GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Canal berth on the Dortmund-Ems Canal; ships dock directly in town

Best For: Cycling the canal towpath, Dörenther Cliffs, nearby Tecklenburg old town

Walk to Centre: Village centre is a short 5-min walk from the canal berth

Don't Miss: The Dörenther Klippen sandstone cliffs and the Crouching Woman rock formation

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Dörenther Cliffs & Crouching Woman** — Hike to the Dörenther Klippen, dramatic sandstone cliffs up to 40 m high in the Teutoburg Forest.
- **Tecklenburg Medieval Old Town** — The nearby hilltop town of Tecklenburg is one of the prettiest in Westphalia — cobbled lanes, well-preserved...
- **Canal Towpath Cycling** — Follow the flat, scenic towpath of the Dortmund-Ems Canal on two wheels.
- **Ladbergen Village & Heimatmuseum** — Explore the village centre's half-timbered houses, photograph the old water mill, and visit the Heimatmuseum for a...

BEST WALKS

- **Village Centre & Old Water Mill** 1–2 km · 30 min · Easy — A short stroll from the canal berth into the village centre, past half-timbered farmhouses and the picturesque old water mill on the...
- **Canal Towpath Walk** 2–4 km · 45–90 min · Easy — Head north or south along the Dortmund-Ems Canal towpath for a tranquil walk through Münsterland farmland, watching barge traffic and...

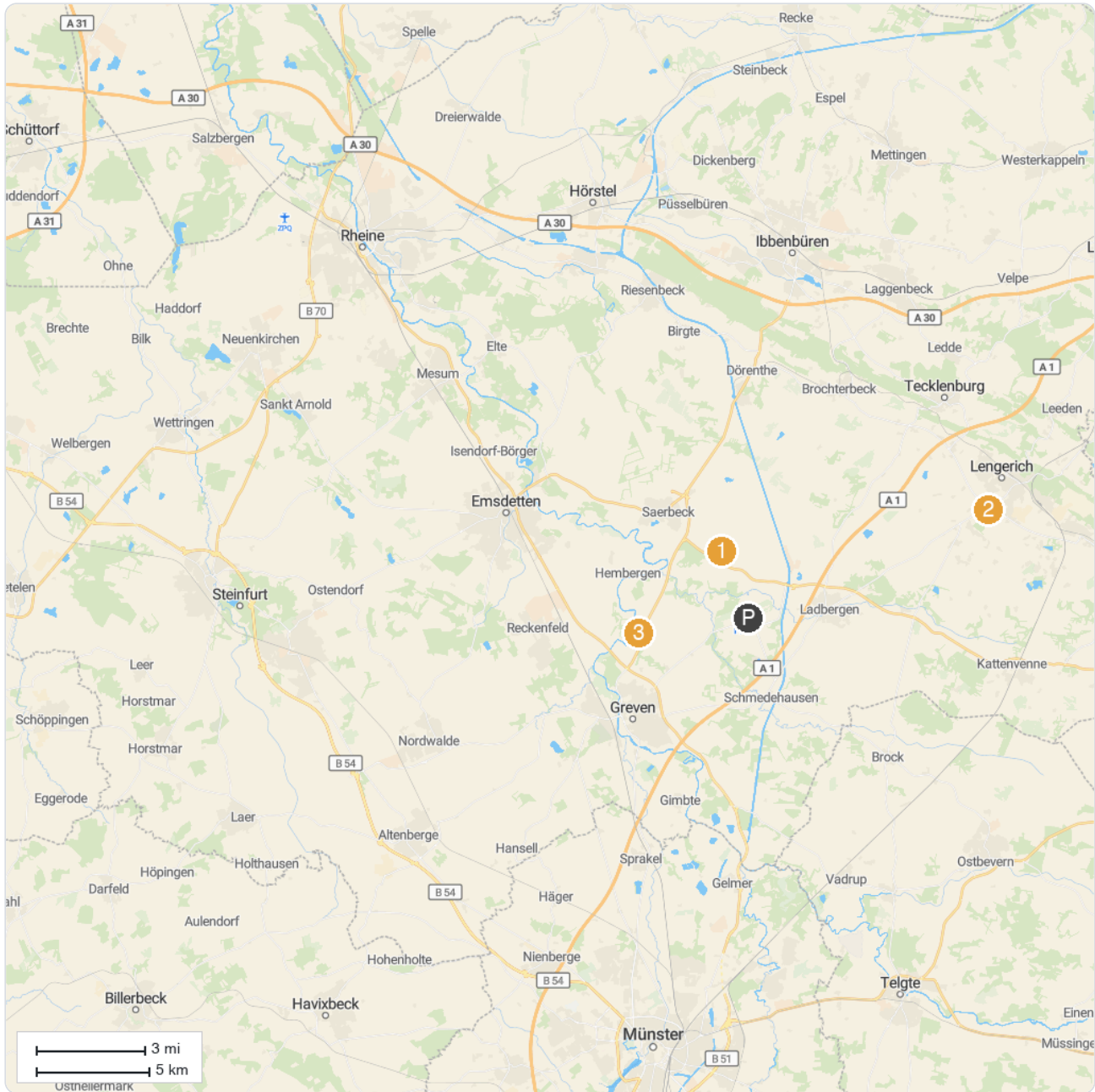
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
