TOP THINGS TO DO

- **East Frisian Tea Ceremony** — Visit the Bünning Tea Museum and experience the traditional Teetied ritual — Kluntje rock sugar, strong black tea, and...
- **Altstadt Walking Tour** — Wander the Dutch-influenced Old Town past Haus Samson (1570), the baroque Große Kirche, and the ornate 1894 Rathaus.
- **Dyke & Riverside Cycling** — East Frisia is legendary for flat, car-free cycling routes.
- **Schloss Evenburg** — A striking neo-Gothic moated castle in the Loga district, surrounded by a free public park.
- **Miniaturland Leer** — One of northern Germany's larger miniature model railways, depicting East Frisian landscapes, Berlin, and working...

BEST WALKS

- **Museumshafen to Rathaus Loop** 1.5 km · ~25 min · Easy — Start at the Museum Harbour, walk along the Uferpromenade past historic barges, reach Haus Samson on Neue Straße, swing by the baroque...
- **Altstadt & Shopping Stroll** 2 km · ~35 min · Easy — From the dock, cross the Nessebrücke pedestrian bridge and explore Mühlenstraße (the main shopping street), then loop back through the...

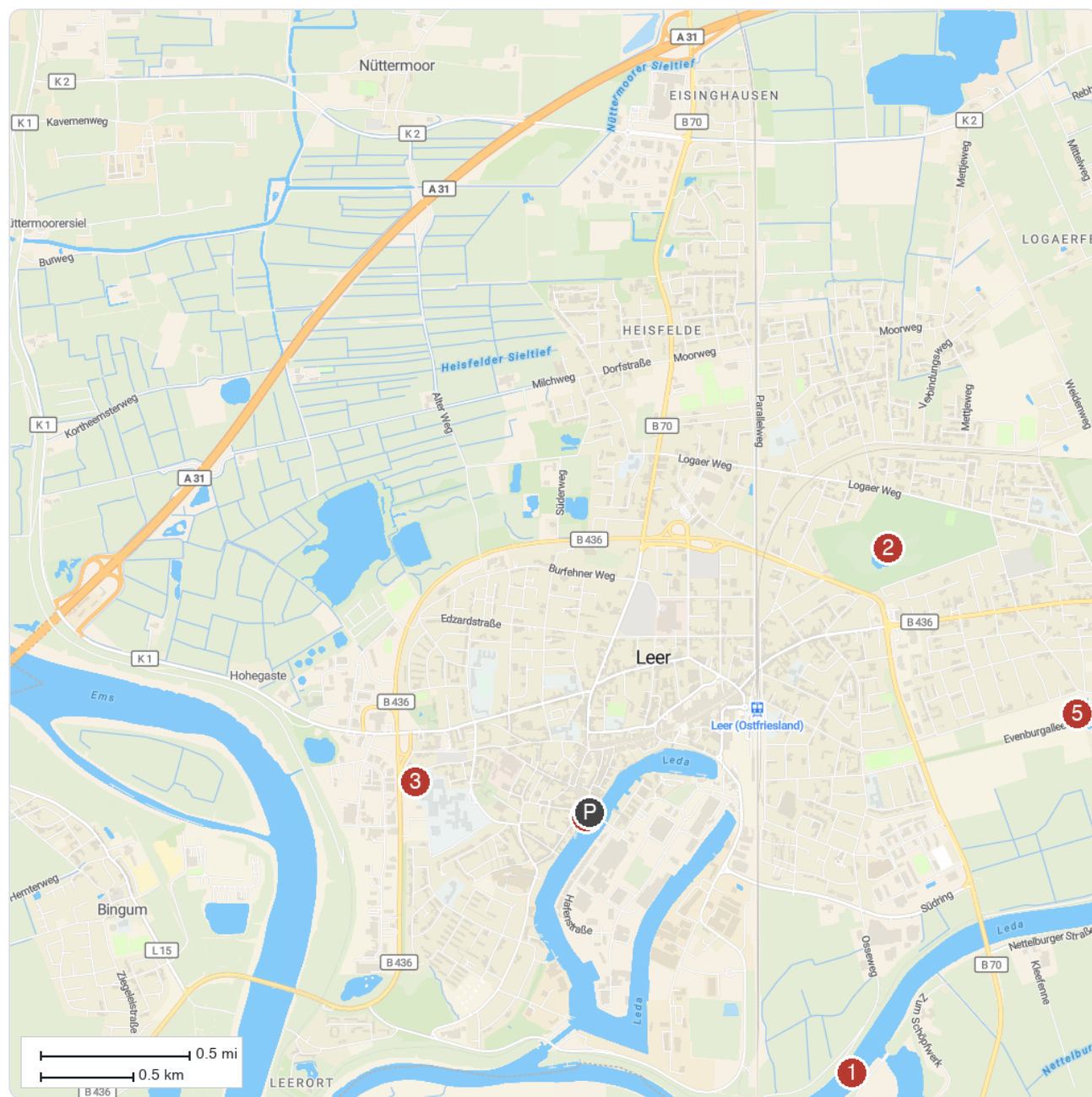
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
