GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Alongside at Limassol Cruise Terminal (DP World), New Port — no tendering

Best For: Ancient ruins, medieval history, wine tasting, beach days

Walk to center: 3-4 km to Old Town; shuttle bus or taxi recommended

Don't Miss: Kourion Archaeological Site and Aphrodite's Rock (Petra tou Romiou)

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Kourion Archaeological Site** — One of Cyprus's crown jewels: a Greco-Roman city perched on a cliff above the sea.
- **Aphrodite's Rock (Petra tou Romiou)** — The legendary birthplace of Aphrodite — a dramatic sea stack rising from turquoise water on the coastal highway.
- **Limassol Old Town & Castle** — The 16th-century Limassol Castle — where Richard the Lionheart married Berengaria of Navarre — houses the Cyprus...
- **Troodos Wine Villages (Omodos)** — Head into the Troodos foothills to the UNESCO-listed village of Omodos — cobblestone streets, the Monastery of the Holy...
- **Limassol Marina & Molos Promenade** — A self-guided walk along the palm-lined Molos seafront promenade to the luxury Limassol Marina — superyachts and...

BEST WALKS

- **Old Town to Molos Promenade** 2.5 km · 30-40 min · Flat & easy — From Limassol Castle, walk east through the Old Town market streets, past the Old Port, and along the seafront to the Molos Promenade.
- **Amathus Ancient City Ruins** Self-guided · 1 hr on site · 11 km east of center — The ruins of ancient Amathus sit right beside the coast road — an open-air site with an agora and acropolis remnants.

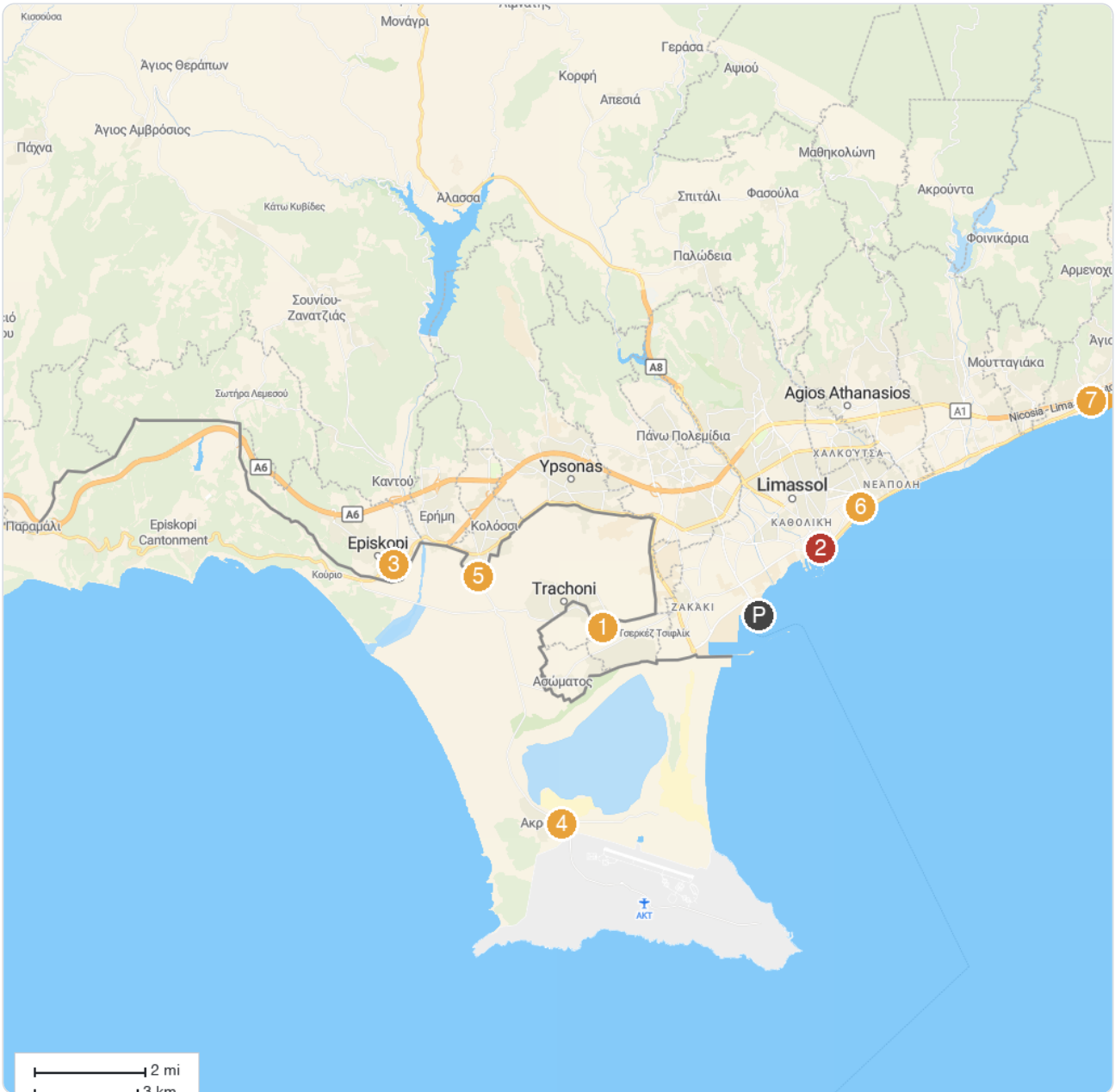

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Get to Old Town first. The cruise terminal is 3-4 km from the action — take the ship shuttle, Bus 30, or a taxi (€8-10) rather than walking in summer heat.
- Cyprus uses the Euro. ATMs are plentiful at the terminal and in Old Town. Credit cards accepted almost everywhere.
