GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier at Kota Kinabalu Port, Sepanggar Bay — 15-20 km from city center

To City Center: 30-45 min by taxi or Grab; no walkable city access from pier

Best For: Island snorkeling, Bornean tribal culture, wildlife parks

Don't Miss: DIY island hopping to Tunku Abdul Rahman Marine Park

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Island Hopping — Tunku Abdul Rahman Marine Park —** Five tropical islands sit just 15 minutes by boat from shore.
- Lok Kawi Wildlife Park —** The best option for seeing Borneo's iconic animals on a port day — proboscis monkeys, pygmy elephants, sun bears, and...
- Sabah Tribal Cultural Village Experience —** Step into the jungle and meet Sabah's five indigenous tribes — Kadazan-Dusun, Bajau, Lundayeh, Murut, and Rungus.
- White-Water Rafting on the Kiulu River —** The Kiulu River offers gentle Grade 1-2 rapids through Sabah jungle — accessible and family-friendly for non-experts...
- City Walk: Waterfront, Atkinson Clock Tower & Markets —** KK's compact center is best on foot once you get there.

BEST WALKS

- KK Waterfront to Atkinson Clock Tower** 1.5 km · 30 min · Flat — Start at the Marlin statue on the waterfront boardwalk, then walk south past the old Jesselton heritage buildings to the hilltop...
- Gaya Street Market Stroll** 0.8 km loop · 20-30 min · Flat — Browse the main shopping street for Bornean pearls, batik sarongs, handicrafts, and local snacks.

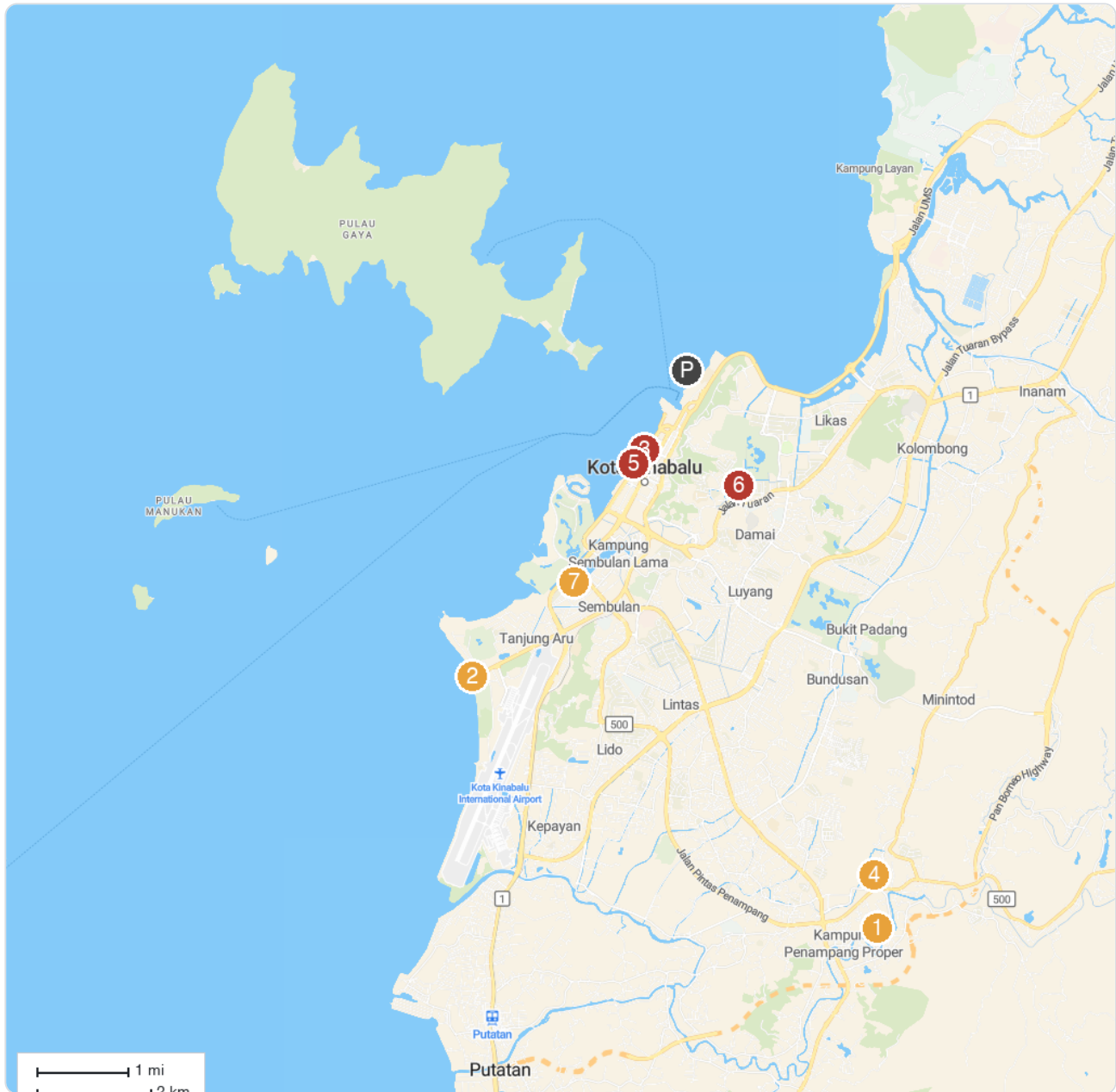
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
