TOP THINGS TO DO

- Tower of Hercules** — Climb the only fully preserved Roman lighthouse in the world, built in the 1st century AD and still guiding ships today.
 - Old Town & Plaza de María Pita** — Wander medieval stone streets in the Ciudad Vieja, then emerge into La Coruña's grand main square.
 - Galician Tapas Crawl** — Hit Calle Galera, Calle Estrella, and Calle Barrera — the tapas heartland just off the main square.
- Riazor & Orzán Atlantic Beaches** — Two sweeping crescent beaches on the wild western side of the peninsula, just 15–20 minutes on foot from the dock.
 - Monte de San Pedro Park** — A former clifftop military fort turned scenic park, with decommissioned 1930s Vickers guns, a hedge maze, and the best...

BEST WALKS

- Harbor to Old Town Loop** 2.5 km · ~45 min · flat · easy — Walk from the terminal along the marina, past the iconic glass-balconied galerías, into Plaza de María Pita, then through the medieval...
- Coastal Promenade to the Beaches** 2 km · ~30 min · flat · easy — Walk west from the center along the Paseo Marítimo — one of Europe's longest seafront promenades — crossing the peninsula to the...

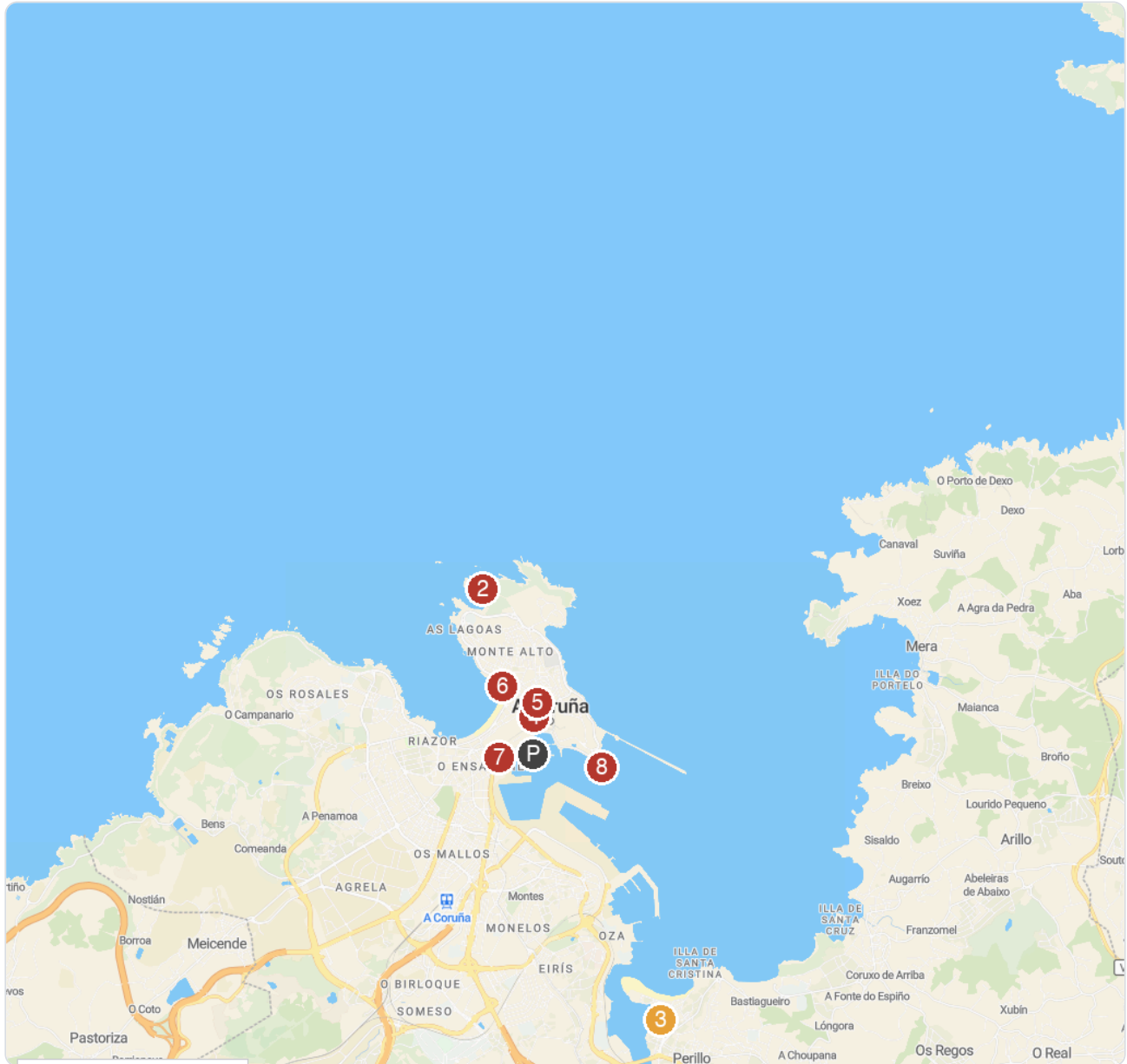
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
