

Kristiansund, Møre og Romsdal, Norway

Built across four islands after WWII bombing leveled the old town, Kristiansund punches above its size — gateway to the Atlantic Ocean Road, home to the world's oldest continuously running public ferry, and the undisputed clipfish capital of Norway.

GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Storkaia pier, central Kirkelandet island — 1-5 min walk to town

Best For: Atlantic Ocean Road drive, island-hopping by ferry, Norwegian coastal culture

Walk to center: 2 min to main square; 20-25 min uphill to Varden viewpoint

Don't Miss: Sundbåten ferry (since 1876) and Kirkelandet Church's 320 stained-glass windows

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Atlantic Ocean Road Drive** — An 8.3 km ribbon of bridges leaping between islands above the open Atlantic — consistently voted one of the world's...
- Norwegian Clipfish Museum** — Kristiansund made its fortune drying cod on coastal rocks and shipping 'klippfisk' to Spain, Portugal, and Brazil.
- Grip Island Day Trip** — A 40-minute boat ride takes you to Grip — a tiny, largely deserted island village with colorful fishermen's houses, a...
- Innlandet Old Town Walk** — The only island that survived WWII bombing, Innlandet is a quiet enclave of 18th- and 19th-century wooden buildings...
- Varden Viewpoint Hike** — A brick tower from 1892 crowns the highest point on Kirkelandet — 25 minutes uphill from the pier but rewarded with a...

BEST WALKS

- City Center & Kirkelandet Church** 1.5 km · 30 min · Easy — From Storkaia, walk to the main square (Rådhusplassen), continue to Kirkelandet Church to view 320 stained-glass windows, then stroll...
- Varden Viewpoint Loop** 2.5 km · 50 min · Moderate (uphill) — Head inland from the pier, climb the hill to Varden for panoramic views, then descend back to the harbor.
- Sundbåten Island Hop** 3-4 hrs · Easy · Ferry-assisted — Ride the world's oldest public ferry between all four islands: Kirkelandet → Gomalandet (Clipfish Museum) → Innlandet (old wooden...

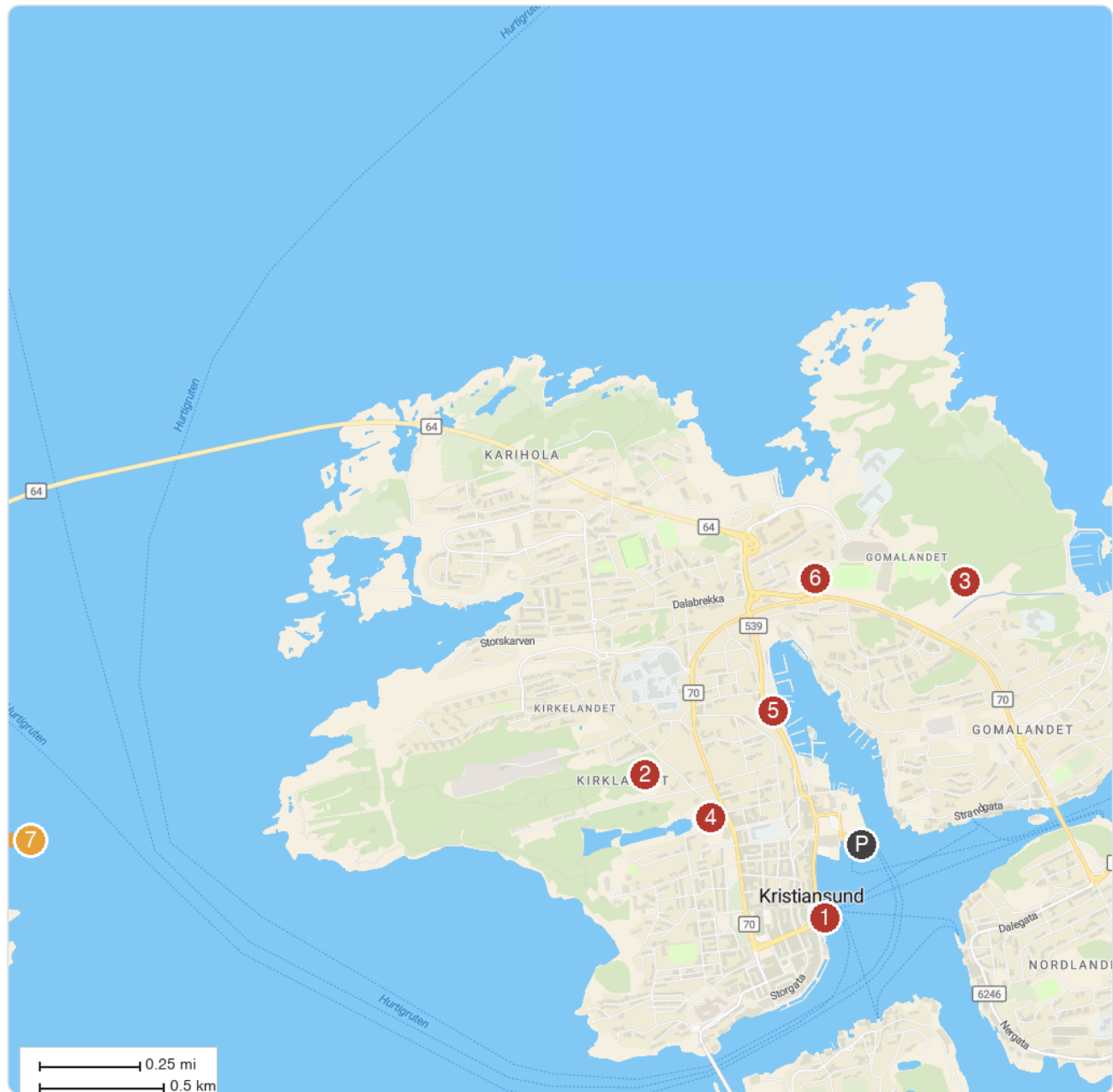
