GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender only — ships anchor off La Passe; 10–15 min tender ride to the jetty

Walk to centre: La Passe village is 1 min from the jetty; nearest beaches 15–25 min on foot

Best For: Beach lovers, photographers, cyclists, nature seekers

Don't Miss: Anse Source d'Argent — regularly rated the world's most beautiful beach

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Anse Source d'Argent Beach** — Walk or bike through L'Union Estate (paid entry ~150 SCR) to reach the iconic beach framed by sculpted pink granite...
- Veuve Nature Reserve** — Free forest reserve in the island's interior — the last stronghold of the critically endangered Seychelles Paradise...
- L'Union Estate Plantation** — A working colonial plantation featuring giant Aldabra tortoises, a vanilla plot, an ox-driven coconut oil press, and...
- East Coast Wild Beaches Hike** — Bike across the island to Grand Anse, then hike the rocky coastal trail to Petite Anse and Anse Coco — dramatic...
- Snorkelling at Anse Sévère** — A reef-fringed north-coast beach easily reached by a 15-minute bike ride from the pier.

BEST WALKS

- Pier to Anse Sévère (North Coast Loop)** 3 km round trip • 30-40 min on foot • Flat — Head north along the seafront road from La Passe Jetty through the village and past L'Union Estate entrance, continuing to the...
- La Passe Village Wander** Under 1 km • 15-20 min • Flat — A short stroll from the jetty into the colourful village centre — Creole wooden houses, souvenir shops, local bakeries, and fish...

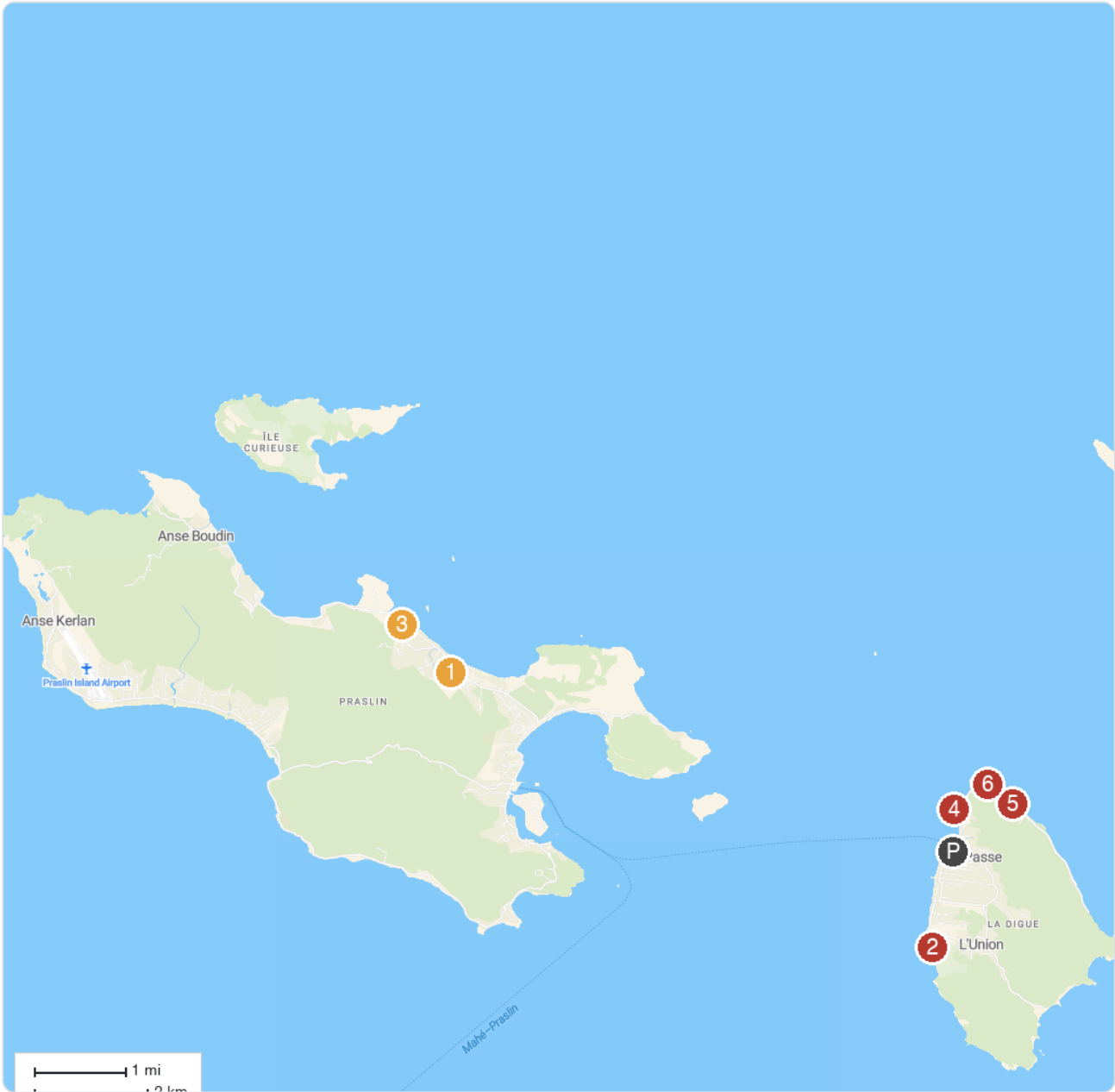
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
