- **Grandad Bluff Overlook** — At 600 feet above the city, Grandad Bluff delivers sweeping views of the Mississippi River valley stretching into three...
- **Riverside Park & River Heritage** — The park at the dock is home to the beautiful paddlewheel boat La Crosse Queen and interpretive displays on Mississippi...
- **Historic Downtown Walk** — Five minutes from the dock, La Crosse's downtown blends Victorian storefronts with craft breweries, local boutiques...
- **Blufflands Trail Hike** — For the active crowd, the City of La Crosse maintains bluff-side trails accessible from Grandad Bluff Park with...
- **Wisconsin Food & Drink Trail** — La Crosse is the perfect place to try Wisconsin staples: deep-fried cheese curds at a downtown pub, a Spotted Cow...

BEST WALKS

- **Riverside Park to Downtown** 0.5 miles · 10 min · Flat · Easy — Walk east from the dock along the Riverside Park path to the heart of downtown.
- **Downtown Heritage Loop** 1.5 miles · 30 min · Flat · Easy — Explore the compact historic downtown: walk along 3rd and 4th Streets past Victorian architecture, visit Artists' Alley murals, and...

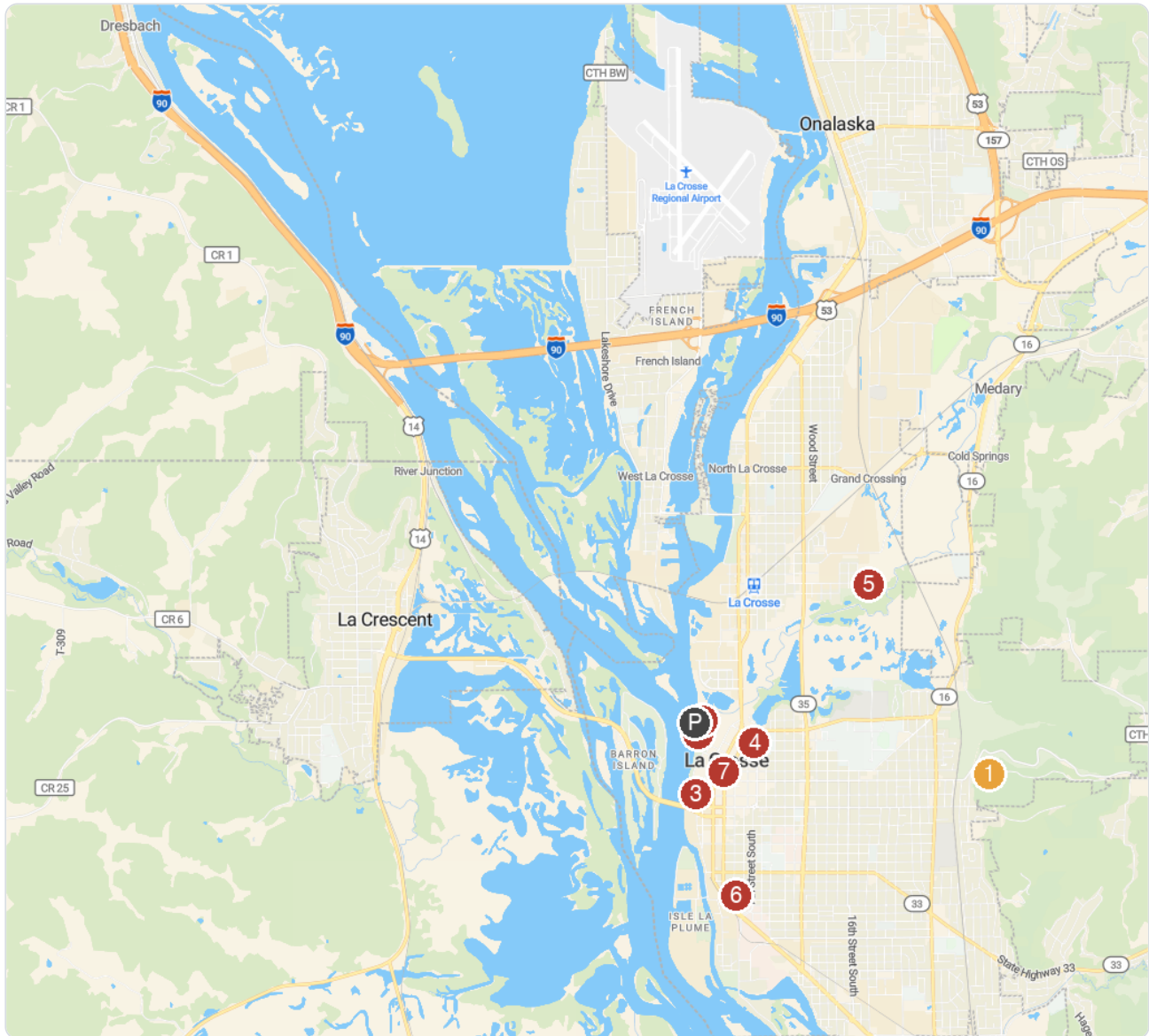
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Easy docking: Ships tie up directly at Riverside Park — no tender boats, no long bus rides. Walk off and you're already in the city.
- Eat Wisconsin: Deep-fried cheese curds and a Spotted Cow ale (only sold in-state) are non-negotiable. Almost every downtown pub serves them.
- Grandad Bluff needs wheels: It's 3 miles from the dock — too far to walk comfortably. Use a rideshare or book a ship tour; the
