TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Burg Linn Medieval Castle** — A beautifully preserved 12th-century moated castle in the Linn district with an archaeological museum, baroque hunting...
- **Haus der Seidenkultur (Silk Museum)** — Krefeld's famous Velvet and Silk City history comes alive in this former parament weaving workshop.
- **Mies van der Rohe: Haus Lange & Haus Esters** — Two residential villas designed by Ludwig Mies van der Rohe in the late 1920s — Bauhaus masterpieces now used as...
- **Rhine Promenade & Uerdingen Stroll** — From the gangway, walk the paved Rhine promenade past the landmark Uerdinger Rheinbrücke (1936), then into the historic...
- **Stadtpark Uerdingen & Dujardin Distillery** — The historic Dujardin brandy distillery, founded in 1810, produced spirits here until 1983; its preserved Rhine-side...

BEST WALKS

- **Uerdingen Riverside & Market Loop** 2.5 km · 35 min · Easy · Free — From the pier head north along the Rhine promenade to the Uerdinger Rheinbrücke suspension bridge, then loop back through the historic...

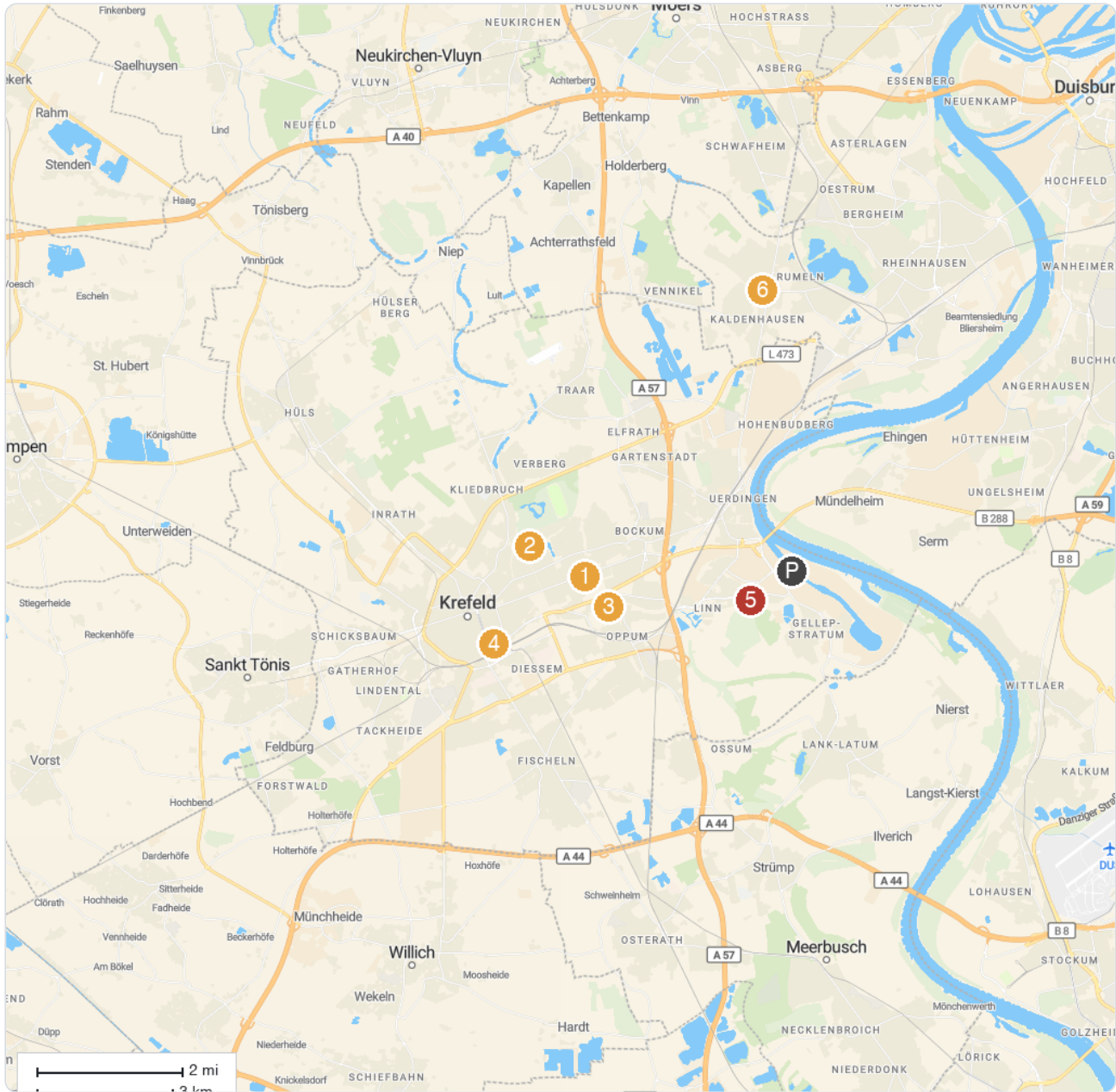
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Don't skip Burg Linn. It's worth the 35-minute transit — one of the best-preserved medieval moated castles in Germany, and rarely crowded.
- Train tickets are cheap. VRR zone tickets for the short hop to Krefeld Hbf cost a few euros each way. Buy at station machines — they have English options.
- Shops close Sundays. All retail including supermarkets is shut. Plan your souvenir shopping before noon on weekdays — or stick
