Docking: Pier — Puerto de La Guaira cruise terminal, no tendering

Best For: Cable car over Ávila, colonial history, Venezuelan cuisine, beach clubs

Walk to Center: ~20 min walk to La Guaira old town; Caracas is 45–60 min by road

Don't Miss: Teleférico Warairarepano cable car from Caracas to ~2,140 m Ávila summit

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Teleférico Warairarepano — Ávila Cable Car** — Ride Venezuela's most famous attraction: a modern gondola rising from Caracas to roughly 2,140 m atop Mount Ávila.
- La Guaira Colonial Walking Tour** — Explore the old port quarter with its 18th-century Casa Guipuzcoana (a grand Basque trading house), cobblestone...
- Caracas City & Simón Bolívar Sites** — Visit the Casa Natal de Bolívar (birthplace of the Liberator), the National Pantheon where Bolívar is interred, and...
- Private Beach Club Day Pass** — Rather than the public beaches, excursions to secured private beach clubs along the Litoral Central offer clean...
- El Hatillo Colonial Village & Shopping** — This charming, secure suburb on Caracas's southern edge is Venezuela's best artisan shopping destination — colorful...

BEST WALKS

- La Guaira Historic Quarter** ~1.5 km · 30–40 min · Flat — From the cruise terminal, walk into the old town along Calle Bolívar to the Casa Guipuzcoana and the central plaza.

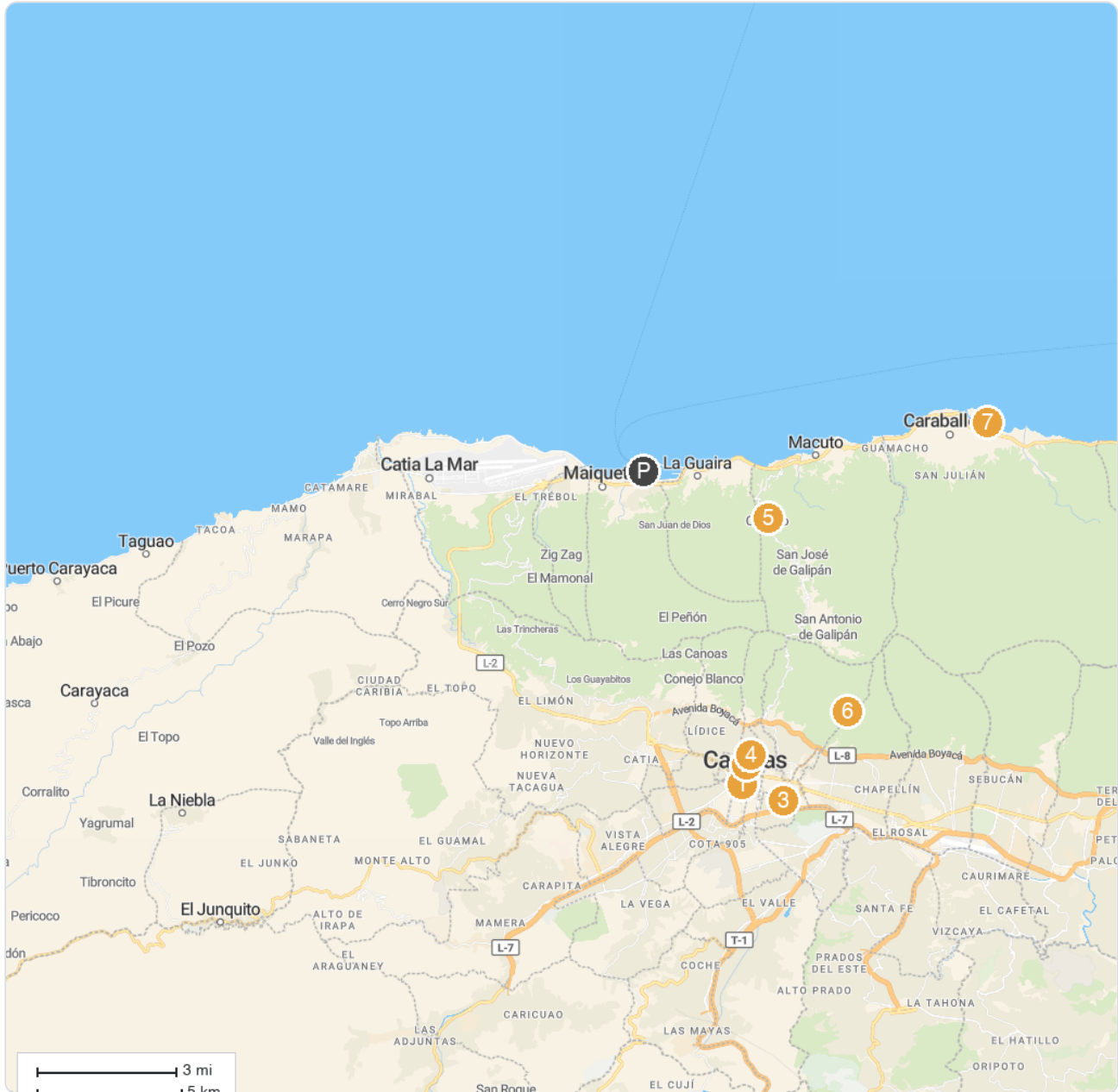
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
