GETTING ASHORE

- Docking:** Tender — ships anchor in the bay; tender boats land at Marina du Marin
- Walk to center:** 10-15 min from tender dock to town center
- Best For:** Beaches, rum tasting, sailing atmosphere, Creole cuisine
- Don't Miss:** Grande Anse des Salines (most beautiful beach in Martinique) & Église Saint-Étienne

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Grande Anse des Salines** — Often called the most beautiful beach in Martinique, Salines delivers a sweeping arc of golden sand, leaning palms, and...
- **Plage de la Pointe Marin** — Calm, shallow, family-friendly beach at the southern entrance to Le Marin bay.
- **Distillerie La Mauny Rum Tour** — An active agricultural rum distillery in Rivière-Pilote, about 15 min from Le Marin.
- **Catamaran Sail & Snorkel** — Local operators at the marina offer day sails to Martinique's southern coves, often including snorkel stops, a swim at...
- **Mangrove Kayak Excursion** — Paddle through the protected mangrove ecosystem of the Bassin de Carénage — crabs, herons, and tropical fish in a calm...

BEST WALKS

- **Marina to Town Center** 0.6 mi / 1 km — 10-15 min — Flat — Walk east along the waterfront boulevard from the tender dock through the marina, past waterfront cafes and superyachts, to the...

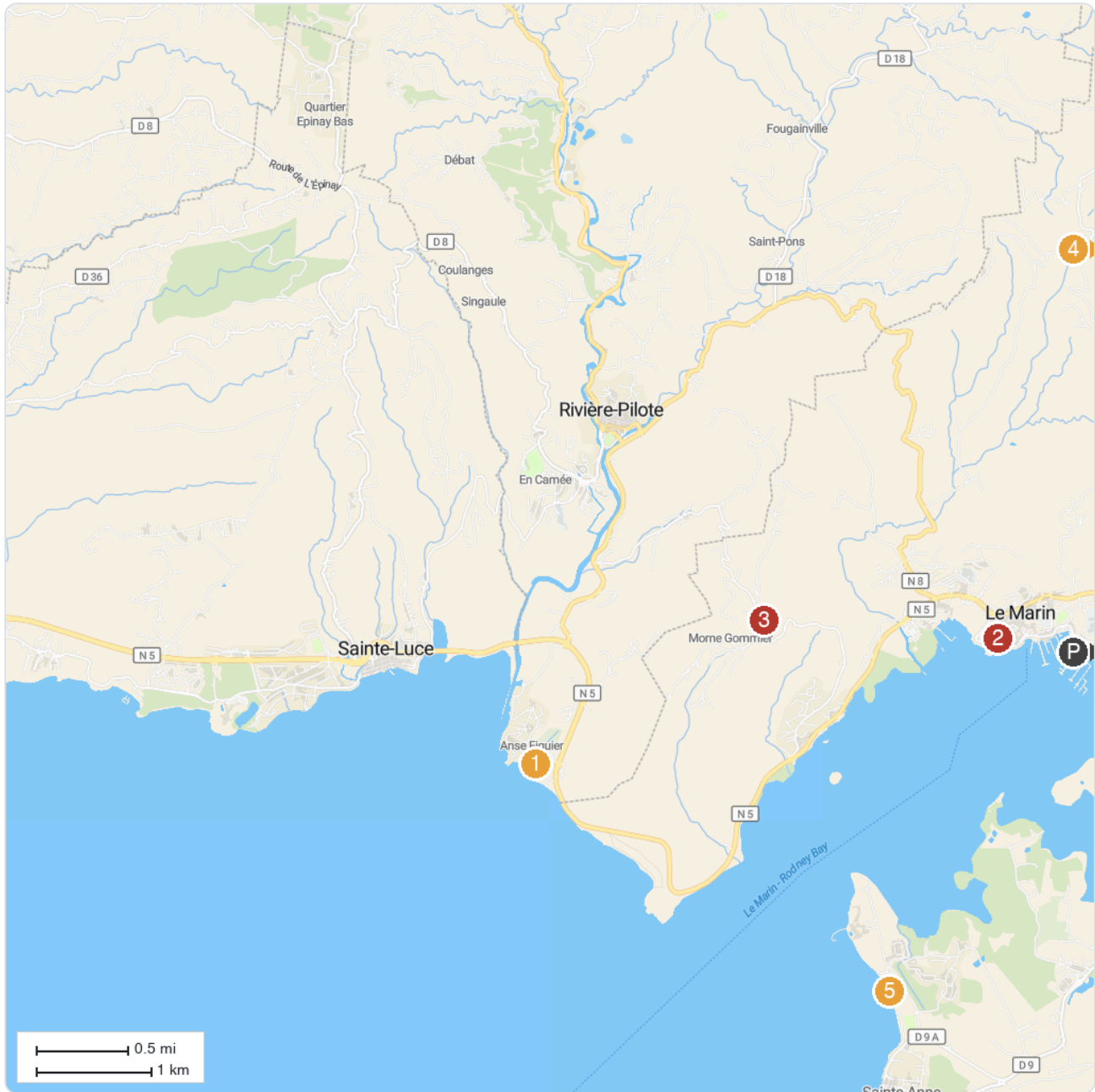
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Euros only. US dollars are rarely accepted. Bring cash for taxis, the local market, and beach vendors — card acceptance is good at marina restaurants but patchy elsewhere.
- Agree on the taxi fare before you get in. Taxis are regulated but not metered; fix the price upfront. Round trips to Salines typically run €25-40 for up to 4 passengers.
- Rent a car if you want the beaches. Jumbo Car and Hertz have kiosks at the marina. Book in advance — stock is limited on ship
