GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Merichas pier — small/mid ships dock; large ships tender

Walk to center: 0 min — port village is at the pier

Best For: Beaches, thermal springs, authentic Greek island life

Don't Miss: Kolona Beach double sandbar (water taxi from port)

 Getting around:  Taxi  €4 minimum, ~€0.90/km

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Kolona Beach Water Taxi** — The island's crown jewel — a 240 m double-sided sandbar of golden sand connecting Kythnos to the islet of Agios Loukas.
- **Loutra Thermal Springs** — Natural sulfur and iron hot springs flow into the sea at the village of Loutra on the northeast coast.
- **Chora Village Walk** — The island capital (Messaria) is a postcard Cycladic village with narrow whitewashed alleys, hilltop churches, and a...
- **Dryopida & Katafyki Cave** — Dryopida is an inland village with unique tiled (not flat) rooftops — a rarity in the Cyclades.
- **Apokrousi & Martinakia Beaches** — Martinakia is a short 10-min walk north of the pier — shaded, sandy, and family-friendly.

BEST WALKS

- **Merichas Harbor to Martinakia Beach** 0.8 km · 10–15 min · Easy · Flat coastal path — A gentle flat walk north along the coast from the port to the tamarisk-shaded cove of Martinakia Beach.
- **Chora Village Lanes** 1–2 km · 30–45 min · Easy–Moderate · Cobblestones — Once you've taken a taxi or bus to Chora, explore its whitewashed alleyways on foot.

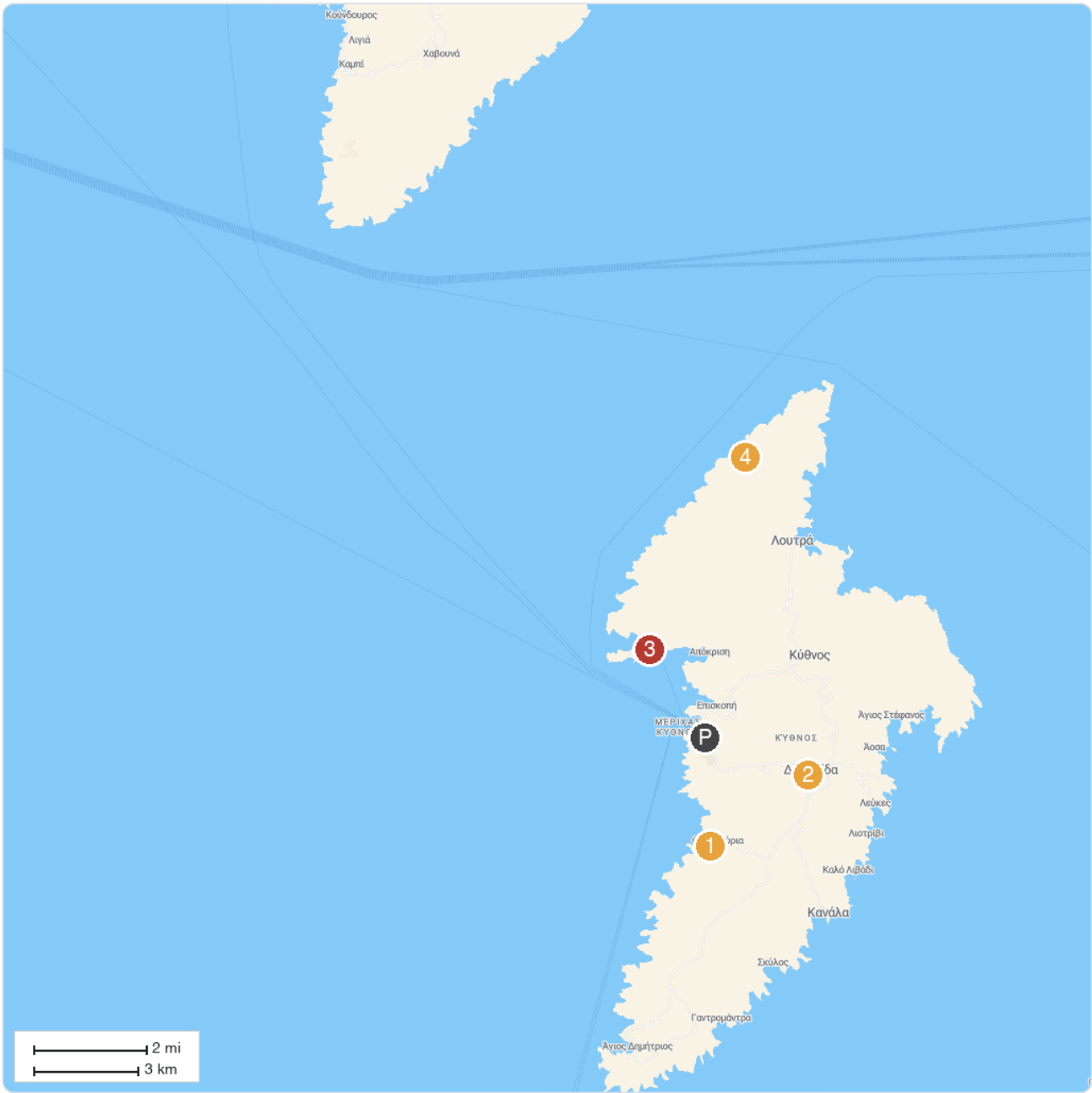
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Book the water taxi to Kolona early. Boats run from Merichas pier but fill up fast on busy days. Head straight to the pier upon arrival or ask your ship's excursion desk.
- Rent an ATV or car first thing. There are fewer than 10 taxis on the island — don't count on flagging one down. Rental offices are along the pier and reservation isn't always
