GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Smaller ships dock alongside the quay by the Old Town walls; larger or overflow ships anchor in the bay and tender 5-20 min to Park Slobode pier

Best For: History lovers, fortress hikers, photographers, and anyone who likes cats

Walk to center: 2-5 min from the dock/tender pier to the Sea Gate — you can see the walls from where you land

Don't Miss: The 1,350-step hike to Fortress of San Giovanni and the boat trip to Our Lady of the Rocks island

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Kotor Old Town Self-Guided Walk** — Wander the marble lanes of the walled Old Town: Arms Square and the 1602 Clock Tower, the Romanesque Cathedral of Saint...
- **Fortress of San Giovanni Hike** — Climb roughly 1,350 uneven stone steps up the ancient city walls to the ruined Fortress of San Giovanni at 280 m, with...
- **Perast & Our Lady of the Rocks Boat Tour** — A speedboat from City Park (100 m from the tender pier) whisks you 20-30 minutes to the Baroque village of Perast, then...
- **Lovćen National Park & Njegoš Mausoleum** — A winding drive up the Austro-Hungarian serpentine road — 25 hairpin bends above Kotor — leads to Lovćen National Park...
- **Blue Cave Boat Tour** — A sea cave on the Lustica Peninsula where sunlight filters through the water and reflects off the white sandy bottom...

BEST WALKS

- **Old Town Loop** 1-1.5 hrs | Flat marble cobblestones | Easy — A full circuit of the compact Old Town hitting all the main squares, churches, and wall viewpoints.
- **Fortress of San Giovanni Climb** 1.5-2 hrs round trip | ~1,350 steps | Strenuous — Follow signage inside the Old Town walls to the staircase entrance and ascend the ancient city wall to the ruined Fortress of San...

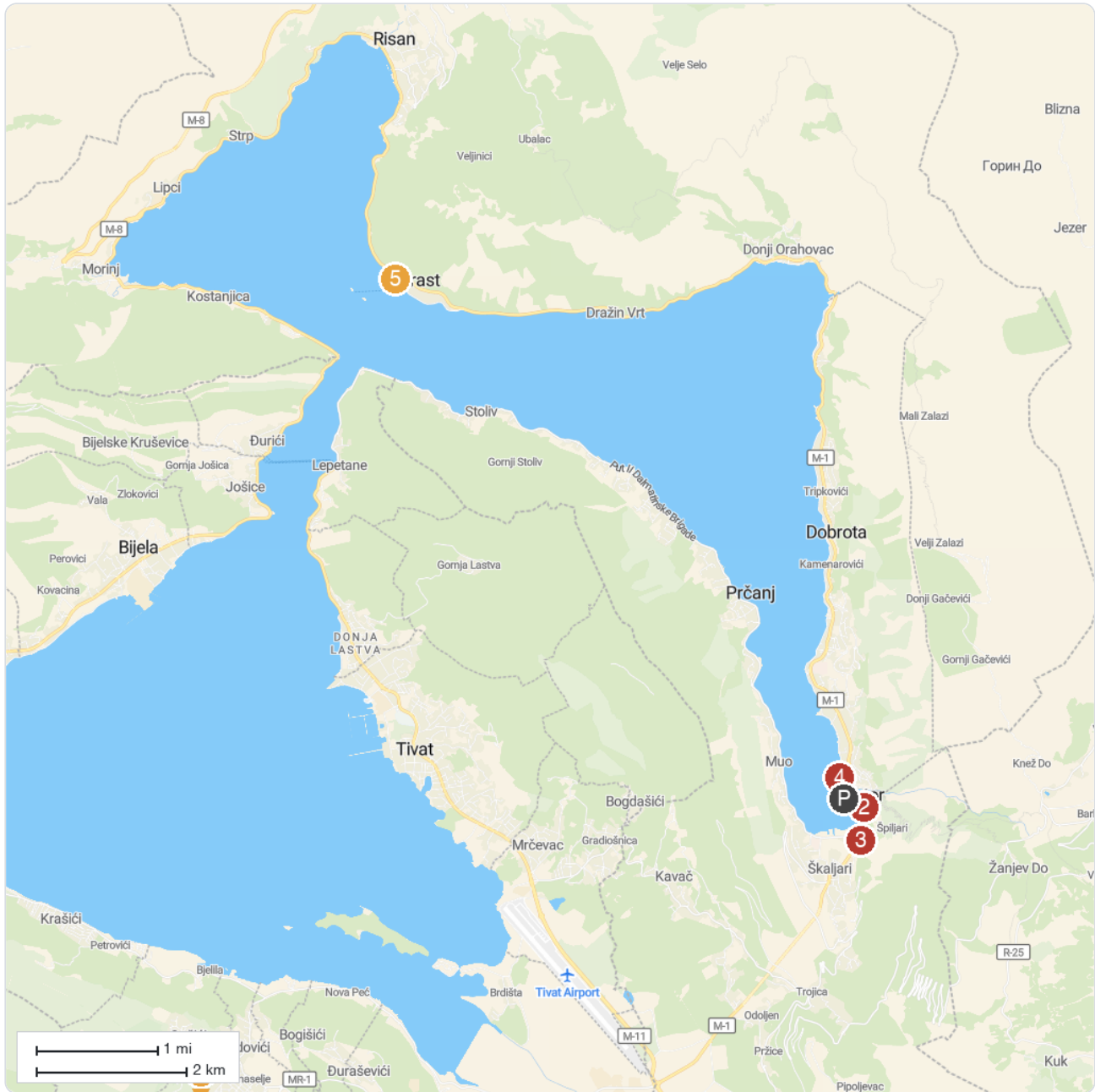
