TOP THINGS TO DO

- Maritime Centre Vellamo** — A wave-shaped architectural landmark right at the Kantasatama pier, housing the Maritime Museum of Finland and Museum...
- Sapokka Water Garden** — Consistently ranked among Finland's most beautiful parks, Sapokka features a near-20-meter waterfall, rock sculptures...
- Langinkoski Imperial Fishing Lodge** — Built in 1889 for Tsar Alexander III, this wooden riverside lodge sits among rushing rapids in a nature reserve.
- Maretarium Aquarium** — A unique freshwater and Baltic Sea aquarium focused entirely on Finnish fish species.
- Katariina Seaside Park & Beach** — A former oil harbor transformed into a sweeping recreational park with ruins of Fort Katarina, a giant labyrinth, and...

BEST WALKS

- City Center & Sculpture Promenade** 1.5 km · 30 min · Easy · Free — Walk from the pier along Keskuskatu — Finland's largest outdoor sculpture gallery — to the Market Square, then loop through Sibelius...
- Vellamo to Sapokka Water Garden** 2 km · 40 min · Easy · Free — Start at the Maritime Centre Vellamo, walk south along the waterfront promenade, and arrive at the award-winning Sapokka Water Garden...

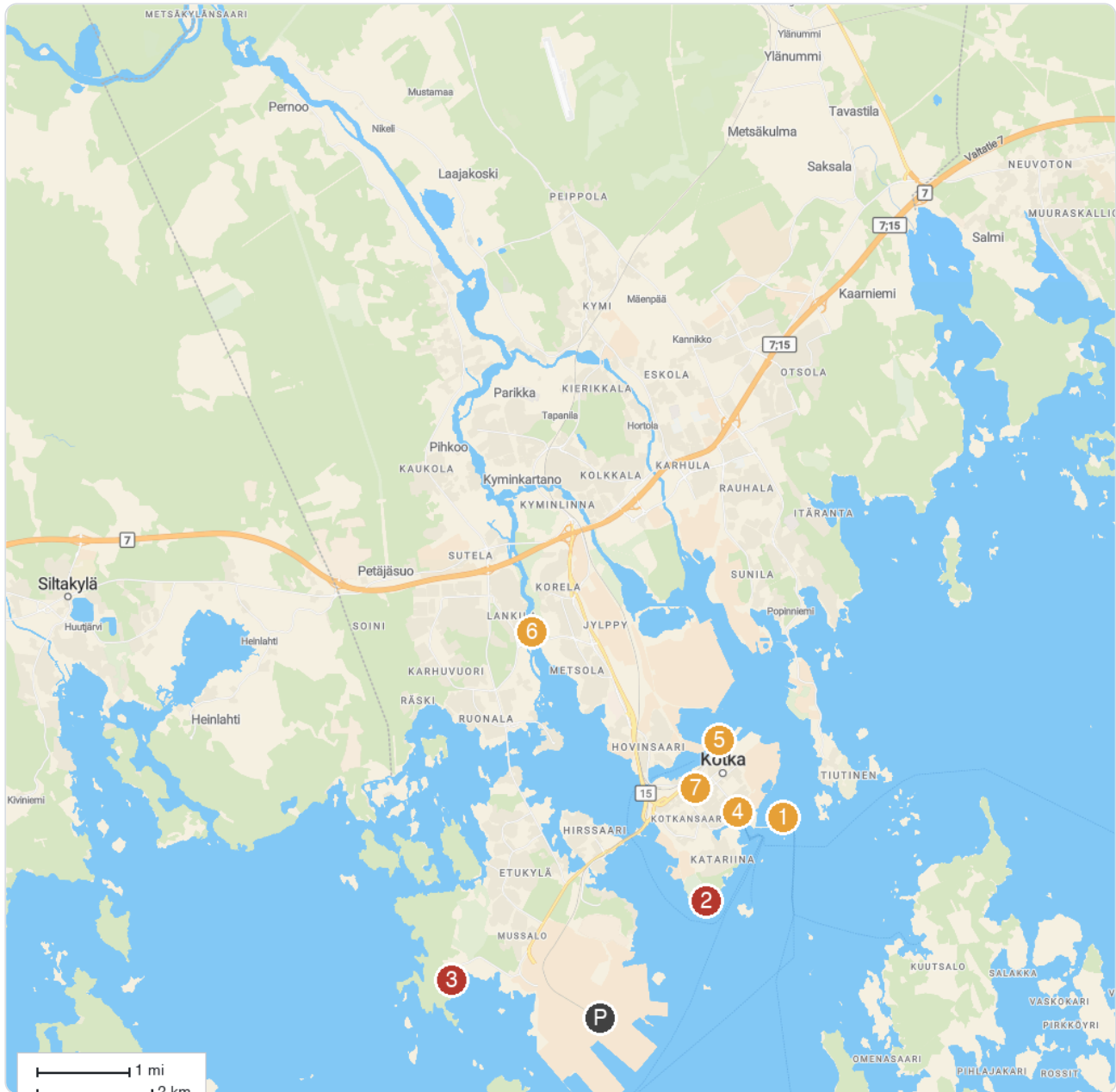
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
