 - Archipelago Island Ferry** — Hop on the local Skjærgårdsbåtene commuter ferry for a scenic ride through

 - Wrightegaarden Historic Merchant House** — An 18th-century merchant estate at the heart of Langesund's cultural life, famous for hosting world-class musicians...
 - Kayak the Skjærgård** — Paddle through the island-studded Langesund archipelago with local guides, exploring sea caves and skerries along...

BEST WALKS

- Old Town to Tangen Fort** 4 km round trip · 1-1.5 hrs · Easy — From the tender quay, follow the harbor promenade past the white captain's houses of Smietangen, then continue along the peninsula...
- Town Center to Krogshavn Beach** 2.4 km round trip · 40 min · Easy — A gentle stroll from the quay through the old town to Krogshavn, Langesund's main swimming beach — grassy lawn, diving platforms, and...
- Steinvika Geopark Loop** 2.5 km · 1 hr · Easy-moderate — Walk the coastal path west from the quay to Steinvika for the UNESCO-listed rock formations, then loop back through the town center.

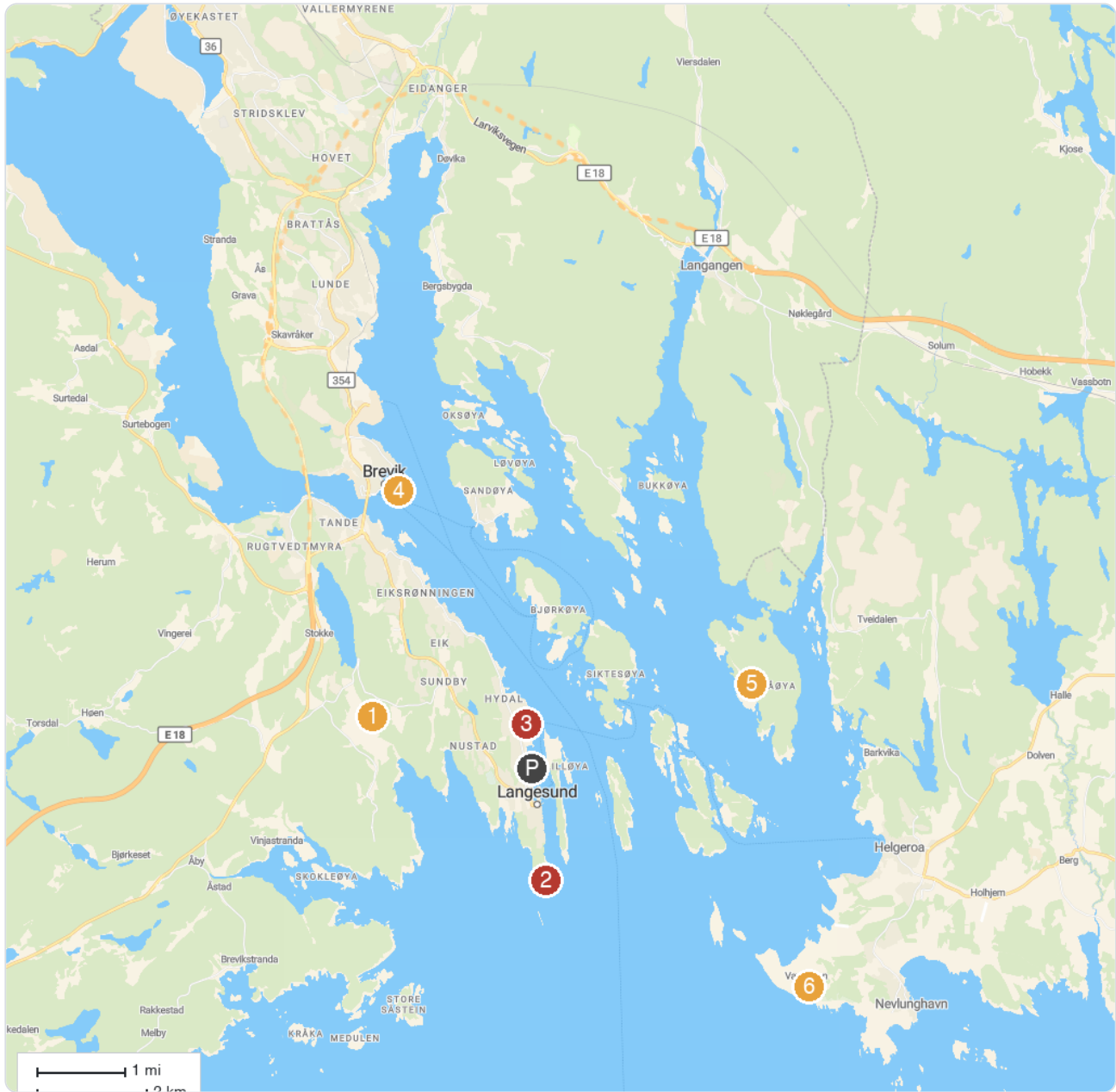

- 3 Badeparken** Badeparken is a popular outdoor swimming park with pools and slides.
- 5 Paradisbukta (Jordsbukta)** Paradisbukta is a picturesque sandy beach perfect for swimming and relaxing.

- 2 Tangen fort** Tangen fort is a historic coastal fortress with scenic views.
- 4 Brevik church** Brevik church is a beautiful wooden church from 1880.
