

Kupang, West Timor, Indonesia

The dry, savanna-clad capital of East Nusa Tenggara blends Dutch colonial history, a Captain Bligh footnote, a cave hiding a crystalline swimming pool, and a local food scene built around wood-smoked pork.

GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier at Tenau Port, ~10 km west of city center

Walk to center: Not walkable — 10 km industrial road; take ship shuttle or taxi

Best For: History buffs, cave swimming, authentic local culture, foodie adventurers

Don't Miss: Crystal Cave swim, Sasando harp village, Se'i smoked pork lunch

Getting around: **Taxi** IDR 80,000–150,000 (~10 USD) · **Rideshare** Grab, Gojek, Maxim

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Crystal Cave Swim (Gua Kristal)** — Descend into a limestone cave hiding a stunning deep-blue pool of crystal-clear brackish water.
- Sasando Harp Village — Oebelo** — Watch master craftsmen hand-build the Sasando, a unique bamboo-and-lontar-palm harp native to nearby Rote Island and a...
- Oenesu Waterfall (Air Terjun Oenesu)** — A multi-tiered waterfall in shady forest, about 35 minutes west of Tenau Port in West Kupang district, with natural...
- Kupang City & Captain Bligh Walk** — Explore Fort Concordia (exterior — built by the Dutch VOC in 1653 as their main base against the Portuguese on Timor)...
- Lasiana Beach & Lontar Palms** — Kupang's most famous beach is lined with thousands of towering lontar palms.

BEST WALKS

- Old Town & Waterfront Stroll** 2–3 km • Mostly flat • 45–60 min — From Taman Nostalgia, walk south to the old Dutch colonial waterfront, past weathered trade warehouses.

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Rupiah cash is essential. Card acceptance is very limited outside major hotels. Get IDR on the ship or find a BNI or Mandiri ATM in the city center on arrival.
- Kupang is seriously hot and dry. Bring high-SPF sunscreen, a hat, and at least 1.5L of bottled water. Only drink bottled water —
