...
- **Piran & Slovenian Riviera** — Drive 20 minutes to Piran — often called the most beautiful town on the Adriatic — with Tartini Square, Venetian walls...
- **Škocjan Caves (UNESCO)** — A UNESCO World Heritage karst cave with a thundering underground river canyon — more dramatic than Postojna for...
- **Koper Old Town Walk** — Self-guided stroll through the medieval Old Town: Tito Square, the Venetian Gothic Praetorian Palace, Cathedral of the...

BEST WALKS

- **Tito Square & Cathedral Loop** 2-3 hrs · Easy · Free — From the cruise terminal, walk north into the Old Town.
- **Waterfront Promenade** 1 hr · Easy — After the Old Town, follow the modern harbour promenade south from the terminal past the marina and small beach at Zusteria.

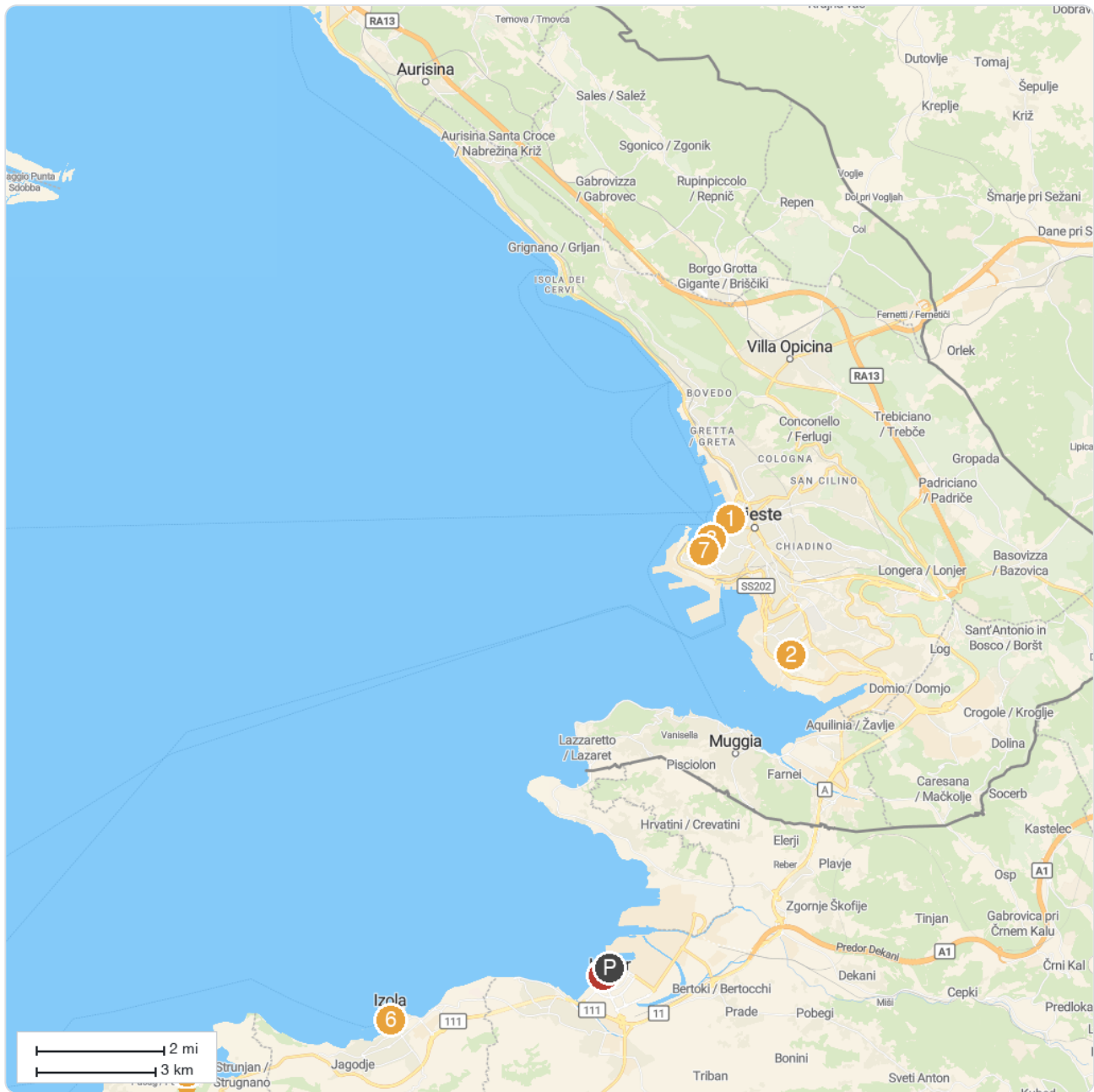
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
