

Lauterbach, Rügen, Germany

A royal Baltic harbor where you step off the gangway and straight onto a 19th-century steam train. Lauterbach opens the door to Putbus's neoclassical elegance, ancient beech forests, and the mysterious GDR-era island of Vilm.

GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier — Kommunalhafen / Lauterbach Mole (small & river ships only)

Don't Miss: Rasender Roland steam train to Binz or Granitz Castle

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Rasender Roland Steam Train Ride** — Board the coal-fired Rasender Roland (Rushing Roland), a working narrow-gauge railway operating since 1895.
- Granitz Hunting Lodge** — Rügen's most visited castle, built 1837–1846 for Prince Wilhelm Malte I.
- Insel Vilm Guided Boat Tour** — A once-secret GDR retreat for top party officials — only 30 visitors per day are allowed on this pristine biosphere...
- Putbus — The White City** — A princely planned town of pure white neoclassical buildings radiating from a circular plaza (The Circus) with a...
- Binz Beach & Strandkörbe** — Rügen's iconic resort town with a 5 km sandy beach lined with hooded wicker beach chairs (Strandkörbe), grand...

BEST WALKS

- Harbor to Putbus via Schlosspark** 2.5 km · 30 min · Flat, paved — Walk south along the harbor promenade, then follow the signposted path through the Putbus Schlosspark — a sweeping English landscape...
- Goor Coastal Forest Trail** 4 km loop · 1 hr · Easy, mostly flat — Head east from the harbor along the shoreline into the Goor Biosphere Reserve.

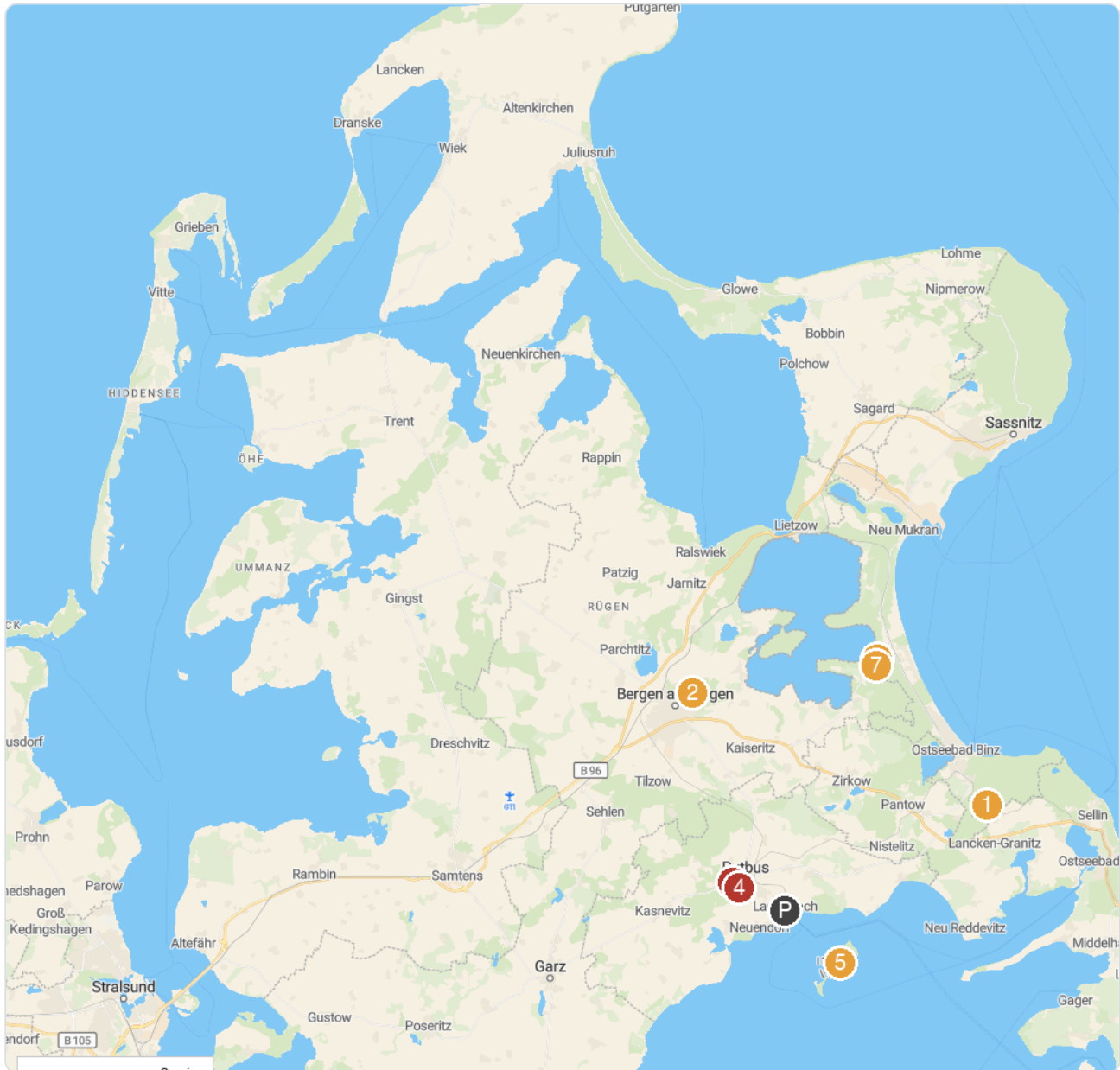
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Carry cash. Fish roll stalls, ice cream kiosks, and the steam train ticket booth often don't accept cards. Keep €20–€30 in small bills.
- First train wins the day. The Rasender Roland runs on a timetable — check it before leaving the ship so you don't miss the last
