Docking: Pier — Quai de Kergroise commercial port; shuttle to center

Best For: WWII history, sailing culture, island day trips, Breton food

Walk to Center: ~2 km (25 min flat walk) or free/low-cost shuttle

Don't Miss: Keroman Submarine Base (La Base) and Cité de la Voile Éric Tabarly

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Keroman Submarine Base (La Base)** — The most intact WWII German U-boat base in the world.
- Cité de la Voile Éric Tabarly** — France's premier interactive sailing museum, dedicated to offshore racing legend Éric Tabarly and the world of ocean...
- Île de Groix Day Trip** — A 45-min ferry from Lorient drops you on this car-free Breton island with wild Atlantic beaches, coastal hiking trails...
- Port-Louis Citadel & East India Company Museum** — Cross the harbor by water bus (about €1.50) to the 16th-century Spanish-built citadel at Port-Louis.
- Carnac Megaliths** — Some 3,000 prehistoric standing stones stretching across the landscape — the largest megalithic site on earth.

BEST WALKS

- City Center & Marina Stroll** 1.5 km • Flat • 30 min — From the city center shuttle drop-off near Hôtel de Ville, walk down to the Port de Plaisance marina to admire ocean-racing yachts...
- La Base Waterfront Walk** 1 km circuit • Easy • 30 min — After visiting La Base, walk the perimeter of the K-bunkers along the waterfront.

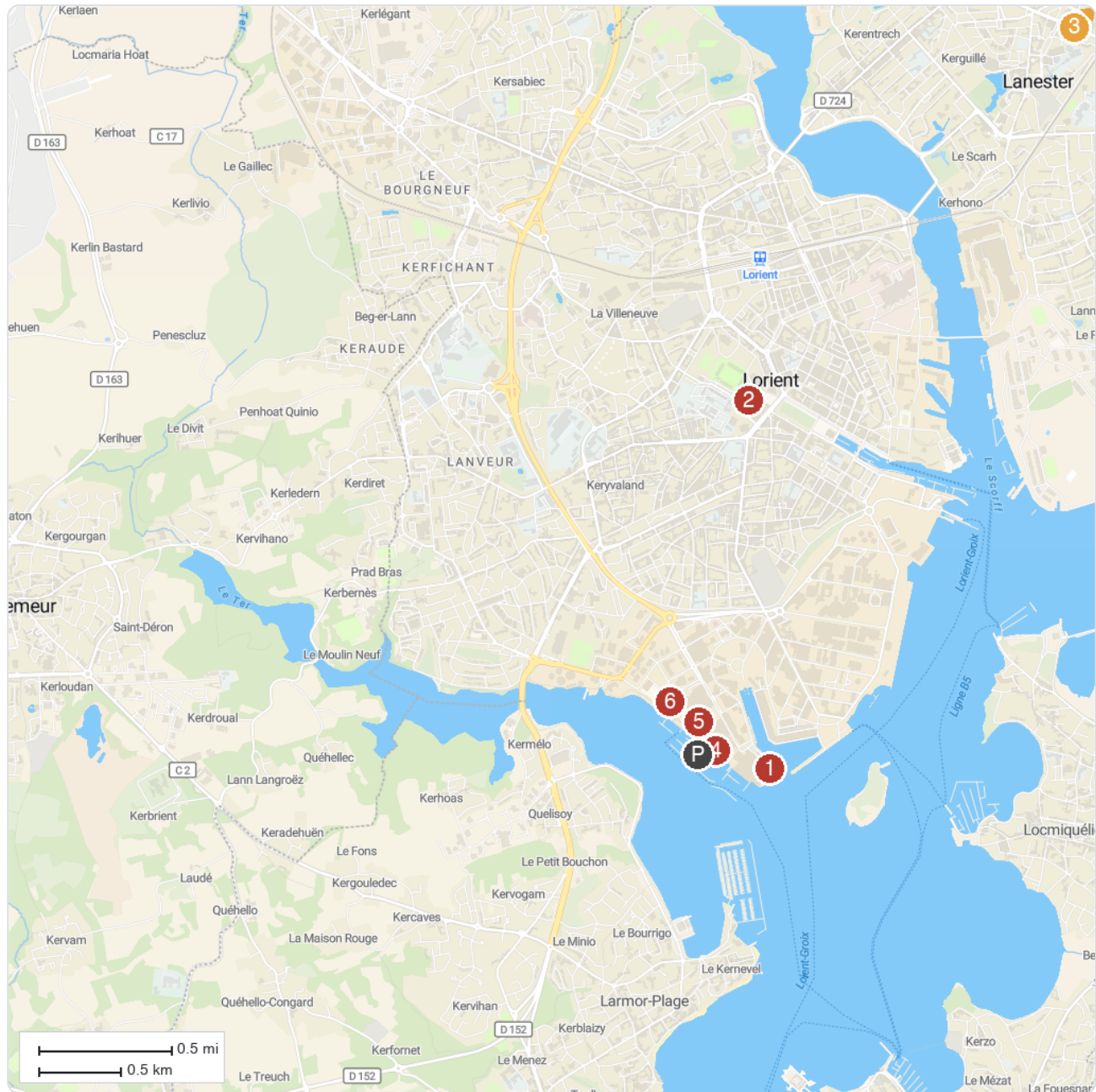
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Shuttle vs. walking: The 2 km walk to the city center is flat but industrial and not scenic. Take the cruise shuttle or a €5 taxi to start your day closer to the action.
- Water bus is a steal: The Batobus to Port-Louis costs about €1.50 each way (regular bus fare) and doubles as a mini harbor
