GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Direct pier — dedicated cruise terminal, no tender

Walk to Center: La Goulette town ~10 min on foot; Carthage/Tunis require taxi or TGM train

Best For: Roman ruins, Arab medinas, photogenic hilltop villages

Don't Miss: Sidi Bou Said village and bambalouni (fried doughnuts) on the main street

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Ruins of Ancient Carthage** — Walk among the UNESCO-listed remnants of one of antiquity's greatest cities.
- Sidi Bou Said Village** — A cliffside hilltop village of uniform blue-and-white houses, bougainvillea-draped alleyways, and elaborate carved...
- Tunis Medina & Souks** — One of the Arab world's finest medinas — a UNESCO-listed labyrinth of covered souks selling spices, pottery, leather...
- Bardo National Museum** — Housed in a 15th-century beylical palace, the Bardo holds one of the world's greatest collections of Roman mosaics...
- La Marsa Beach Day** — If your call time allows, La Marsa is an upscale suburb 20 minutes north of the port with a clean sandy beach, seaside...

BEST WALKS

- La Goulette Waterfront Stroll** 30–45 min · Flat · Free — Exit the cruise terminal and walk south along the seafront promenade past fish restaurants and the old Ottoman fort of La Goulette.
- Sidi Bou Said Village Loop** 1–1.5 hrs · Mostly flat with gentle hills · Free — From the TGM station, walk up the main cobbled street past the blue doors and jasmine sellers to the Café des Délices terrace for Gulf...

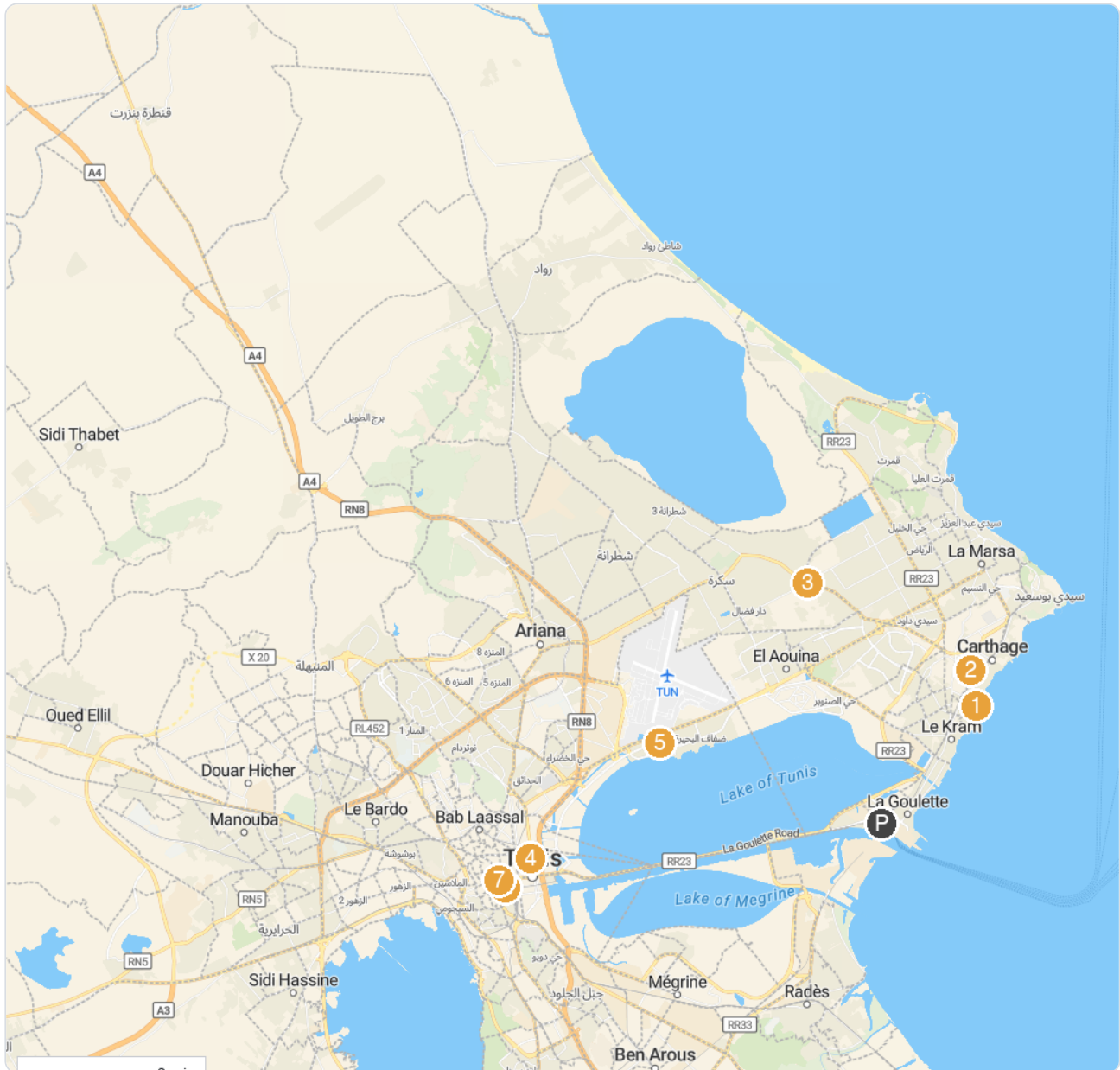
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Dinar rules:** It is illegal to export Tunisian Dinars — only exchange what you'll spend, and reconvert leftovers to euros/USD at the terminal before boarding.
- Agree on price before you get in:** Check the fixed-rate board inside the terminal, then confirm the amount AND currency with your
