GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Quai Roger Meunier cruise terminal — ships dock directly, no tender

Best For: Paris day trip, D-Day beaches, Normandy scenery, Impressionist art

Walk to center: ~30 min walk or €8 taxi to the city center (Place de l'Hôtel de Ville)

Don't Miss: St. Joseph's Church tower, Étretat cliffs, or take the train to Paris

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Paris Day Trip** — Take the direct train from Gare du Havre to Paris Saint-Lazare (~2h 10min) and spend the day in the city.
- **D-Day Landing Beaches** — Visit Omaha Beach, the American Cemetery at Colleville-sur-Mer, and Pointe du Hoc — among the most moving sites in...
- **Étretat Cliffs Walk** — The chalk sea cliffs at Étretat — with their famous rock arches and needles — are about 29 km northeast of Le Havre.
- **Le Havre City & MuMa** — The rebuilt city center is a UNESCO World Heritage Site — explore the concrete boulevards and soaring St.
- **Honfleur Half-Day** — The prettiest harbor town in Normandy sits 45 minutes from Le Havre.

BEST WALKS

- **Perret City Center Walk** 2-3 km · Easy · 1-1.5 hrs — Walk the grand boulevards of Auguste Perret's postwar masterplan.
- **Waterfront Promenade** 2 km · Easy · 45 min — Stroll the seafront promenade from the port toward the beach at Plage du Havre.

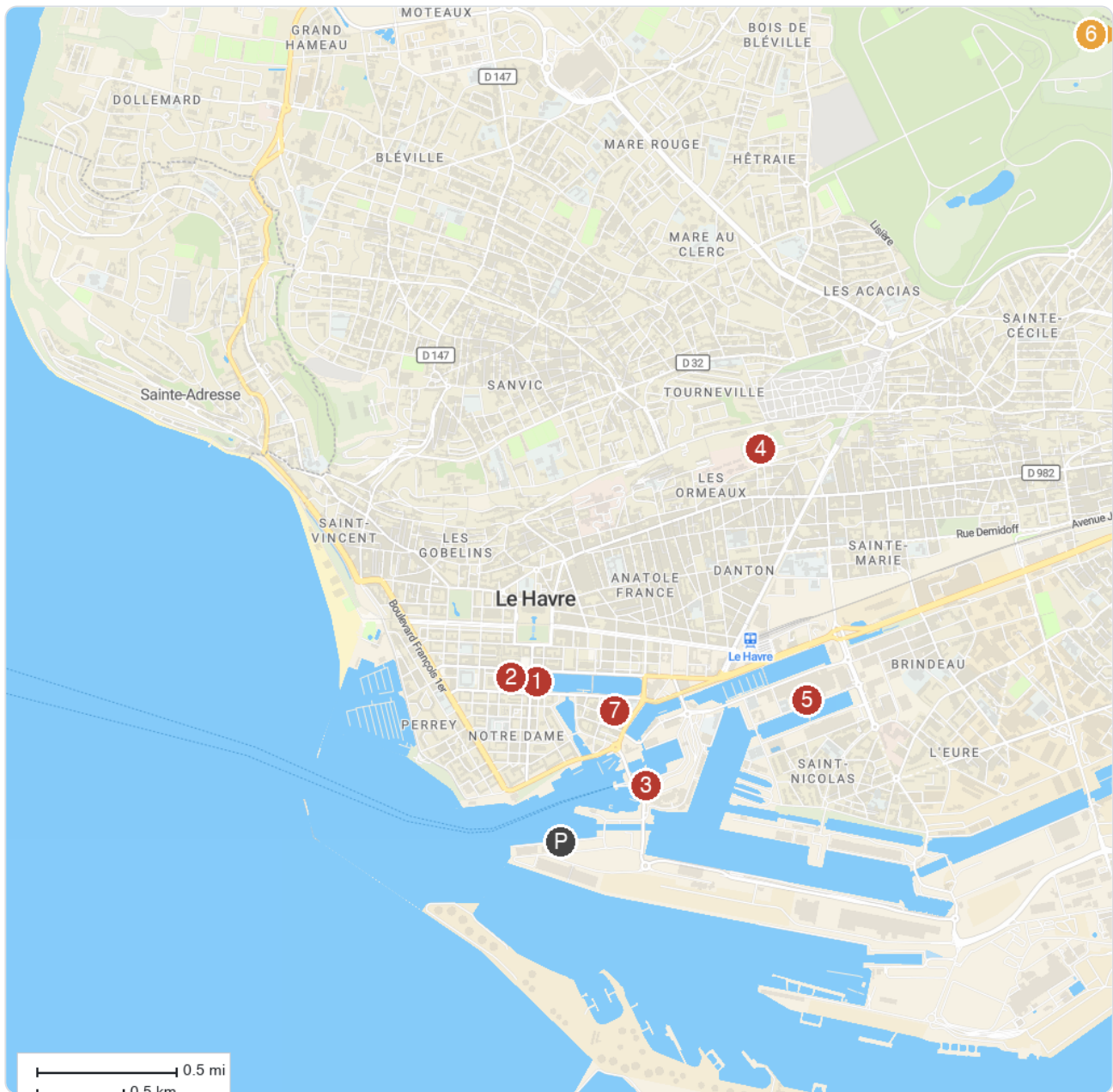
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Train to Paris: Book tickets in advance on [sncf-connect.com](https://www.sncf-connect.com). The 08:00-09:00 trains fill fast on port days. Last safe return from Paris Saint-Lazare is around 17:00-17:30 to be...
- Taxis are your friend: Taxis queue at the terminal. Fixed €10 to the train station, ~€8 to the city center. For Étretat, negotiate a round-trip rate (typically €80-€100 for the...
- MuMa is free on Sundays and has an outstanding Impressionist permanent collection — one of the best outside Paris, and rarely
