GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender — ships anchor in the harbor; 10–15 min ride to Levuka Town Jetty on Beach Street

Walk to Center: 0 min — tender drops you right on the main street

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **UNESCO Town Walking Tour** — Local guides lead you through Beach Street's 19th-century timber storefronts, the Sacred Heart Church (1858), the Cession Site where Fiji was handed...
- **Lovoni Crater Village Tour** — 4WD into the extinct volcanic crater at the island's center to visit the fiercely independent Lovoni village.
- **Climb the 199 Steps** — A self-guided hike up Mission Hill via the famous 199 Steps delivers sweeping panoramic views over Levuka's colonial rooftops, the barrier reef, and...
- **Levuka Community Centre & Museum** — Housed in the restored 1868 Morris Hedstrom building, this small museum holds artifacts, colonial-era photographs, and documents including records of...
- **Royal Hotel & Whale's Tale Lunch** — Settle in at the Royal Hotel (1880s, oldest in the South Pacific) for a cold Fiji Bitter or a gin & tonic among antique furniture, or head to the...

BEST WALKS

- **Beach Street Heritage Stroll** 1.5 km · 30–45 min · Easy · Free — Start at Levuka Town Jetty and walk Beach Street end-to-end: the Sacred Heart Church clock tower, Morris Hedstrom Museum, Royal Hotel, and colonial storefronts.
- **Mission Hill — 199 Steps** 0.8 km round-trip · 45 min · Moderate (stairs) · Free — From the jetty, walk 8 minutes to the base of the 199 Steps and climb Mission Hill for the best panoramic view in Levuka — reef, harbor, and outer islands spread below...

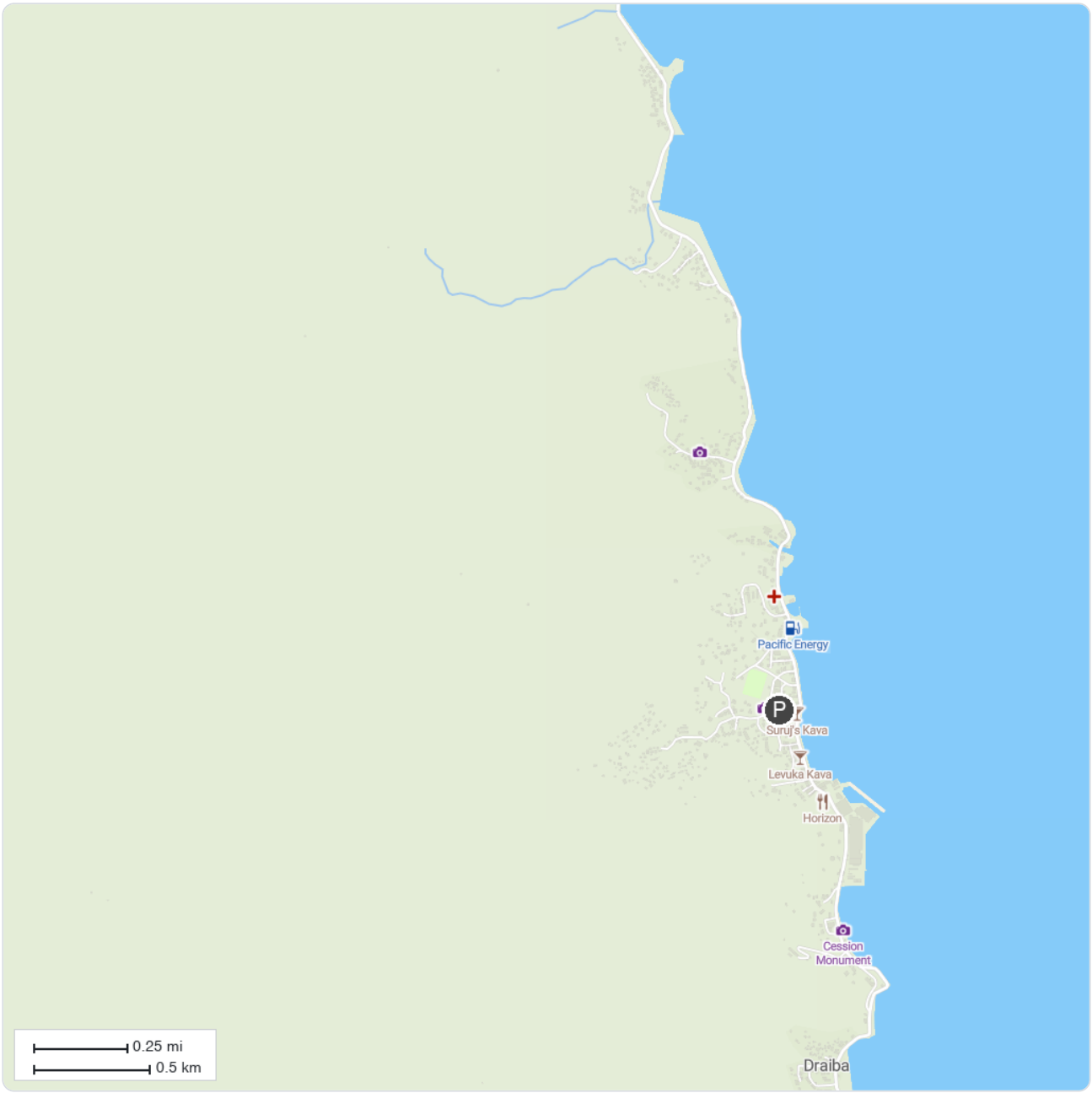
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Dress modestly in town. Levuka is a conservative Fijian community. Cover knees and shoulders. For village visits, wear a sulu (sarong) and remove hats and sunglasses.
- Bring cash (FJD). The Westpac ATM in town can run out of money on cruise days. Exchange currency onboard or at a port before you arrive.
- Sunday in Levuka = Sunday service. If your ship calls on Sunday, shops and the museum will be closed. Instead, attend a Fijian church service — the choral singing is spine-tingling and visitors are always welcome.
- Book Lovoni early. The crater village tour is the highlight of any Levuka call, but seats fill up fast on ship excursion days. Book through your cruise line or a pre-arranged local operator.
- Bring mosquito repellent. Ovalau's lush tropical climate means insects are present, especially near the crater and jungle trails.
- "Bula" goes a long way. Fijians are famously welcoming — a simple Bula (hello) and Vinaka (thank you) will make every interaction warmer. No aggressive vendors here.
